GDR Policy: All Ph.D. students (beginning with the class entering in 1995) will take a minimum of 12 hours of course work at Vanderbilt in a minor area or areas. Normally, transfer credit will not be allowed to satisfy this requirement. The minor can be in another area of the GDR, or another department of the University, or it can be an interdisciplinary minor defined by a problem or theme proposed by the student. A minor in interdisciplinary studies may, under appropriate circumstances and with the approval of the advisor, include some courses related to a student's major area of studies. This requirement is satisfied by two minors in Religion and Personality. Competence in the minor area will be tested by a qualifying examination or paper.
