

Application for Pre-Freshman Credit

Please note: **This form is not for Advanced Placement/International Baccalaureate credit.**

Entering freshmen that have taken college work during their junior or senior in high school or during summers *prior* to their offer of admission to Vanderbilt must report such work to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. At the student's request a determination will be made by the Office of the Dean as to whether such work may be awarded credit toward the Vanderbilt degree. *You must apply for Pre-Freshman credit before the end of the first week of classes.*

Any courses taken as pre-freshman college work **must** meet several criteria in order to receive Vanderbilt credit (*see below*). Please make special note that credits earned through participation in Girls' State/Boys' State and/or Governor's School programs are not eligible to be transferred.

Pre-Freshman Credit Eligibility

Circle the answers to these questions for each course you wish to have evaluated for pre-freshman credit.

1. Was the course offered through an accredited college or university? *Yes or No*
2. Did you take the course on the campus of the college/university? *Yes or No*
3. Was the professor of the course a member of the institution's faculty? *Yes or No*
4. Were the majority of students in the course degree-seeking college students? *Yes or No*
5. Was the credit earned separate from high-school graduation requirements? *Yes or No*
6. Did you earn a calculated grade of C- or better (no Pass/Fail grades)? *Yes or No*

- If you answered **No** to any of the above questions regarding previous college work it is not eligible for Vanderbilt credit. You do not need to send in this form.

- If you answered **Yes** to all of the above questions regarding previous college work it may be eligible for Vanderbilt credit. Please completely fill out the reverse side of this form and **follow the instructions.**
