




Approval of State Leaders by Party ID






Approval of President Trump Over Time by Party ID







Approval of President Trump by Community Type over Time





Top 3 Priorities of TN State Government Over Time


Which of the following do you think should be the top priority of the Tennessee state government? 80%







Top Priorities For Tennessee State Government by Party ID








Perceptions of the Economy

(% Responding "Good" or "Fairly Good")













Which of the following types of debt do you have, or not? (% Responding "Yes")










Types of Debt by Race








Concerns About Personal Debt by Party ID

Based on your total family income, how concerned are you right now about each of the following financial matters? Are you very worried, moderately worried, not too worried or not worried at all










Opinions on American Dream by Party ID

Which comes closer to your opinion?





Compared to five years ago, do you think things in your local community have:








Health Care Cost by Community Type/Gender

(% Responding Yes")








Local Problems by Party ID

How much of a problem, if at all, is each of the following in your local community? (Percent answering "Big Problem")












Views on Federal Funding Options for TennCare by Party ID













Views on Roe Versus Wade by Party ID








Views on Nathan Bedford Forrest Bust by Party ID








Views on Tobacco Laws by Party ID

Would you support or oppose raising the legal age to buy cigarettes and other tobacco products from age 18 to age 21 in Tennessee?








Concerns about Health Care Cost by Community Type

In the past 12 months, have you put off or postponed getting health care you needed because of the cost?




