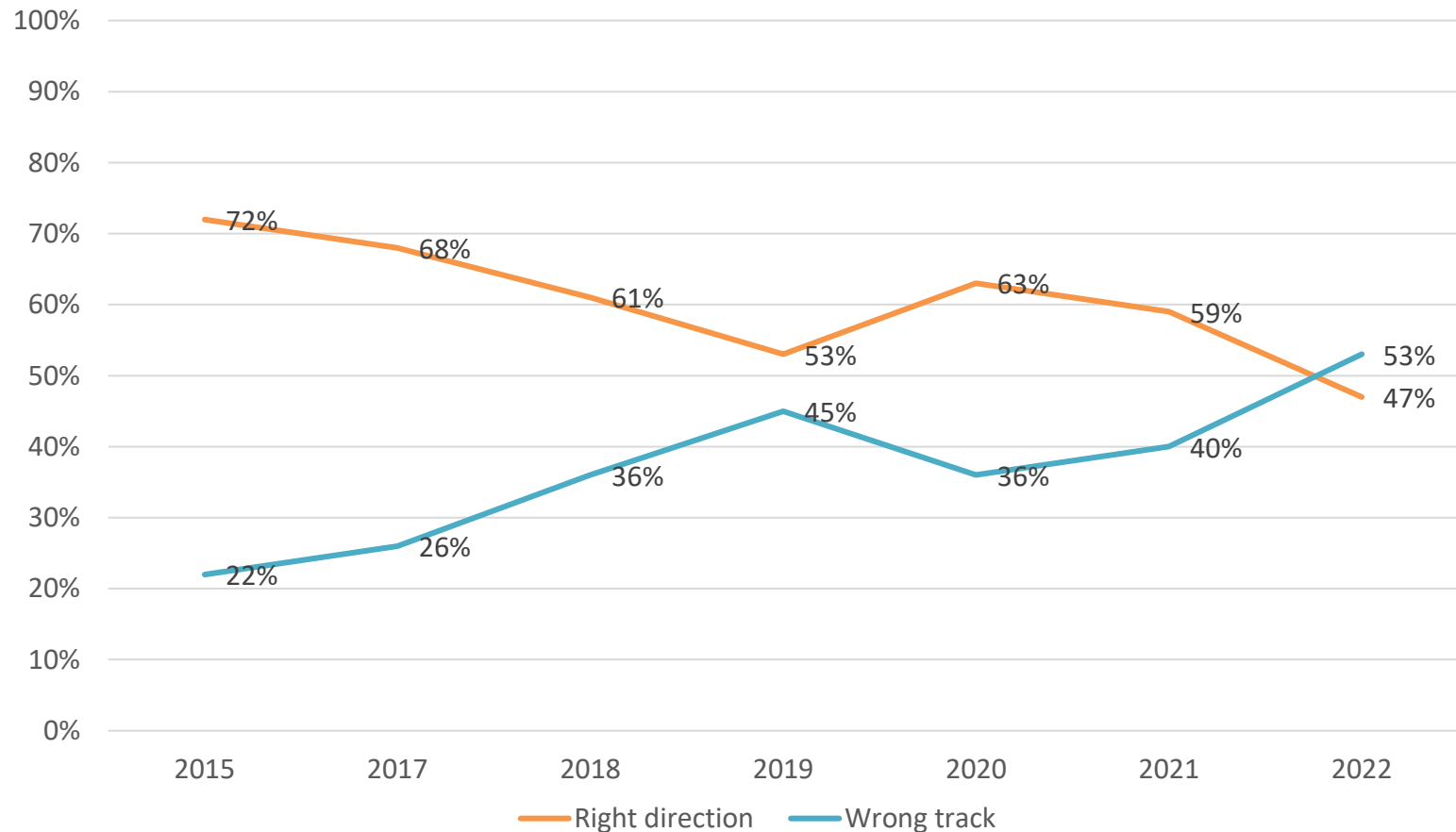

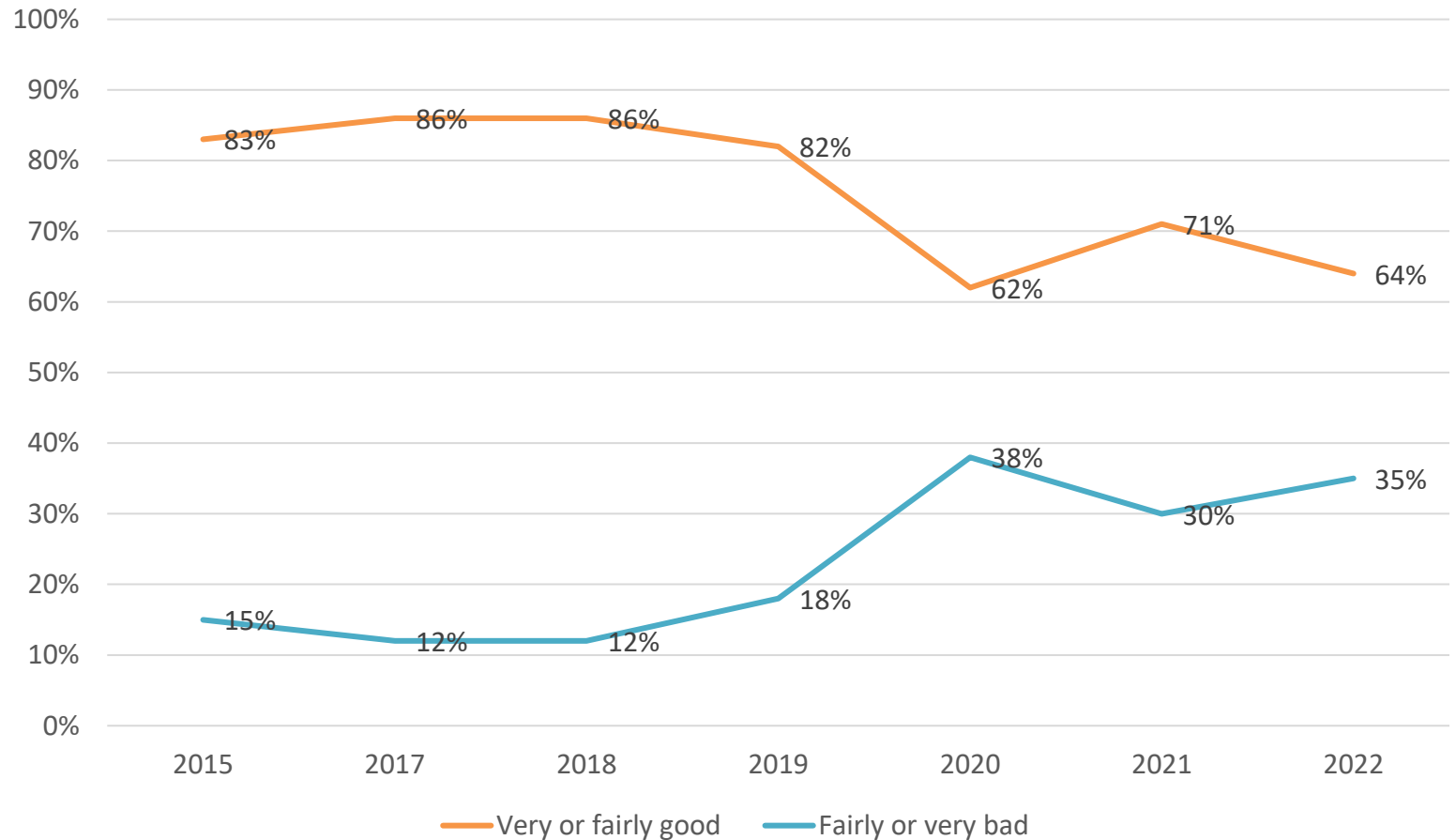

Nashville, Right Direction or Wrong Track over Time

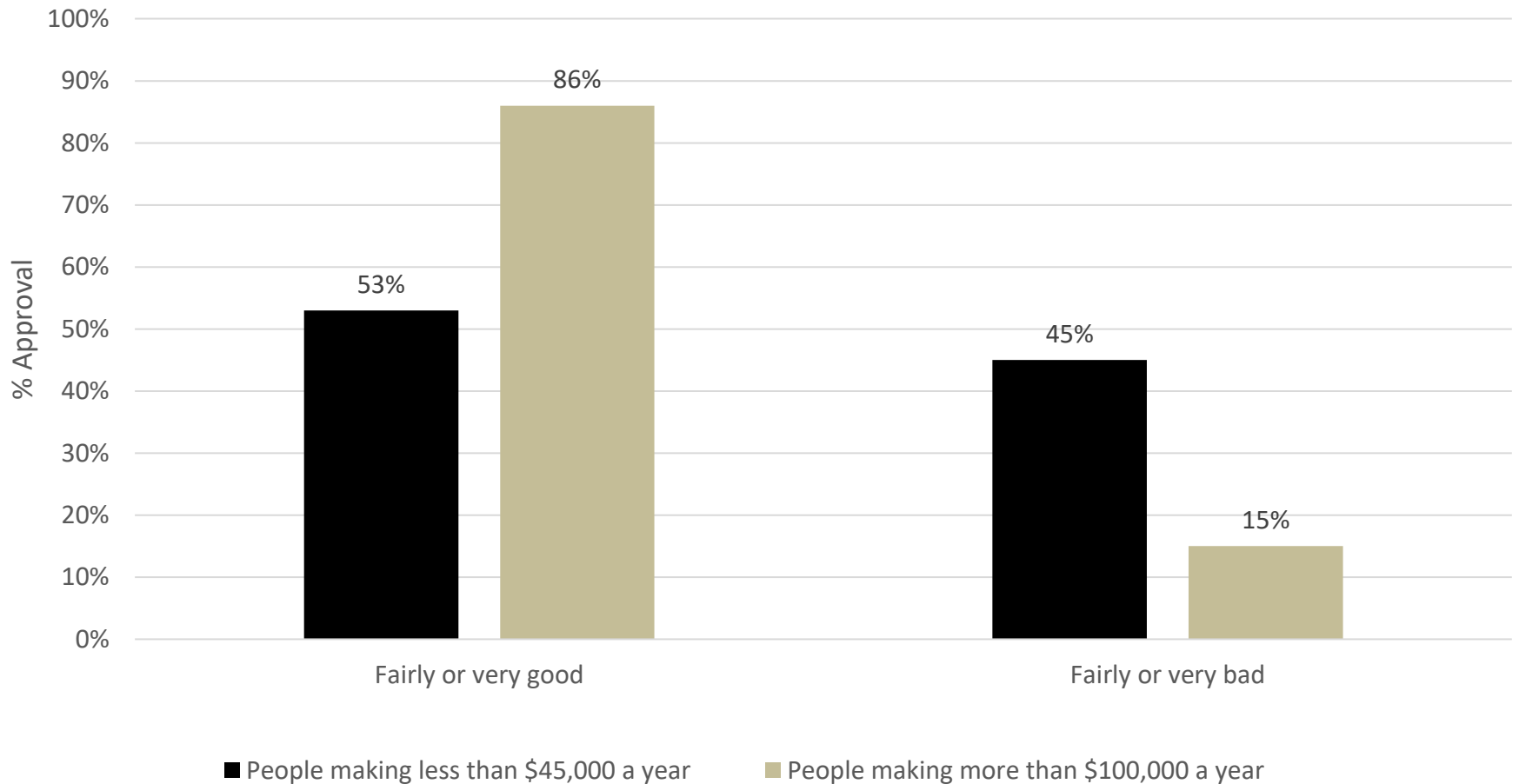
Do you think things in the Nashville area are generally headed in the right direction, or do you feel that things are off on the wrong track?



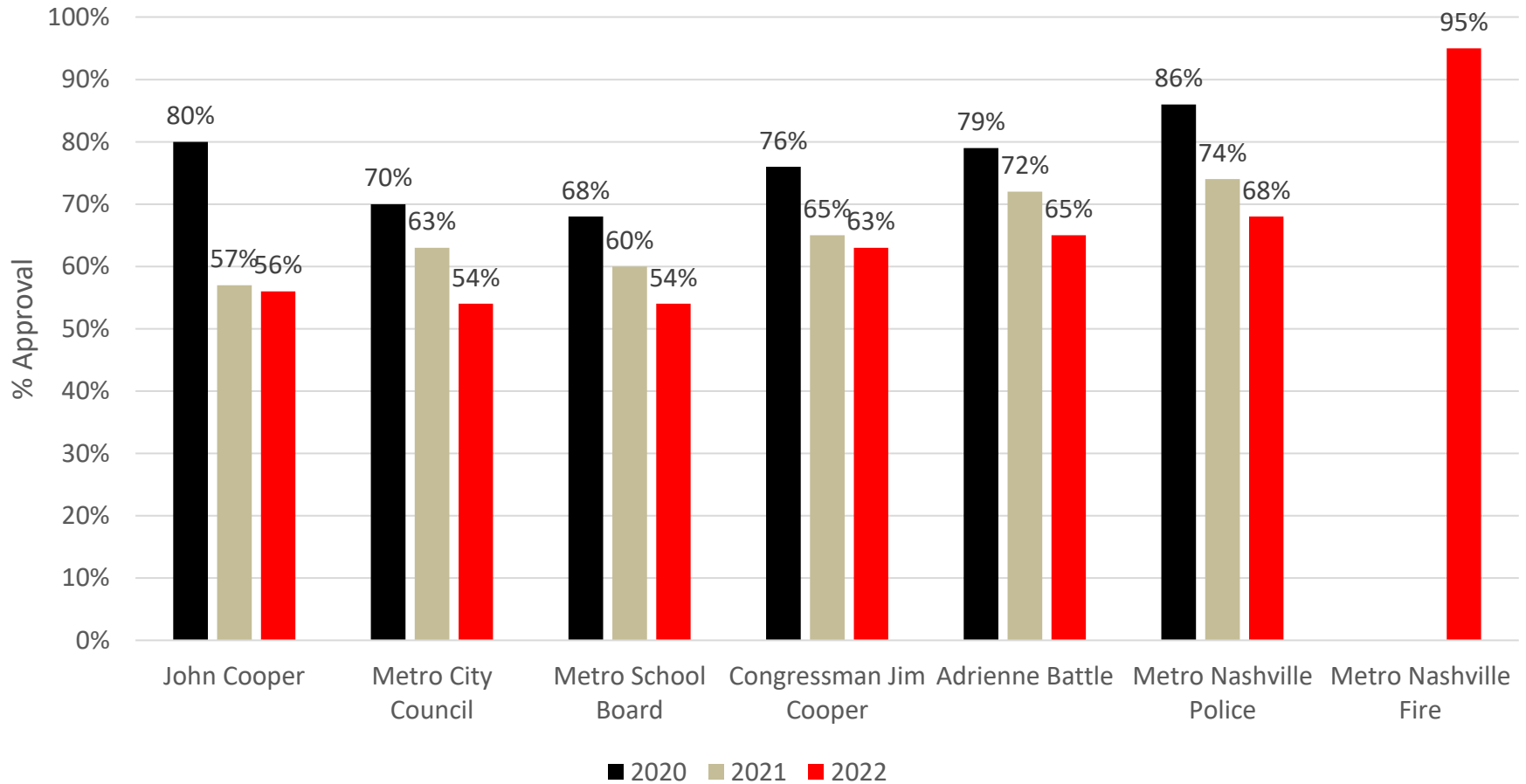
Opinion on Nashville's Economy Over Time



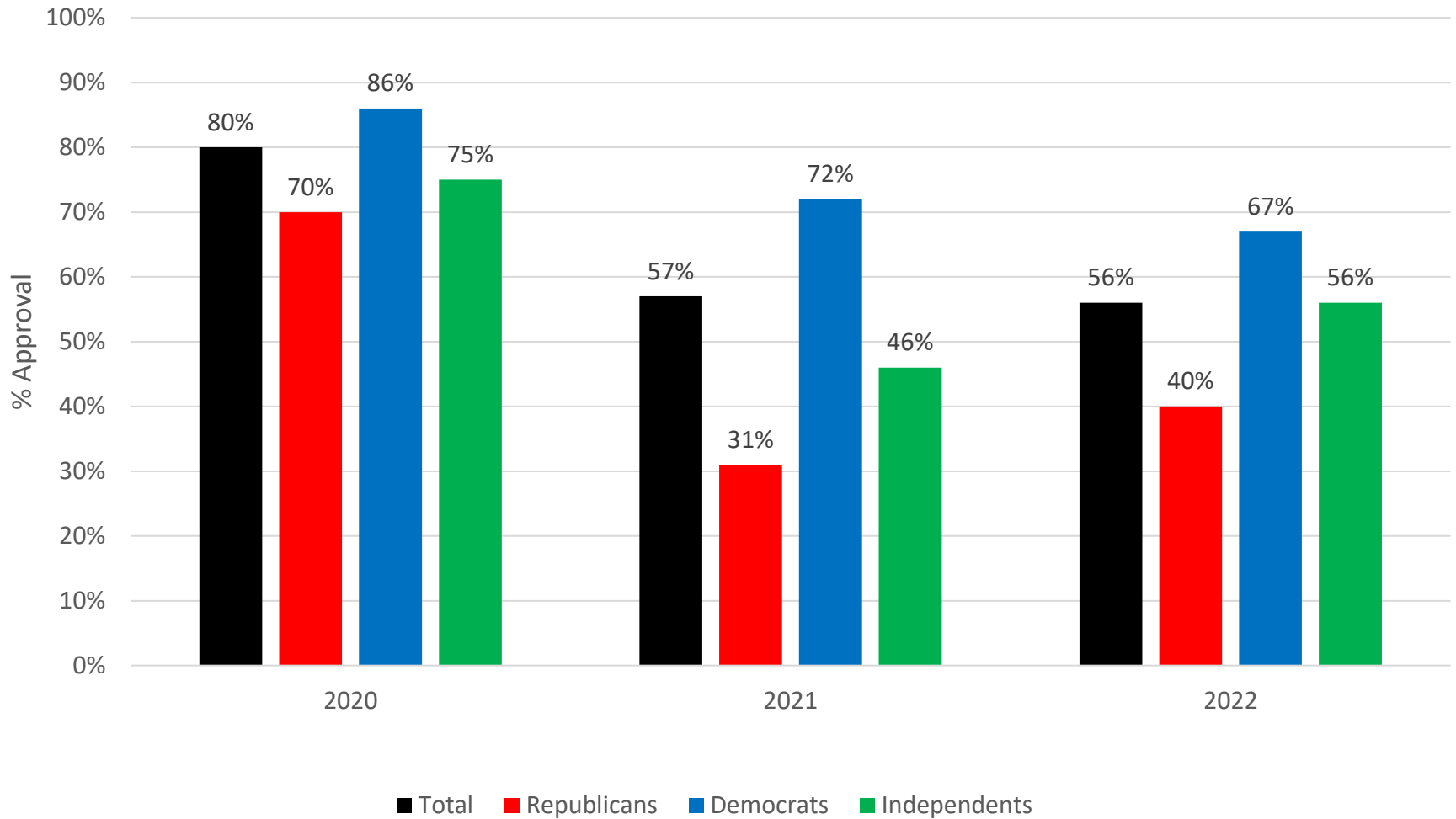
Opinion of Nashville's Economy by Income Level



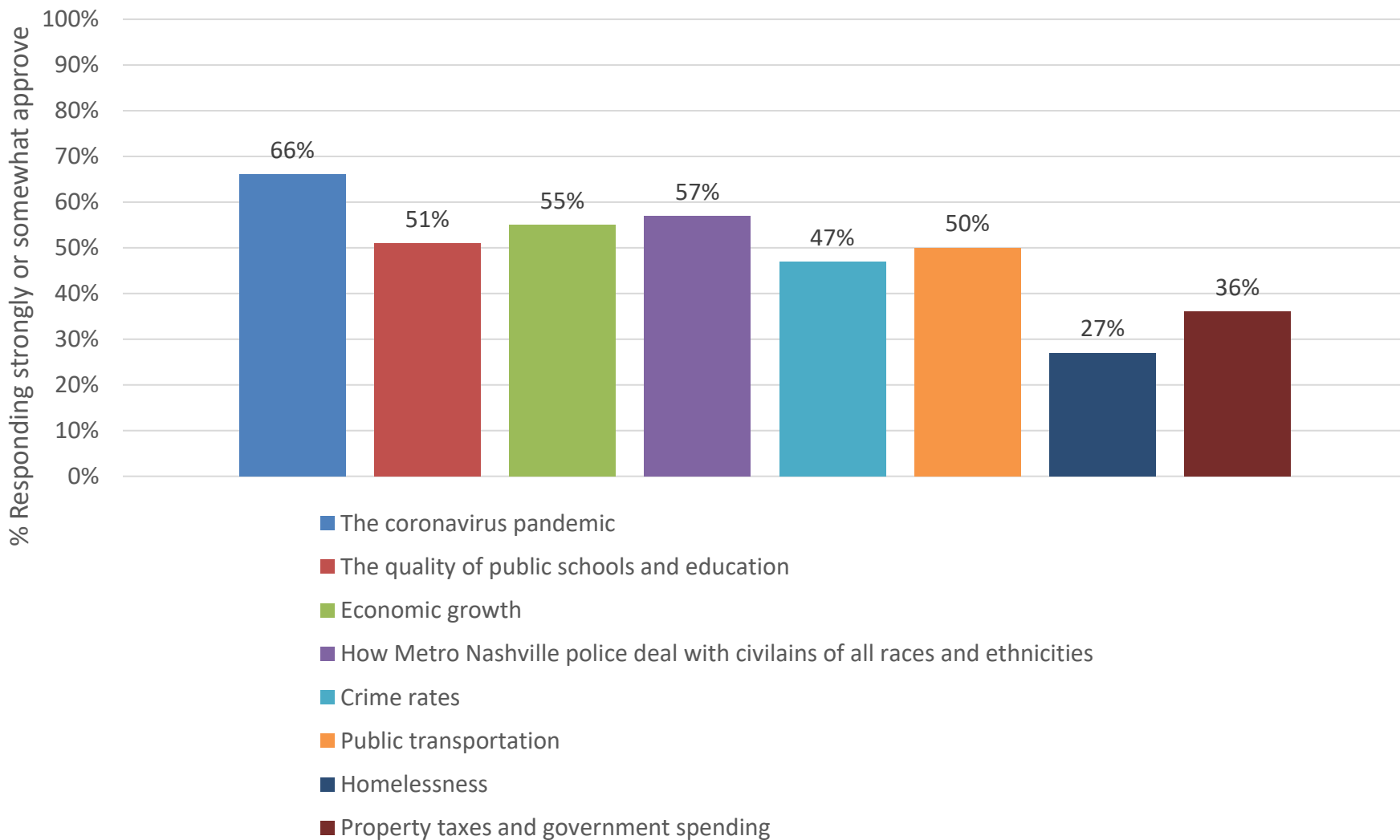
Approval of Nashville's Elected Officials, Institutions Over time



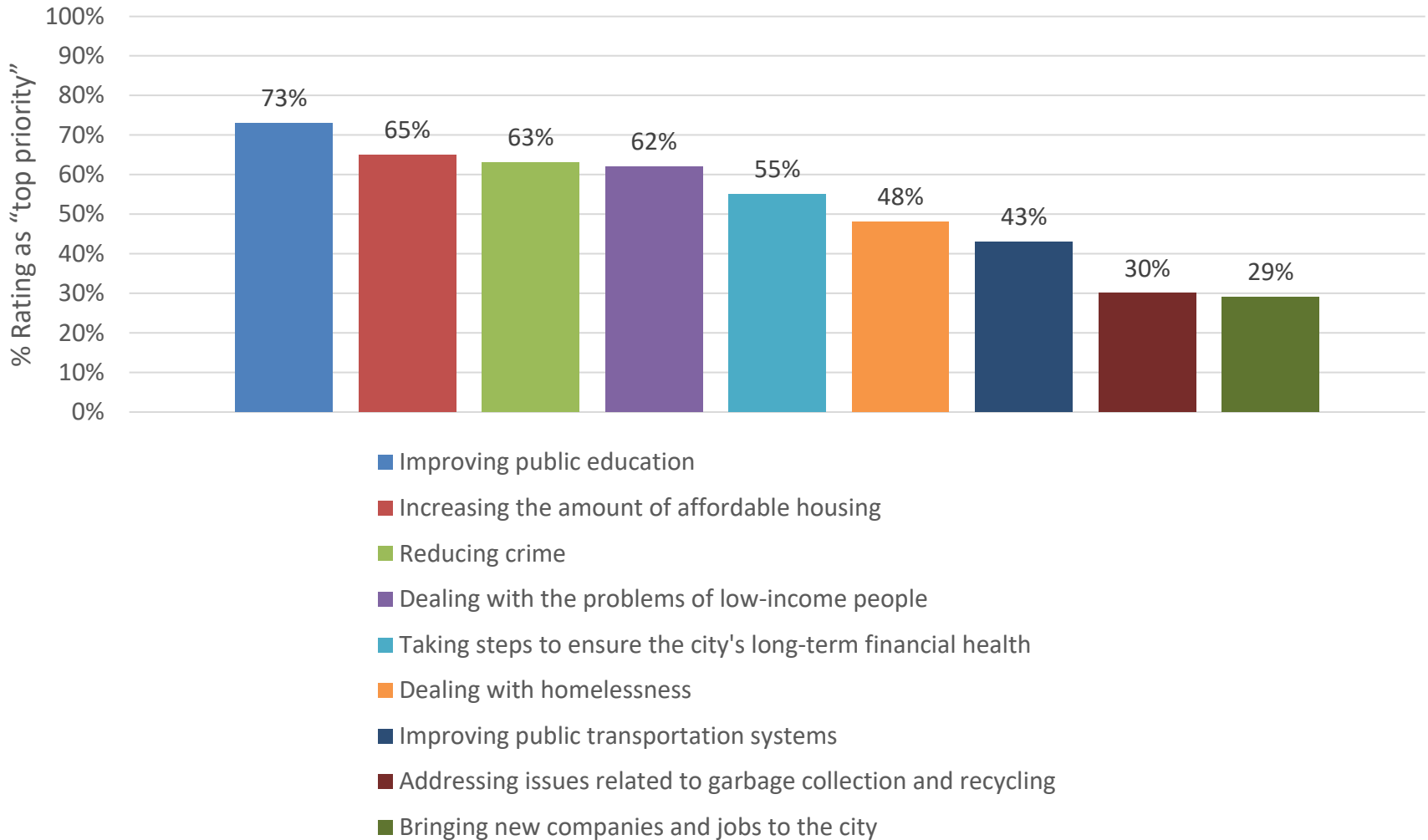
Approval of Mayor John Cooper by Party ID Over Time



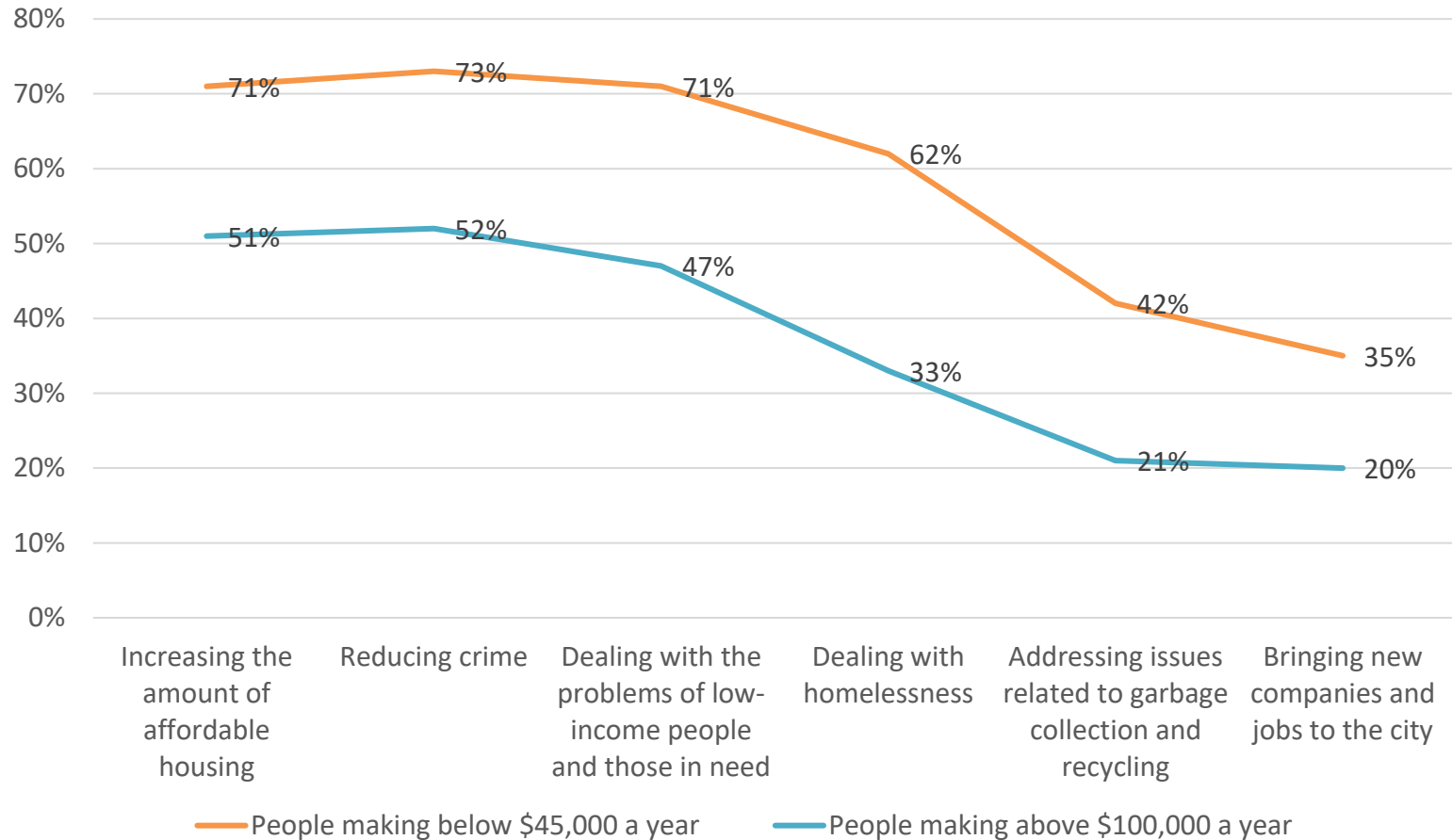
Opinions on How Mayor Cooper is Handling Specific Issues

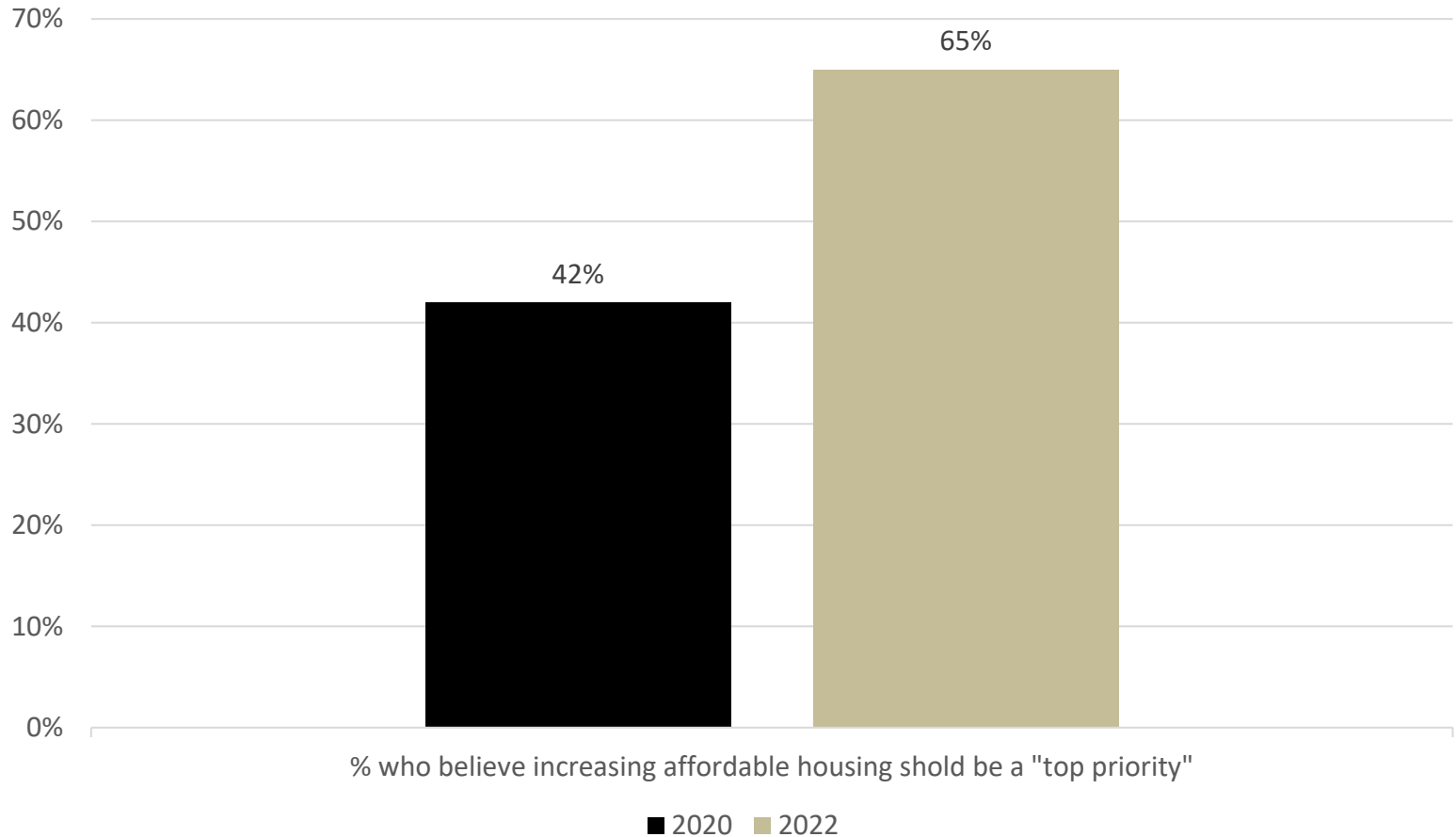


Opinion on What Should be Mayor's "Top Priorities" (largest gaps) by Income Level

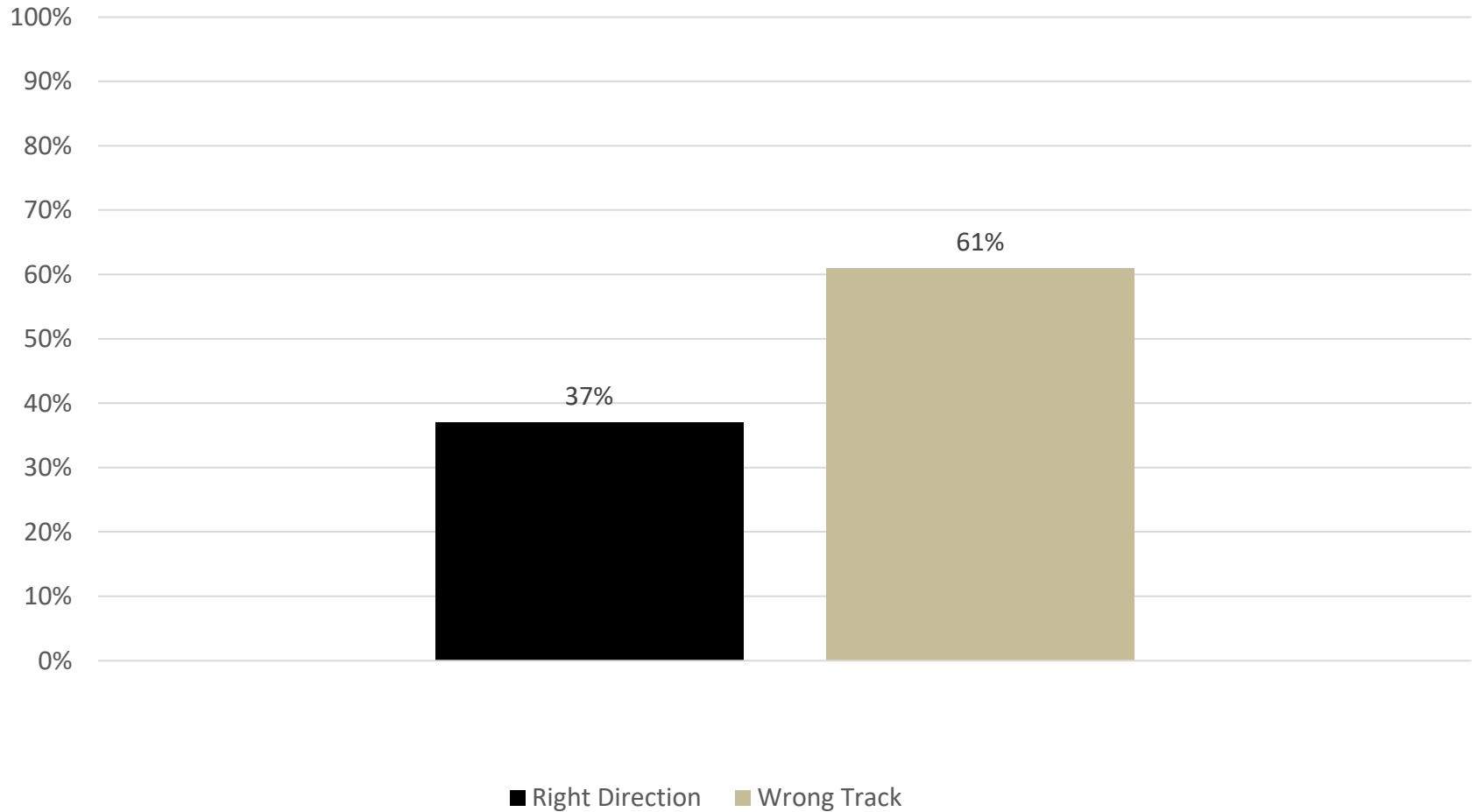


Increasing Affordable Housing as a “Top Priority” 2020/2022

How much of a priority do you think increasing the amount of affordable housing should be for Mayor Cooper?

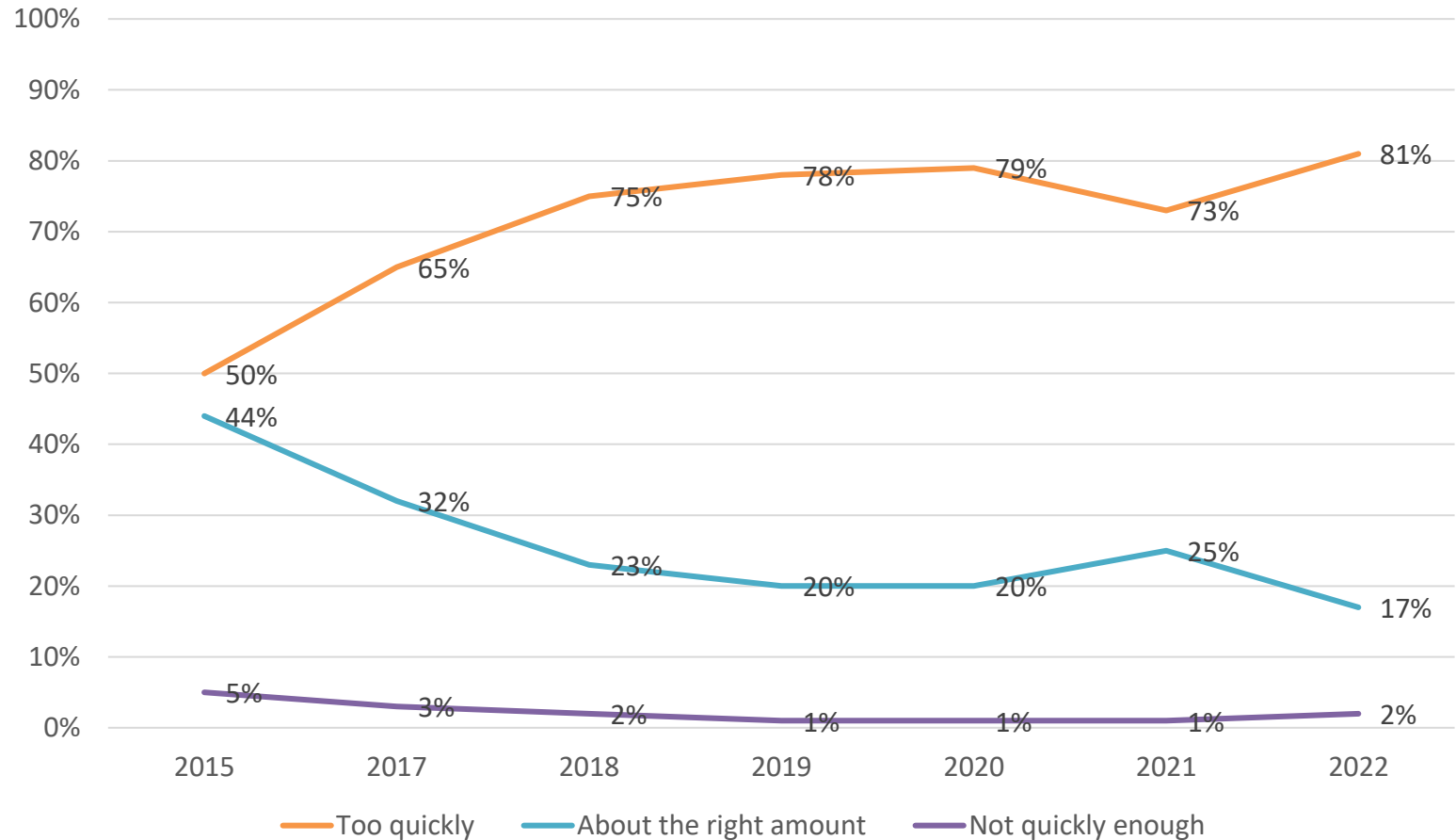


Opinions on whether Metro Nashville is Moving in the Right Direction or is on the Wrong Track by People who Plan to Move Away From the City

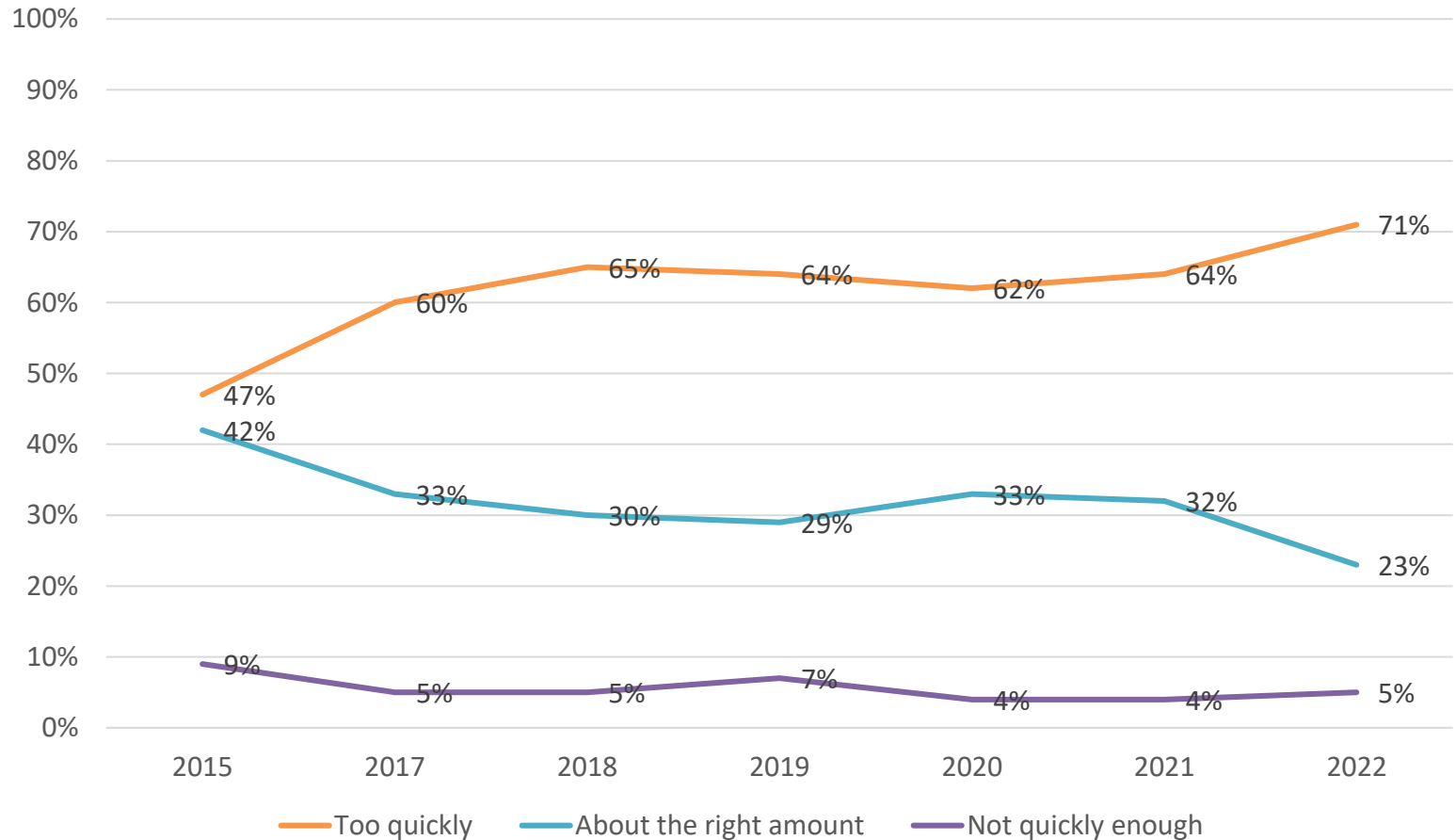

Opinion on Nashville's Population Growth Over Time

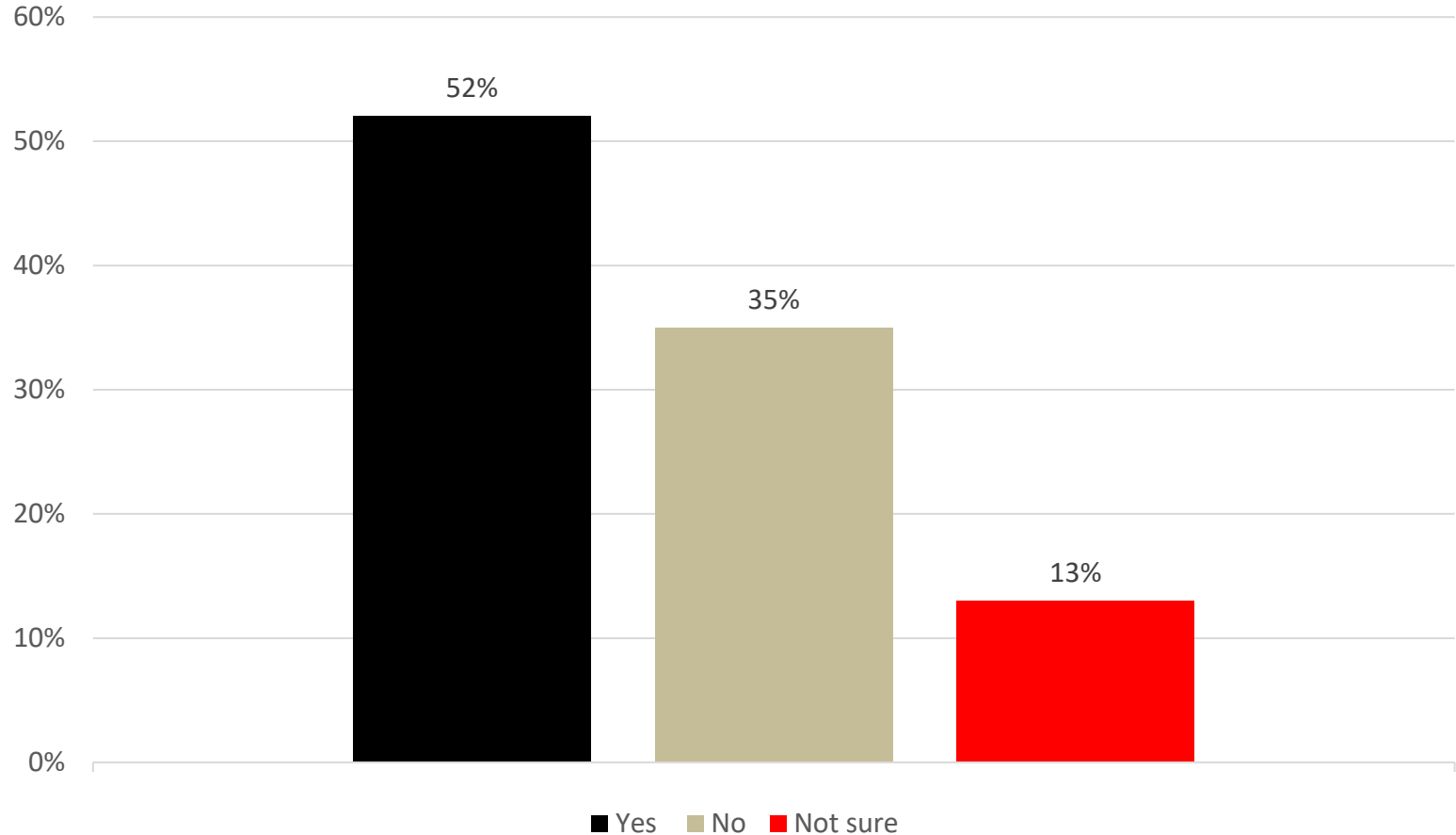


Opinion of Construction of New Buildings and Properties in Nashville Over Time



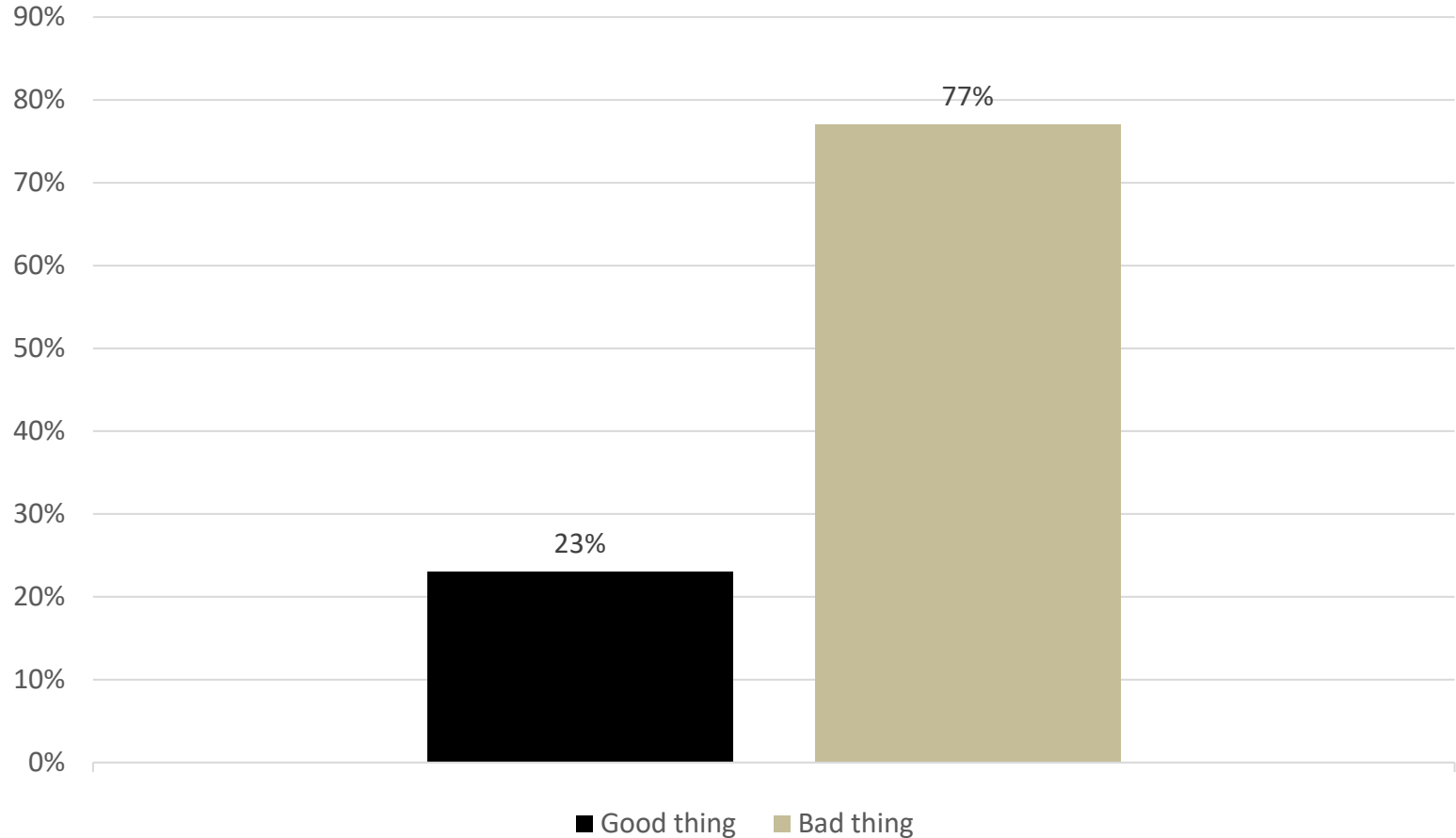
Observations on Neighborhood New Construction

Opinions on Neighborhood New Construction

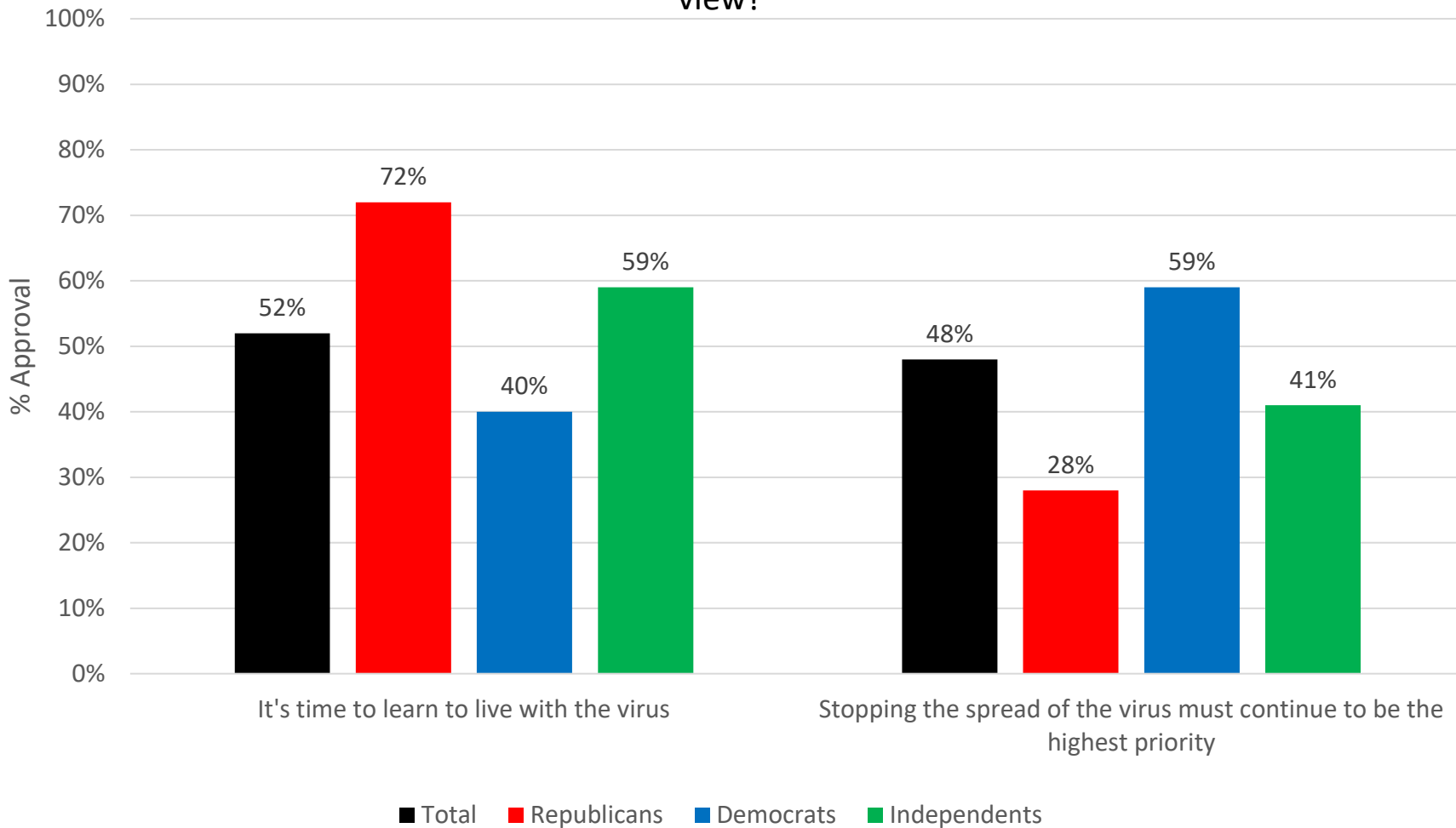
Do you think replacing older homes with bigger and more expensive homes is generally a good thing or a bad thing?

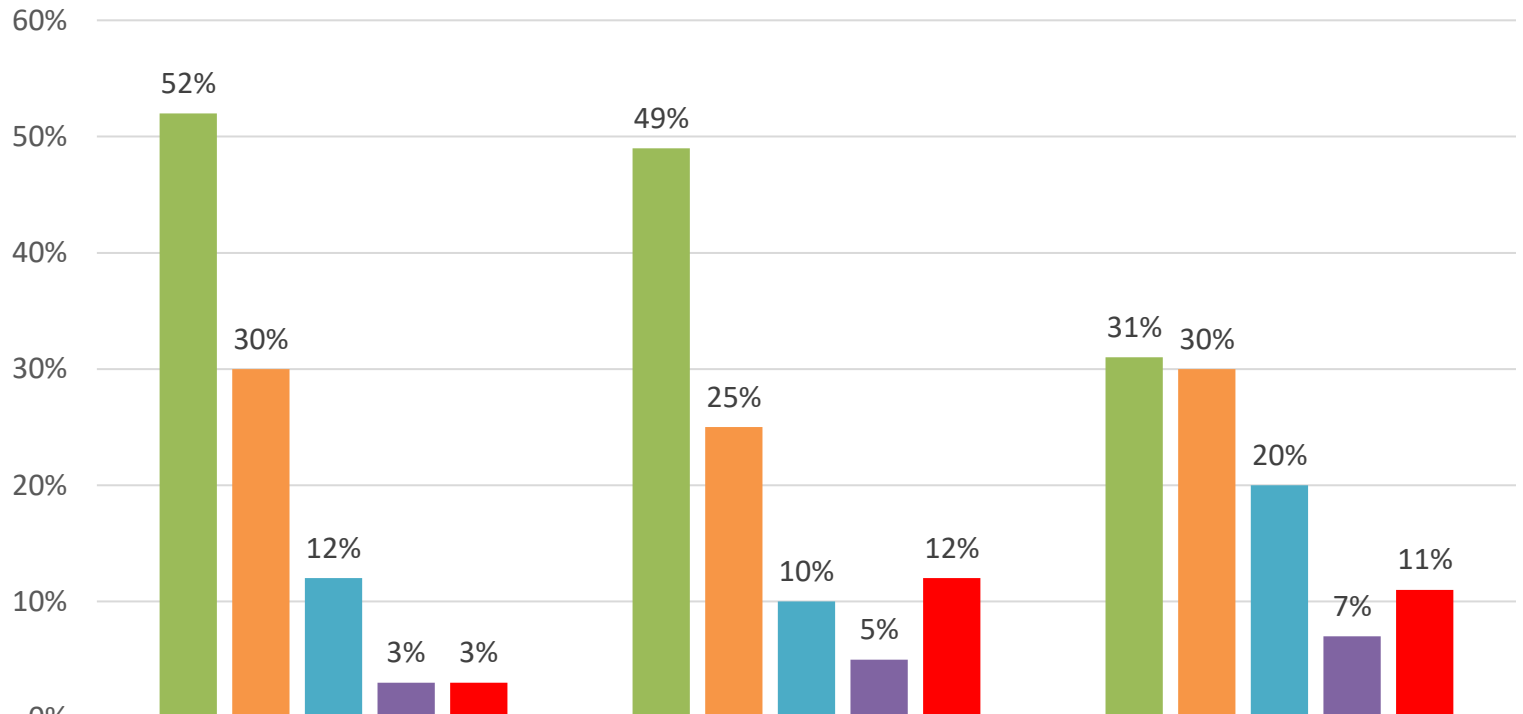
Opinions of Where We are With the Covid-19 Pandemic by Party ID

Concern for Contracting Coronavirus Over Time

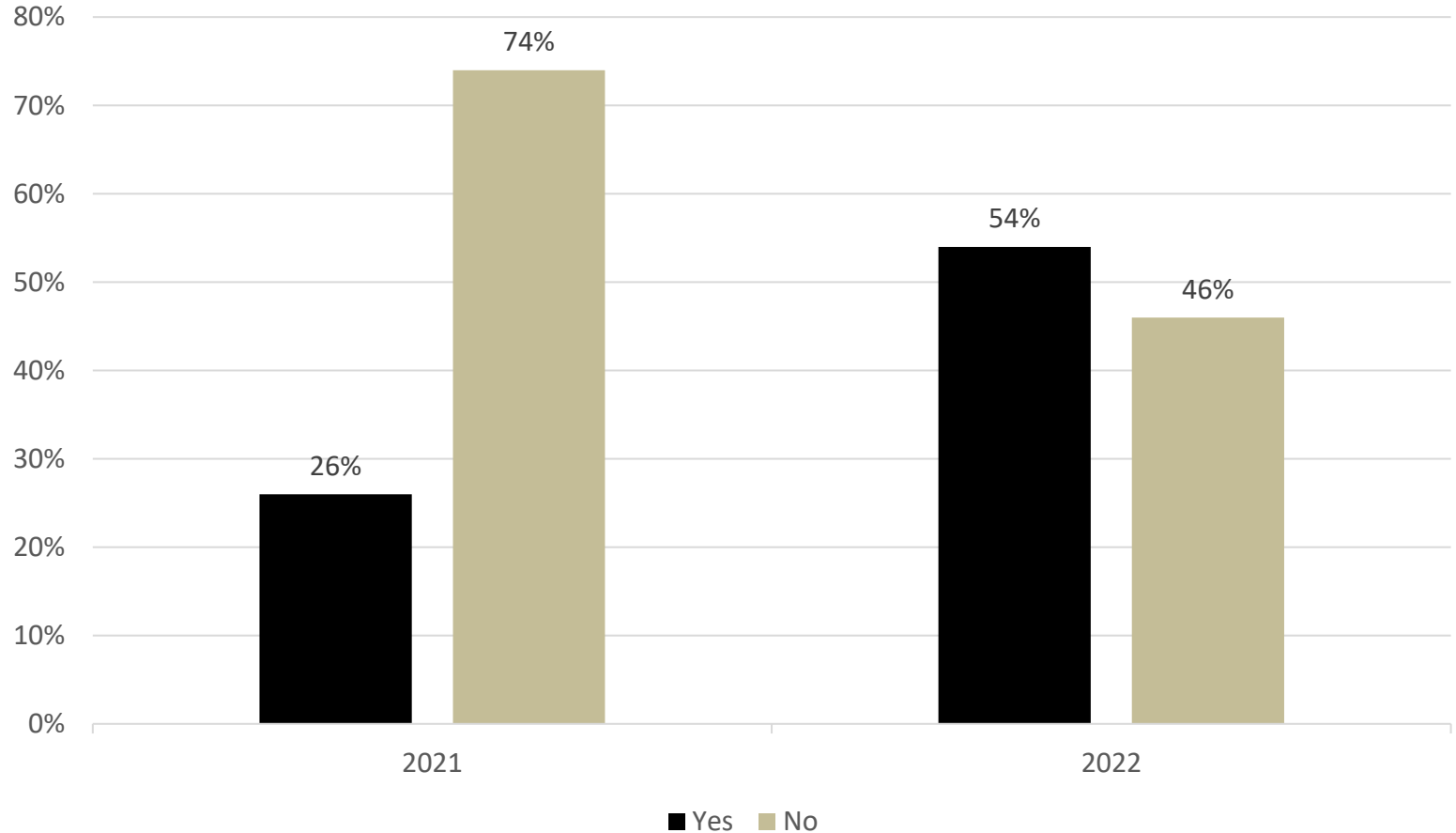
How concerned, if at all, are you that you or someone you know will get sick from the coronavirus?

Reporting of Covid Prevalence 2021-2022

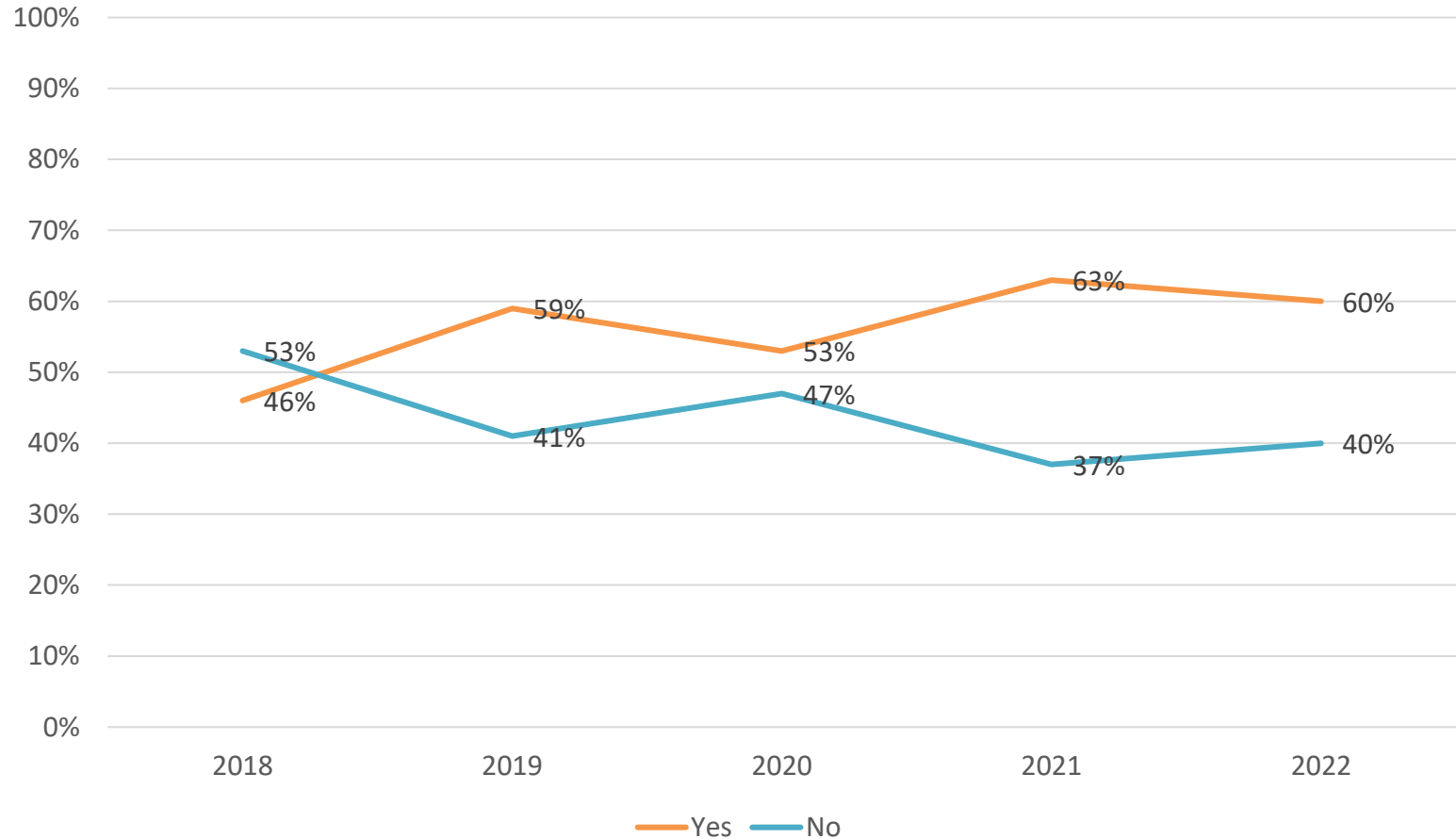

Fear of Crime Close to Home - Over Time

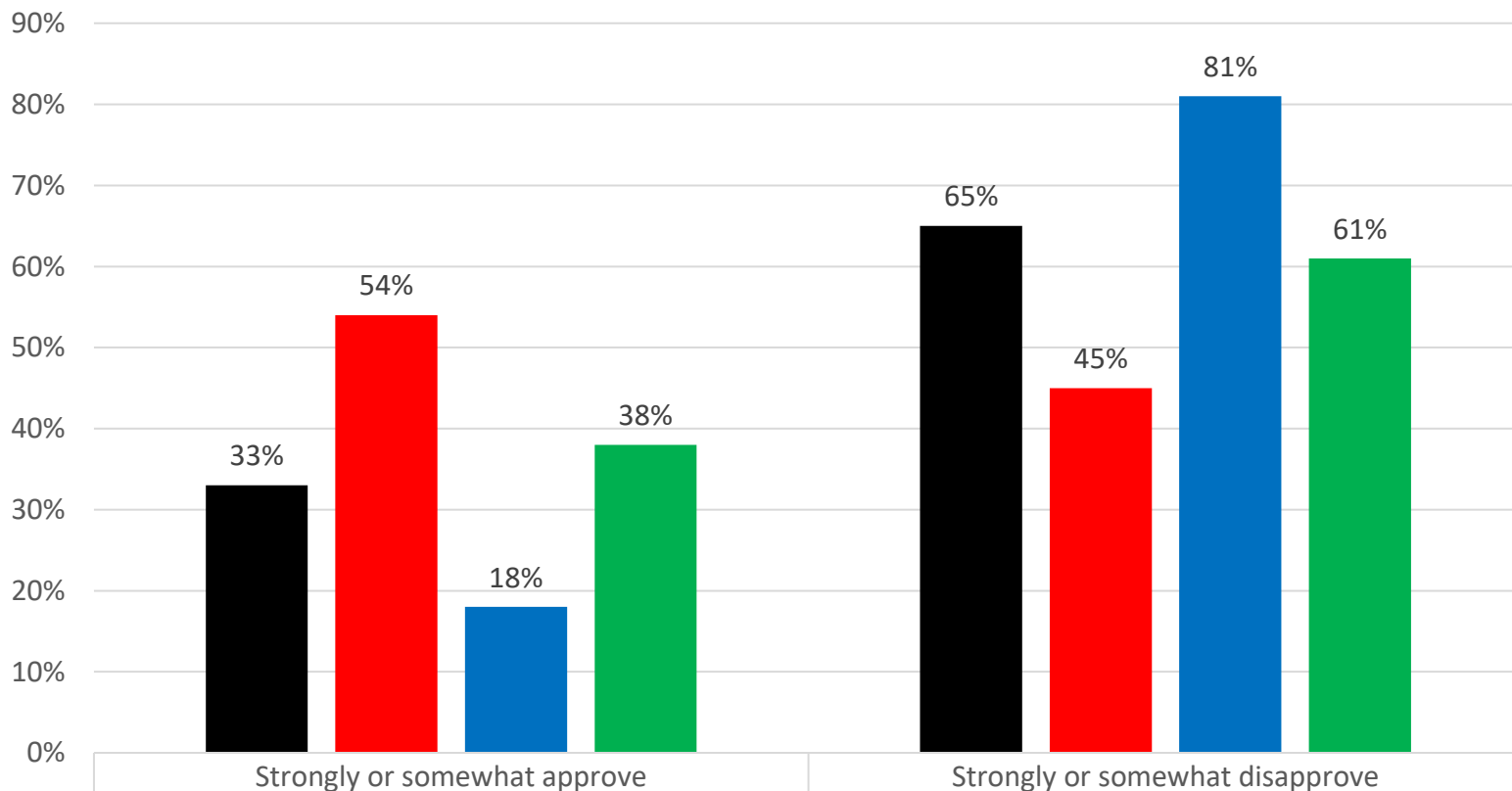
Is there any area near where you live – that is, within a mile or so - where you would be afraid to walk alone at night?



Opinions on Redrawing of 5th Congressional District by Party ID

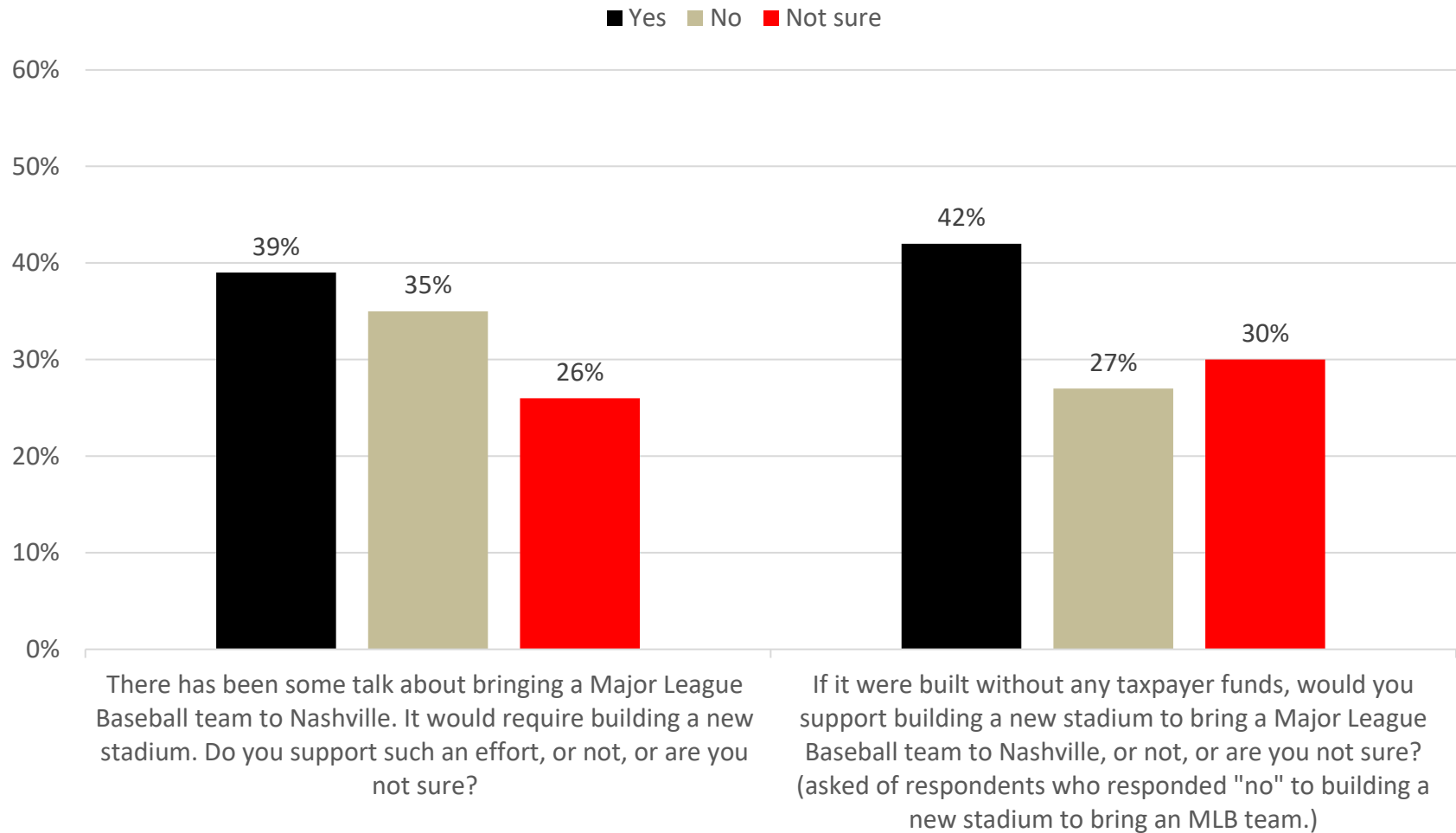
The state legislature redrew the congressional district covering Nashville and represented by Democrat Jim Cooper into 3 different districts by combining Davidson county with surrounding counties,

Do you support or oppose this change?



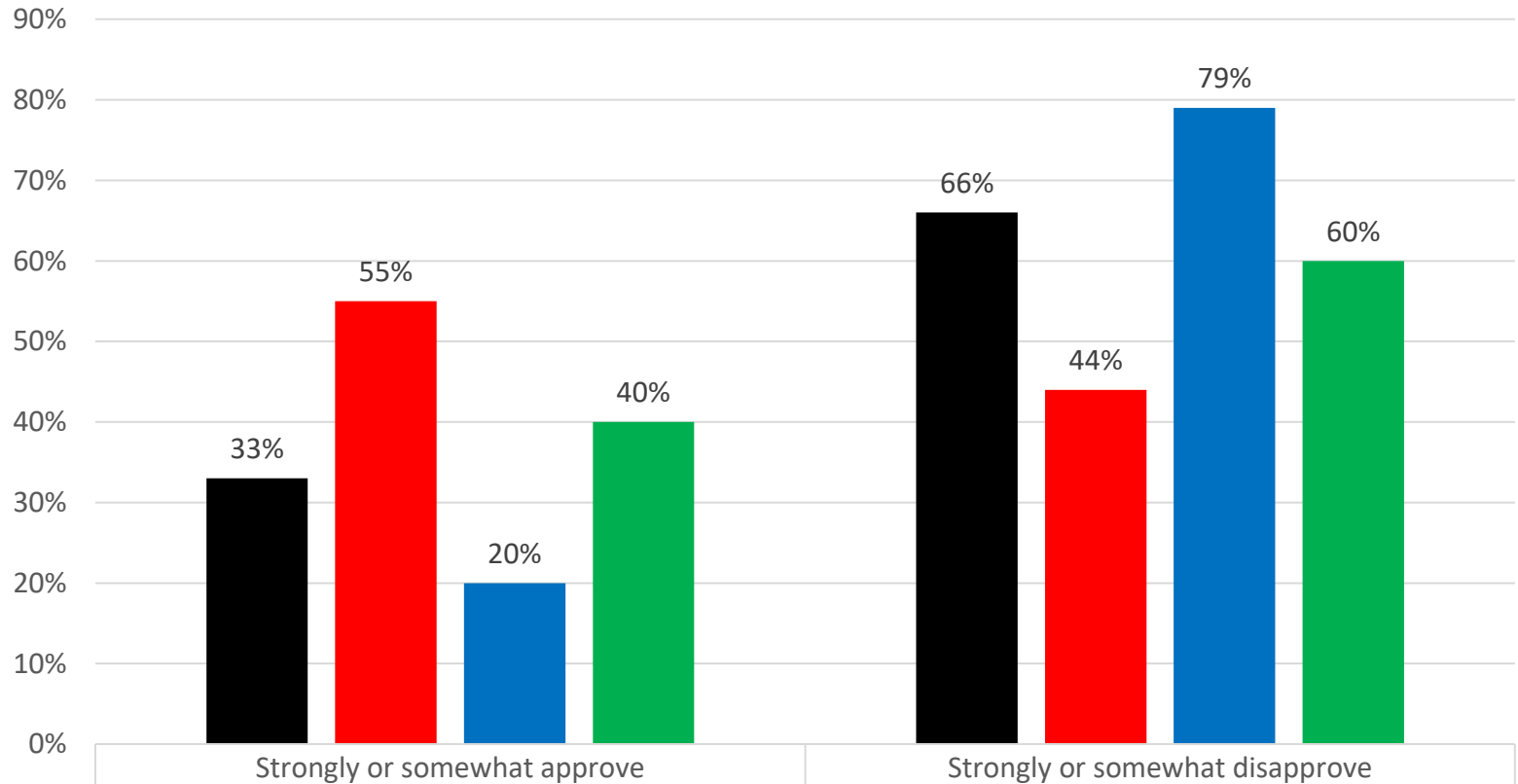

Opinions on Allowing Parents to Review and Remove Books From Public School Libraries by Party ID

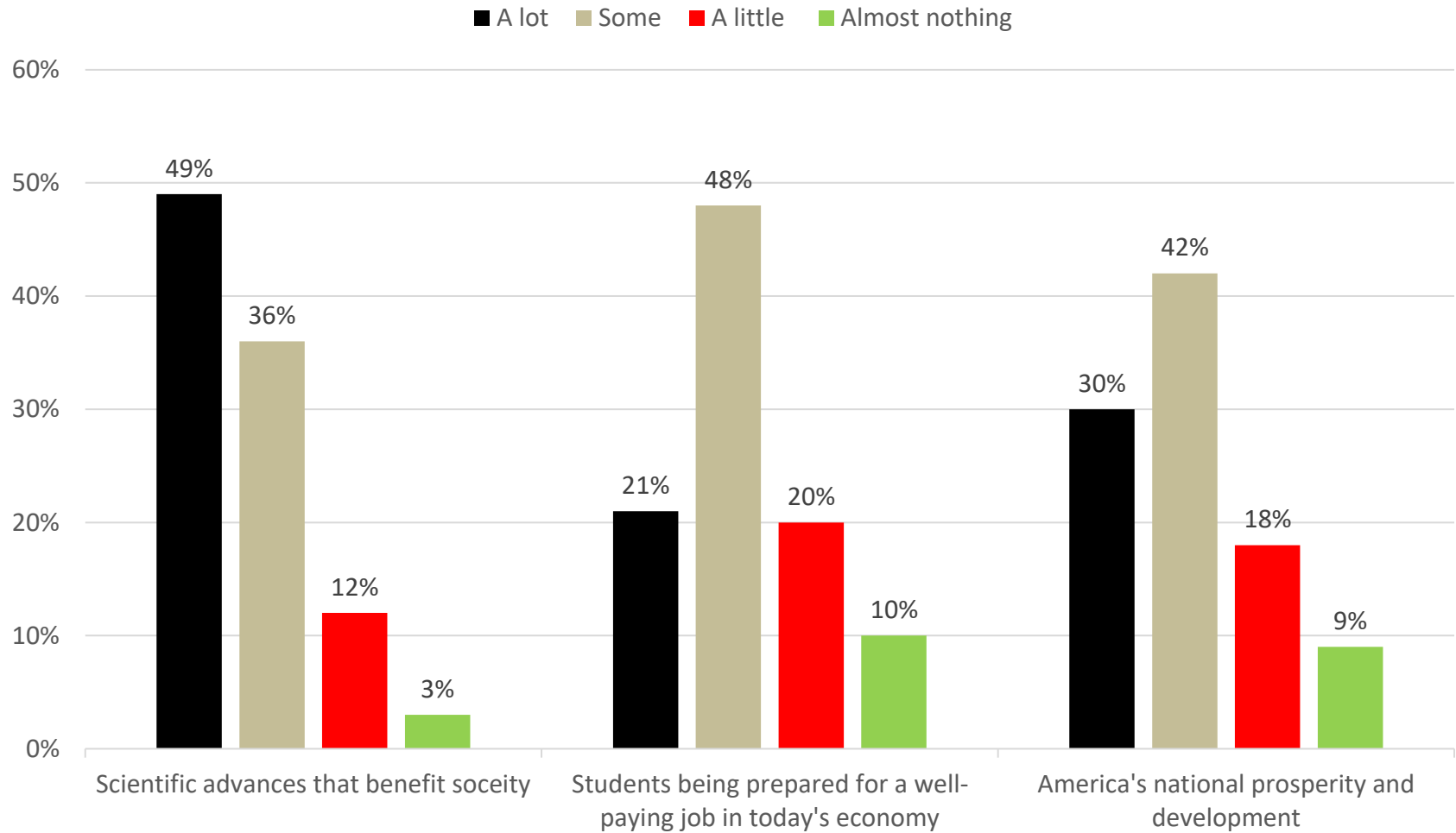
Do you approve or disapprove of policies that allow parents to review and remove books they find objectionable from public school libraries?

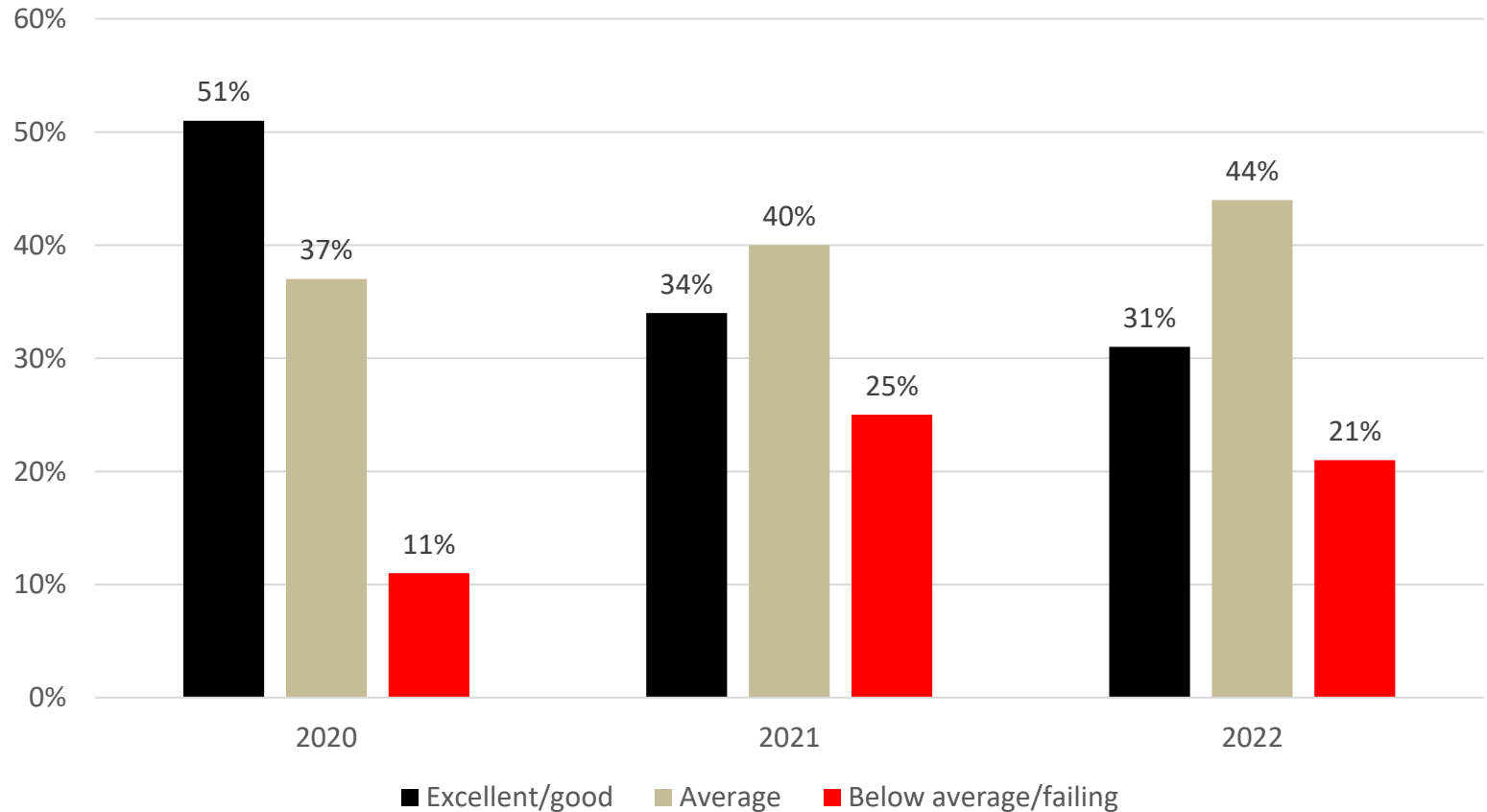
Opinions on America's Colleges and Universities

Now thinking about America's colleges and universities, how much do you think they contribute to each of the following?

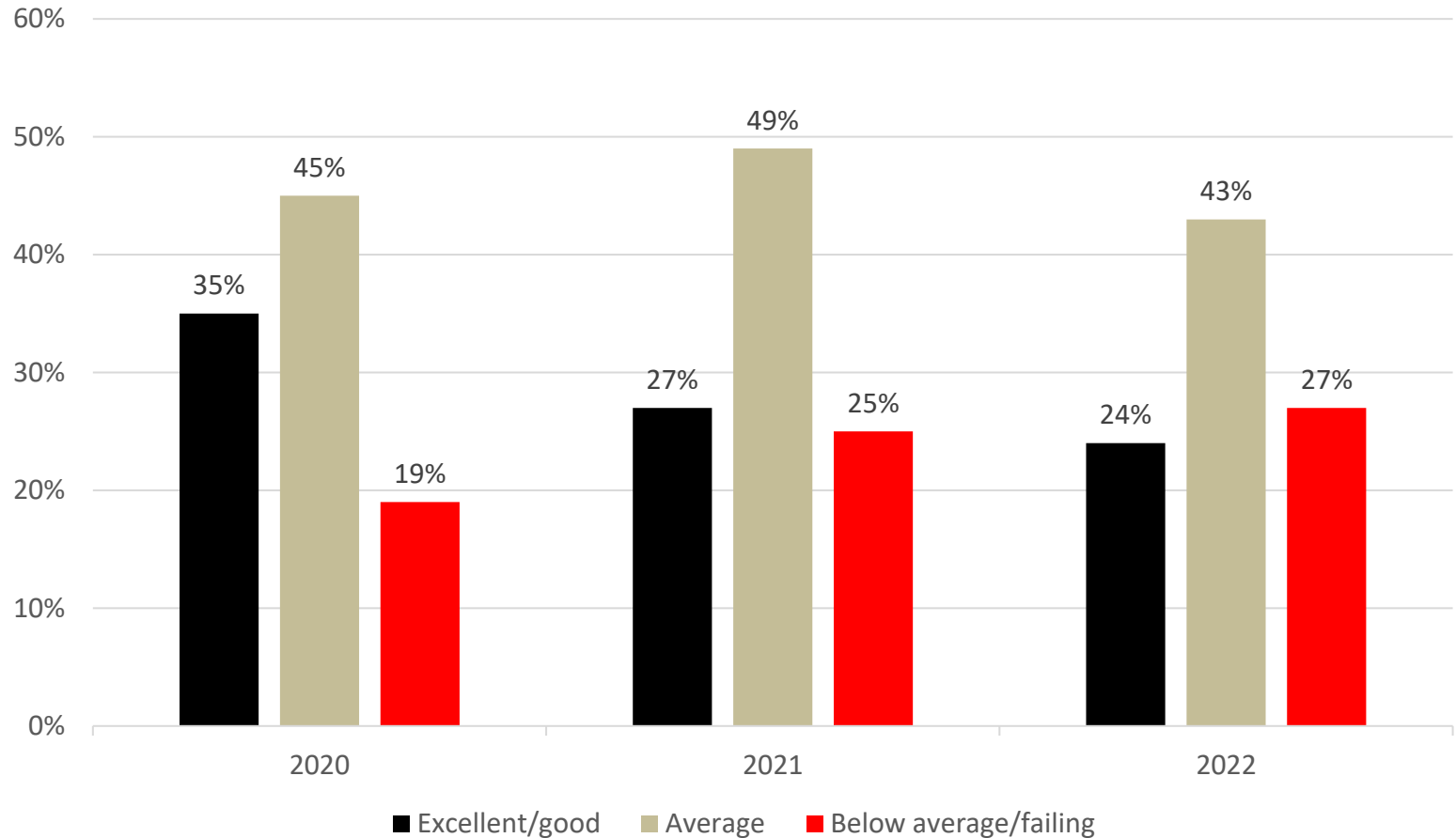
