2. Submit the following items to CET:

- online forms at www.cetacademicprograms.com*
- official Vanderbilt transcript (*in addition* to transcript for VU SAPO)
- professor recommendations (2 for Italy, 3 for China)
- Language recommendation - *only* if you have background in target language (Italian or Chinese)
- 8 passport photos
- photocopy of signed passport

- Recommendations should go directly to CET. You may send them in yourself or ask your Professors to send them CET. Vanderbilt Global Education Programs, including CET programs, are NOT subject to rolling admissions. All applications will be considered only after the Vanderbilt deadline.
- **Both** the Vanderbilt **and** CET portions of the application must be complete and submitted by the Vanderbilt deadline for your application to be considered.
- You **do not** need to complete the home institution approval form. This is for non-Vanderbilt applicants only.
- You must submit the transcript request form, even if you are not requesting an additional transcript. You will automatically receive an unofficial copy and GEO will receive an official copy.

Please carefully read all portions of the application as well as CET brochures and make note of all pre-requisites, including a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 for all programs. You will be notified by the Global Education Office via email approximately 4 to 6 weeks after the application deadline whether or not you have been *approved* by Vanderbilt to study abroad. We will then notify CET of our approval of your application. CET will make final program acceptance decisions. You will be notified by CET via email as to your application status.
