

US allopathic/MD medical schools accepted (128) out of (191) Vanderbilt University firsttime applicants.

National Acceptance Rate44%Vanderbilt University Acceptance Rate67%

Osteopathic/DO medical schools accepted (3) Vanderbilt first-time applicants. Including these applicants:
















2012 Pharmacy Applicants
