


#### Nashville - Right Direction or Wrong Track Over Time

Do you think things in the Nashville area are generally headed in the right direction, or do you feel that things are off on the wrong track?











#### Opinion on Nashville's Economy Over Time


How would you rate the condition of the Nashville economy these days?










#### Approval of Mayor Freddie O'Connell by Party ID











Given the recent disagreements between Nashville's elected officials and the state legislature, which statement comes closer to your view?








#### Opinion on Nashville's Population Growth Over Time




Which of the following statements about multifamily housing, such as duplexes, townhouses, and apartment buildings, comes closer to your view, even if neither is exactly right?









% responding strongly or somewhat support






# Views on Deportation of Illegal Immigrants WITHOUT a Criminal Record by Party ID

How much do you support or oppose deporting individuals who are living in the United States illegally back to their home countries even if they have no criminal record unrelated to their immigration status?





#### Time Spent in Weekday Traffic Each Day


On a typical weekday, how much total time do you spend in traffic?





#### Reports of "Road Rage" Incidents


When driving in Nashville, how often do you come across "road rage" – instances in which other drivers are operating their vehicles in aggressive or unsafe ways?

How much do you approve of the use of scooters to get around Nashville?






#### Approval of Scooters by Income










### Opinions on a Later Start for Nashville's Public High Schools

Nashville's public high schools currently start classes at 7am – the earliest in the nation. Would you support shifting the public school day to start and end later?








# Opinions on Revitalization Plans For the Nashville Fairgrounds


