

At the Annual Meeting on January 15, 2015 the Club membership voted to approve several revisions to the bylaws. A copy of the proposed bylaws had been mailed/emailed to all Club members prior to the meeting. The final version, approved on 1/15/15, includes two additional minor changes which were not in the mailed/ emailed version: In Article III, Sections A and B the word "husbands" is changed to "spouses/ partners" and in Article IX, Section 1 the final sentence has been changed to "The payout (interest) from the Endowed Center is directed into the Vanderbilt Woman's Club Stapleton/ Weaver Scholarship Account for disbursement to scholarship recipients."
