








#### Tennessee "Right direction/Wrong track" by Party ID

Generally speaking, would you say things in Tennessee are going in the right direction, or do you think things have gotten off on the wrong track?






### Opinions on Proposal Ensuring Tennesseans Right to their Reproductive Health Decisions by Party ID

How much do you support or oppose a proposal in the state legislature that gives Tennesseans a fundamental right to their reproductive health decisions, including the use of contraceptives?





How much do you support or oppose a proposal in the state legislature that gives Tennesseans a fundamental right to their reproductive health decisions, including the use of contraceptives?




























How much do you support or oppose reducing federal funding for national parks, including the Great Smoky Mountains in Tennessee?










Thinking about your everyday life, how would you rate the current cost of living?


