### **TRIP OVERVIEW:**

This is the 13th snow ski trip sponsored by the Outdoor Recreation Program. We are working with a ski tour company to assure that the trip will run smoothly. Due to the distance and the time of the year, we will be flying, via American Airlines, to Dallas, and then onto Hayden. Then we will take a short ride on a shuttle bus to Steamboat Springs. Once in Steamboat Springs, we will be staying at Timber Run Condominiums for five nights. They are located in around 500 yards from the Silver Bullet Gondola. This is a bit of a walk, or you can take advantage of the free shuttle service that picks up in front of Timber Run. There is also a free shuttle bus to take you around the town. We have condos that sleep 6 people each at maximum occupancy. Each spacious unit features a gas fireplace, fully equipped kitchen with microwave oven, telephone, phone message service, two full bathrooms, and cable TV with HBO and VCR. This popular property has an outdoor heated pool, three outdoor hot tubs, sauna, and private shuttle service to skiing, dining and shopping.

Steamboat Springs has a ski resort area that is nearby, and an old downtown area that is a shuttle ride away. We will also receive discounts on night time tubing, Never Ever Ski or Snowboard Lessons (only \$10 last year, possibly more this year), and a coupon book for area shops and restaurants.

If you have never skied before (see above), or it has been a while, we recommend you participate in the ski and snowboard school on site. If you have never skied out west before, the snow tends to be deeper and more powder-like than most eastern ski slopes. And, the scenery is absolutely gorgeous!! We hope this will be a trip to remember for you (and your friends).

### **SKI & SNOWBOARD RENTALS:**

Full ski rental packages including shaped skis, boots, and poles are available at the discount price of \$16/day for the Sport Package and \$32/day for the Performance Package. Snowboards/boots rent for \$26/day. All extra fees will be collected at the Pre-Trip Meeting.

### **OTHER ITEMS TO NOTE:**

- If you need a place to store your luggage (that you will take home for the semester break), there will be a secure place to store luggage at the Outdoor Recreation Center while you travel to Colorado.
- You can sleep at Outdoor Rec. on Wednesday, Jan. 2 if you need a place to stay.
- Guests of VU people are welcome.
- The airplane is scheduled to depart Nashville at 8:10 AM on Thursday, Jan. 3. We are scheduled to arrive back in Nashville at 9:00 PM on Tuesday, January 8, 2008.
- There is an additional fee for the condo; a \$25 per person security deposit, which is refunded if the condo is left in acceptable condition.
- There may be an additional fee if the airline raises all ticket prices due to fuel cost increases.
