

## **VANDERBILT OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH CLINIC IMMUNIZATION RESOURCE SHEET**

- HEPATITIS B:** If you have the potential to come in contact with human blood or body fluids as part of your employment here, documentation of either
- A.** A completed series of 3 hepatitis B vaccines
  - B.** A hepatitis B vaccine series in progress
  - C.** Laboratory evidence of immunity to hepatitis B
- or**
- D.** Informed refusal of the vaccine

**VARICELLA (chickenpox):** Written documentation of a varicella immunity test drawn from a reputable laboratory (date and result)

### **MMR**

- Measles (rubeola):** If born on or after 1/1/1957, written documentation of either
- A.** Two (2) live measles (rubeola) vaccines given no less than one month apart, after the first birthday
  - B.** One (1) measles/mumps/rubella (MMR) vaccine since 1989
  - C.** Laboratory evidence of immunity to rubeola (date and result)
- or**
- D.** Physician diagnosed rubeola infection

**Mumps:** One dose of live mumps after first birthday

### **Rubella (German measles):**

- A.** Written documentation or laboratory evidence of immunity to rubella with date and result
- or**
- B.** Documentation of an MMR vaccine or a rubella vaccine since 1989

**TETANUS/DIPHTHERIA:** Documentation of a tetanus/diphtheria booster within the past 10 years. (*Optional*)

### **TUBERCULOSIS:**

- A.** Written documentation of either 2 negative TB skin tests within the past 12 months with the most recent being within the past 3 months
- or**
- B.** If a history of a positive skin test, a chest x-ray within the past 6 months
