

Parking for the RIPS Lab

Note: Please allow 10 minutes to walk from a parking spot to the lab. If you are having trouble finding the lab, please call the Vanderbilt Political Science office at 615-322-6222 (or, after hours, try calling 615-720-7577) and ask for directions to the RIPS Lab in Room 010 of Calhoun Hall.

For those with a Vanderbilt parking pass, the most convenient lots are those in Zone 2; in particular, we recommend you park in those near the law school. These options are illustrated in the below map.




The RIPS lab is located in the basement of Calhoun Hall (Rm. 010).

Those with a University Zone permit for Zone 2 can park in any of the lots identified as Zone 2 (green) on the map here, and walk to Calhoun. We recommend you enter through the entrance facing North, which takes you directly into the basement.

After 2:30pm, it is Vanderbilt policy that anyone with a University Zone parking permit can park in any Zone lot. If you are coming before that time, we recommend you park in your usual lot and walk to Calhoun.

For those without a Vanderbilt parking pass, all spots in red on the below map indicate public parking options. Most all of these parking options are metered spaces of one form or another.



The RIPS lab is located in the basement of Calhoun Hall (Rm. 010).

One option is to park in the metered spaces in the Terrace Place Garage (outlined in a Red rectangle), walk across 21st street to enter Vanderbilt's campus. Then proceed past the law school, then by the front of Furman, before reaching the North entrance to Calhoun Hall (highlighted in yellow and circled in Black), where you enter into the basement by the RIPS lab. The suggested walking route from the garage to Calhoun is shown in blue dots on the map to the left.
