The Program

The Vanderbilt International Office (VIO) Grants Program offers multiple ways to receive funding for international research projects and curriculum development:

Research Grants, Category A: Collaborative Exploratory Grants

Up to \$8,000 to develop new research collaborations with foreign partners

Research Grants, Category B: Project Development Grants

Up to \$15,000 to lay the foundation for ongoing and sustainable research partnerships

Curricula Grants

Up to \$10,000 for teams of at least three faculty members to develop global content and perspectives in undergraduate courses within a department

Objectives

Research Grants

- 1) To enhance the research and teaching programs at Vanderbilt by providing seed funding to establish selective international research collaborations and exchanges
- 2) To promote the academic reputation of Vanderbilt outside the U.S. and to enhance recruitment of international faculty and students
- 3) To build sustainable institutional partnerships with peer institutions overseas

Curricula Grants

- 1) To develop global content and perspectives in undergraduate courses within a department
- 2) To integrate new content into the curriculum and make it sustainable
- 3) To improve the quality of international learning experiences for students
