Application Instructions:

1. Complete and submit the general Vanderbilt Global Education Application to study abroad.

2. Submit the following items to Vanderbilt Global Education Office:
 - Homerton College application forms (2 total)
 - personal statement/essay
 - 2 letters of recommendation from professors in proposed subjects of study
 - SAT and/or ACT scores (minimum 650 in Math and Verbal for SAT and 29 in English and Math for ACT)
 - one passport sized photograph attached to application
3. Following completion of Step 2, you will be contacted by Global Education Office Director Dr. Gary W. Johnston for a required interview.

-Proposed subjects of study should fall under the normally offered classes (please see Cambridge website, www.cam.ac.uk) through one department. Some flexibility may be considered for cross department courses on a case-by-case basis.

- Study Abroad at Homerton is full-year only. The full year consists of Michaelmas Term - end of September to mid-December; Lent Term – early January to mid-March; Easter Term – mid-April to end of June.

Please carefully read all portions of the application make note of all pre-requisites, including participation as a student in Junior standing and minimum 3.4 GPA . You will be notified by the Global Education Office via email approximately 4 to 6 weeks after the application deadline whether or not you have been *approved* by Vanderbilt to study abroad. We will then notify Homerton College of our approval of your application. Homerton College will make final program acceptance decisions via email.
