- His three minutes against Mississippi State was the most since playing eight minutes against American December 20

## General Evaluation

Scored points in flurries with his great shooting range...A lifelong Vanderbilt fan who committed early and did not make official visits to any other schools...A highly decorated prep star who scored more points at Goodpasture Christian than Ron Mercer.

## Vanderbilt Record Book

- 5th in career 3-point FG made with 234
- 4th in career 3-point FG attempts with 643
- 11th in single-season 3-point FG made with 78 (1999-00)

## 2001-2002 Notes

- With 20 points at Arkansas, became the 34th member of Vanderbilt's 1,000-point club; His 20 points at Arkansas is the third-highest total for him this season and it was the first time Howard has led the team in scoring since Morehead State
- Overall, eighth in three-point field goals made (2.16) and third in three-point field-goal percentage (.421) in the SEC
- In SEC games, sixth in three-point field-goal percentage (.406)
- For the second time in three games, he led VU in scoring with a game-high 14 points in only 15 minutes versus Houston; Houston was the sixth game this season in which he has made at least four three pointers
- 23 of his last 33 field goals were three pointers
- Six treys at Arkansas was a season high and is one off career high
- Did not see action at Tennessee, which is the first time in his career that he has not made it into a game
- His 16 minutes vs. South Carolina was the most in past six games and he then matched it with 16 minutes vs. Mississippi State
- His 22 points at Alabama ties the second-best mark of his career
- His four assists versus American tied a season high
- Scored a career-high 24 points in season opener versus Liberty
- After struggling through junior season, has rebounded to rank fourth on team with 9.7 points per game
- Has scored in double figures in 15 games this season after scoring in double-digits just eight times in 30 games last season
- Made a three pointer in all but five games this season
- Playing time was limited vs. Auburn after suffering a slight concussion
- Led team in scoring six times, assists two times and steals four times

## 2000-2001 Notes

- Seven field goals against South Carolina Jan. 17 was the most since he connected on seven against Georgia, March 1, 2000
- Five made two-pointers against LSU is second most in career
- Played a career-high 37 minutes at Boston College
- Broke his right foot before the season
