Last Time Out

The Vanderbilt Commodores finished the exhibition season with a 2-0 record with wins over the Harlem Globetrotters and the Upstate New York All-Stars.

The highlight of the two games was the 70-68 win over the Globetrotters, which was just the third time in three seasons they had lost during their college tour. Making the game even more dramatic was junior forward Matt Freije hitting an 18-foot fall-away jumper at the final buzzer to give Vanderbilt the win.

The Commodores followed that big win with a dominating 91-70 victory over the Upstate New York All-Stars. This game was never in doubt as Vanderbilt trailed just once, 2-0, and was able to post a 50-25 halftime lead.

Freije was the leading performer for Vanderbilt in both games, averaging 22.5 points and seven rebounds despite playing just 19 minutes against the Upstate New York All-Stars. The only other Commodore to average double-digit points was sophomore David Przybyszewski, who averaged 14 points and five rebounds in the two games. Junior guard Russell Lakey once again made his presence known as he dished out 12 assists to just three turnovers.

Scouting Southeastern Louisiana

This is the season opener as well for Southeastern Louisiana. The Lions return six of 10 letterwinners and two of the five starters from last squad that finished 7-20 overall and 6-14 in the Southland Conference.

Junior guard Amir Abdur-Rahim is Southeastern Louisiana's top returning player after he averaged 15.9 points and 3.5 rebounds per game last season. Abdur-Rahim was deadly from long range as he hit 77 three pointers last year.

The other returning starter for the Lions is junior point guard Dyron Clark, who finished last season with 6.2 points, 2.6 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game.

This is the first meeting between the two schools. Vanderbilt holds a 1-0 all-time record against the current members of the Southland Conference. The Commodores earned an 85-37 home win over Nicholls State Dec. 15, 1996.

Despite this being the first meeting between the two schools, there are ties. Former VU head football coach Woody Widenhofer is Southeastern Louisiana's defensive coordinator as the Lions return to the gridiron next fall after disbanding the team following the 1985 season.

Vanderbilt in Season Openers

The Commodores boast an 84-31 all-time record in season openers. Also, they have won six straight season openers and 10 of the past 11, dating back to Eddie Fogler's 1991-92 NIT team. Last season, Vanderbilt opened the campaign with a convincing 96-61 victory over the Liberty Flames.

Commodores in Home Openers

Vanderbilt has won 12 consecutive home openers. The last time the Commodores lost a home opener was Nov. 29, 1989, when Tennessee Tech beat Vanderbilt, 89-76.

Krueger & Skuchas to Redshirt

Vanderbilt freshmen Bryson Krueger and Ted Skuchas will redshirt this season. Krueger, a 6-6, 183-pound guard from Tempe, Ariz., missed most of the preseason practices because of personal issues and did not play in either exhibition game. Skuchas, a 6-11, 243-pound center from Audubon, Pa., will sit out this season in an effort to help his long-term development.

The last Commodore to truly redshirt was Sam Lekwauwa in the 1998-99 season. Chuck Moore, who graduated this past spring, was forced to sit out the 1999-00 season after transferring from Seton Hall.

Bulk of Production Returns for Commodores

With the loss of just two starters and four letterwinners overall, the majority of Vanderbilt's production returns for the 2002-2003 season. Led by junior Matt Freije, almost 55 percent of the scoring and almost 64 percent of the rebounding return from this past season. The Commodores also have more than 55 percent of the assists, more than 53 percent of the steals and almost 59 percent of the minutes played returning this fall.

The only area in which less than half of the team's production is not returning is three-point field goals. With the departure of Brendan

Plavich, Sam Howard and Chuck Moore, VU returns less than 28 percent of its three-point baskets from last season.

Youth Reigns Again for Vanderbilt

Just as they have the past two seasons, the Commodores will be forced to depend on a young and inexperienced group of players to win games. Of the 13 scholarship players on the roster, there are no seniors, three juniors, five sophomores and five freshmen.

The 10 underclassmen is the largest number of underclassmen on a Vanderbilt team since 11 dotted the 1987-88 squad. That group of underclassmen went on to lead the team to the 1990 NIT championship.

Stallings' Fourth Year Provides Quality Seasons

In his 20 seasons as an assistant and head coach, there have been three times when Kevin Stallings has coached the same team for a fourth consecutive season. As Stallings enters his fourth season at the helm of the Commodores, history provides hope for a successful 2002-2003 Commodore campaign.

In his fourth season as an assistant coach on Gene Keady's staff at Purdue, Stallings helped the Boilermakers to a 22-10 overall record, an 11-7 Big Ten mark and an NCAA Tournament berth.

Stallings' fourth season as an assistant on Roy Williams' staff at Kansas saw the Jayhawks finish 27-5 overall, 11-3 in the Big Eight and advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

In his fourth season as the head coach at Illinois State, Stallings led the Redbirds to a 24-6 overall record, a 14-4 record in the Missouri Valley Conference and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.

Reaching New Heights

This year's Commodore team has six players that stand 6-8 or taller, including sophomore David Przybyszewski (6-11), freshman Ted Skuchas (6-11), sophomore Martin Schnedlitz (6-10), junior Matt Freije (6-9), freshman Julian Terrell (6-9) and sophomore Brian Thornton (6-8).

The last VU team to have at least six players who stood 6-8 or taller was the 1997-98 squad that advanced to the third round of the NIT. The six players on the 1997-98 squad included Darius Coulibaly (7-0), Dan Langhi (6-11), Austin Bates (6-10), Billy Di Spaltro (6-9), Greg LaPointe (6-9) and Gianni Cugini (6-8).

Vanderbilt Welcomes Two Freshmen With Local Ties

Incoming freshmen Mario Moore and Julian Terrell both come to Vanderbilt from Nashville, continuing a long tradition of home-grown talent for the Commodore men's basketball program.

This is the first time since the 1985-86 season in which more than one incoming freshman has come to Vanderbilt from the same area. That 1985-86 squad actually had two pairs of freshmen from common areas. Barry Booker from Franklin, Tenn., and Sydney Grider from Nashville, Tenn. joined the local team, while Frank Kornet and Chip Rupp joined the Commodores from Lexington, Ky.

Quiet Signing Day for Vanderbilt

Vanderbilt had an uneventful signing day as the Commodores inked no recruits during the early signing period. This is because Vanderbilt has no scholarship seniors and a full roster, leaving them no scholarships to offer this year. Walk-on Matt Carter is the team's only senior this season.

However, with freshmen Bryson Krueger and Ted Skuchas red-shirting this season, the Commodores will have, in a sense, a two-player incoming class for next season.

Memorial Gym Shines Past Golden Anniversary

The Vanderbilt basketball teams play their games in a new-look Memorial Gym as a \$25 million renovation was completed this past fall. Included in the renovation was a three cross-court practice gym, coaches office suites, new entry plazas and a donor lounge that overlooks the court.

These improvements come on the heels of Phase I of the project, which included aesthetic enhancements to the seating bowl and lobby areas, new lighting and sound systems, private suites and new press row and media work areas.

Freije Named Third-Team All-SEC

Matt Freije was named Third-Team All-SEC for the 2001-02 season after being selected as a member of the SEC's All-Freshman Team in 2001. The sophomore forward led the Commodores in scoring and rebounding for the 2001-02 season.

Freije, who was the only Commodore to start every game this season, finished the season ranked among the SEC's best in several statistical categories. He was 12th in scoring (15.1), seventh in free-throw percentage (.768) and eighth in field-goal percentage (.466). In SEC games, the native of Shawnee Mission, Kan., finished 14th in scoring (13.6), tied for 19th in rebounding (5.3) and sixth in free-throw percentage (.774).

Thornton Named to SEC's All-Freshman Team

Brian Thornton became just the sixth Commodore to earn SEC All-Freshman honors and the second in as many years. He joins Matt Freije (2000), Greg LaPointe (1998), Drew Maddux (1995), Ronnie McMahan

Thornton led Vanderbilt's five freshmen in scoring, rebounding, minutes played and starts. He posted the team's only double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds at Tennessee. In the next game at home against No. 11 Kentucky, the native of Louisville, Ky., scored a career-high 17 points and just missed his second consecutive double-double with nine rebounds.

Vanderbilt Makes 16th Postseason Appearance

Vanderbilt's closed out this past season by making its 16th trip to the postseason and the ninth appearance in the NIT. The Commodores earned a 59-50 home win over Houston in the opening round before falling 83-68 at Louisiana Tech.

Thornton Ranks Among SEC's Best Freshmen

This past season, forward Brian Thornton ranked highly among SEC freshmen in several statistical categories. Among SEC freshmen, Thornton was second in rebounding (4.6), second in blocks (0.59) and fourth in free throw percentage (.703). Thornton's 4.6 rebounds per game is sixth-best all-time for a Vanderbilt freshman.

Freije Named SEC Player of the Week

Sophomore forward Matt Freije was named SEC Player of the Week Jan. 21. It was the first Player of the Week award for Freije and the first for Vanderbilt since Anthony Williams earned the honor February 21, 2000.

Three-Point Streak Moves Past 500 Games

Vanderbilt continues to be one of only three schools (UNLV & Princeton) to have made a three-point field goal in every game since the shot was introduced for the 1986-87 season. Vanderbilt's streak stands at 504 games, which is just three games behind UNLV's streak for the longest in the nation.

Musical Lineups

During the 2001-2002 season, Vanderbilt started 18 different lineups in 32 games. The combination of Matt Freije, Sam Howard, Chuck Moore, Brendan Plavich and David Przybyszewski led the way with a 5-2 record. Freije was the only Commodore to start every game this past season.

Commodores Secure Winning Season

With the 86-73 victory over No. 11 Kentucky, Vanderbilt secured its 12th winning season in the past 16 years. In those 16 seasons, the Commodores have posted 12 winning seasons, two .500 seasons and two losing seasons. In three seasons at Vanderbilt, head coach Kevin Stallings has now posted two winning seasons and one .500 campaign.

Vanderbilt Versus Ranked Opponents

Vanderbilt finished the 2001-02 campaign 3-4 and 9-15 under Kevin Stallings versus ranked opponents. The Commodores collected victories over ranked foes Western Kentucky, Georgia and Kentucky. In the 36 games versus ranked opponents leading up to Stallings' arrival (1994-99), VU won just six games.

SEC Winning Streak

With consecutive wins in January over Auburn, South Carolina and Georgia, VU captured three straight SEC victories for the first time since the 1997-98 season.

Matt Freije finished his sophomore season with 39 career blocks, which leaves him nine away from cracking the school's top-10 list. His 28 blocks in the 1999-2000 season ranked him as the top freshman and sixth overall in single-season blocks at VU.

Freije Scores Career High

Sophomore forward Matt Freije scored a career-high 29 points against Auburn, eclipsing his previous high of 22 that he had set three times. His 29 points against Auburn is the most for a Commodore since Dan Langhi scored 32 points March 1, 2000, against Georgia.

Freije also set or tied career highs in three-point field goals (3), three-point attempts (5), free throws made (12), free-throw attempts (14) and minutes (35).
