- 2022 Campus Dining initiated a reusable container program designed to reduce the university's dependance on disposable to-go containers
- Free for students; faculty/staff purchase for \$5
- Every time a student reuses their container money is donated to trusted charitable partners
- o 2131 students are enrolled
- o 18,968 reuses
- o No More Plastic water bottles will be initiated in 2023.
- The reusable VU Water Bottles with QR code will help save 400,000 plastic water bottles at VU.
