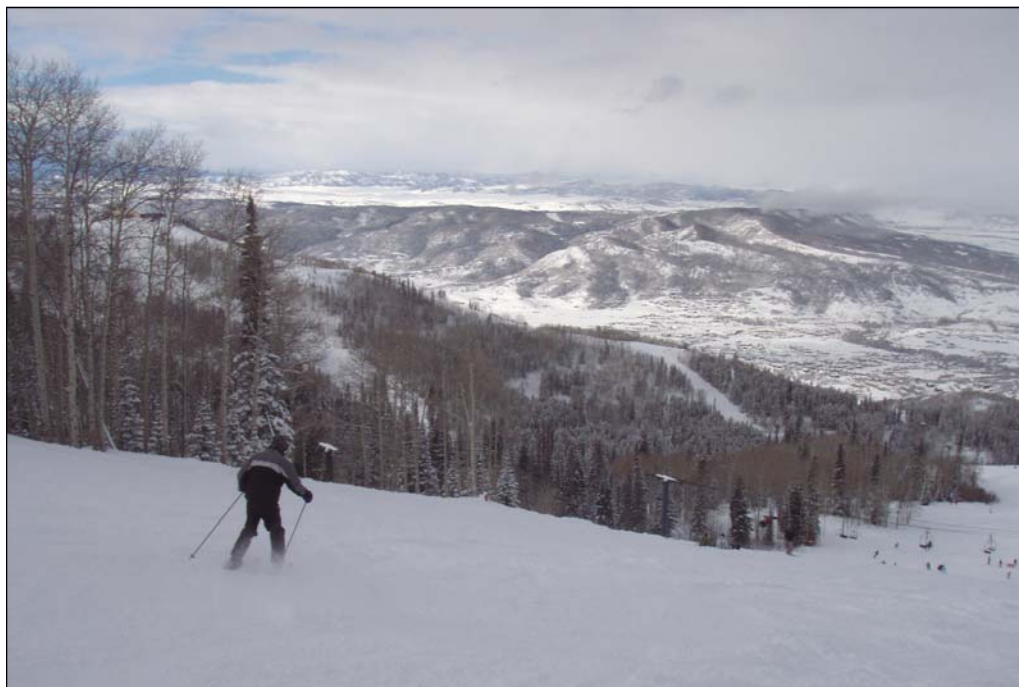

TRIP OVERVIEW:

This is the 15th snow ski trip sponsored by the Outdoor Recreation Program. We are working with a ski tour company to assure that the trip will run smoothly. Due to the distance and the time of the year, we will be flying, via Northwest Airlines, to Hayden, via a stop in Minneapolis-St. Paul. Then we will ride a shuttle bus to Steamboat Springs. Once in Steamboat Springs, we will be staying at Timber Run Condominiums for six nights. They are located around 500 yards from the Silver Bullet Gondola. This is a bit of a walk, or you can take advantage of the free shuttle service that picks up in front of Timber Run. There is also a free shuttle bus to take you around the town. We have condos that sleep 6 people each at maximum occupancy. Each spacious unit features a gas fireplace, fully equipped kitchen with microwave oven, telephone, phone message service, two full bathrooms, and cable TV with HBO and VCR. This popular property has an outdoor heated pool, three outdoor hot tubs, sauna, and private shuttle service to skiing, dining and shopping.

Steamboat Springs has a ski resort area that is nearby, and an old downtown area that is a shuttle ride away. Check out the details about Steamboat Springs at www.steamboat.com . We will also receive discounts on night time tubing, Never Ever Ski or Snowboard Lessons (only \$10 last year, possibly more this year), and a coupon book for area shops and restaurants.

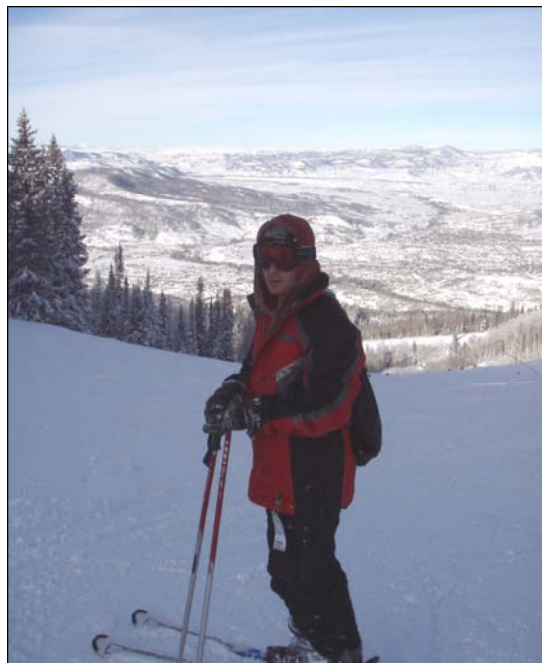

If you have never skied out west before, the snow tends to be deeper and more powder-like than most eastern ski slopes. And, the scenery is absolutely gorgeous!! SKI & SNOWBOARD RENTALS:

Full ski rental packages including shaped skis, boots, and poles are available at the discount price of \$18/day for the Sport Package and \$32/day for the High Performance Package. Snowboards/boots rent for \$28/day. All extra fees will be collected at the Pre-Trip Meeting.



OTHER ITEMS TO NOTE:

If you need a place to store your luggage (that you will bring back from home but not use on the trip), there will be a secure place to store luggage at the Outdoor Recreation Center while you travel to Colorado.

This trip is open to VU Students, Graduate and Professional Students, Staff, Medical Staff, and Faculty.

Guests of VU people are welcome.
