EMPLOYER PROGRAMS

Handshake utilizes standard language for their employer events requests. Below are the categories to select based on the type of event you would like to host at Vanderbilt University.

Employer Onsite

Site Visit

Want the opportunity to connect with students off-campus? Invite Vanderbilt talent into your office for an in-person or virtual site visit. During a site visit, you can host a group of students to showcase your organization's office culture, share about available internship and full-time opportunities, and provide more information about your organization and various career paths to potential candidates.

Trek

Want to be considered for a future trek? Treks are location-based events that involve multiple site visits, and typically involve financial sponsorship and/or a meal provided to 20-30 students. Oftentimes these take place over the course of one to two days and feature employers in similar industries or with similar corporate social responsibility goals. Trek locations change annually, so connect with your Employer Relations Specialist to express your interest in serving as a host site Site Visit

Information Session

Host an information session to inform Vanderbilt talent about your organization, career opportunities, industry tips and tricks, or anything related to recruiting. Information Sessions can be held in person or virtually. We suggest hosting information sessions Monday through Thursday between 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. CT.

Networking

Coffee Chat

Interested in engaging with students one-on-one? Hosting a Coffee Chat is the perfect opportunity to casually discuss internships or full-time roles with your company and get to know Vanderbilt's talent. They can be held in the Career Center, virtually, at a local Coffee Shop, or off-campus site!

Curiosity Conversation

Want to help educate students on your industry? Curiosity Conversations are meant to be exploratory, one-on-one casual discussions. Topics of conversation could include possible

career paths, industry knowledge, resources, etc. Target students for Curiosity Conversations are typically in the beginning stages of their career exploration, specifically First & Second Year Students.

Office Hours

Similar to coffee chats, office hours serve as an opportunity for a casual group or one-on-one drop-ins between Vanderbilt students and members of your organization. Topics for office hours can include company overview, position openings, industry tips, and more.

Speaker/Panel

Panel

Host a panel to educate students on an industry-specific topic. We encourage thought leaders from your organization to explore various career paths, industry trends, diverse perspectives, etc. Panels promote conversations and Q&A between panelists and students.

Special Guest Speaker

Are you (or do you know) an industry expert who would like to share their knowledge with Vanderbilt students? Invite a guest speaker sponsored by your organization to deliver industry knowledge or discuss emerging topics in a formal setting.

Student Lunch & Learn

Inform potential Vanderbilt candidates about industry-related topics over lunch! Student Lunch & Learns provide an opportunity for informal engagement with students during the lunch hour.

Other

Case Competition

Does your organization have a problem that you are looking for talented Vanderbilt minds to help solve? Sponsor a case competition for a class, a student organization, or a targeted group of students you may be interested in hiring.

Customized Program
