- Endeavor to
 - 1. Dismantle systemic barriers for marginalized and underserved population to thrive.
 - 2. Champion equity, diversity, and inclusion in academic and scholarly activities by cultivating opportunities for collaborating and community across the University.
 - 3. Provide education resources, programming, outreach, and learning opportunities that promote access and well-being.
 - 4. Align our mission and actions through meaningful accountability measures and data to ensure progress on goals related to equity, diversity, and inclusion.
