



TN Ideological Composition: Perceived vs. Actual










Preferences for Partisan Compromise by Party ID



Approval of Leaders Over Time





Trump Approval Over Time










Views on Trump's Truthfulness










Future of the Health Care System Over Time










Views on whether the State/Federal Government Should Contribute More Funding to Keep Rural Hospitals Open








Views on Children of Undocumented Immigrants and In-State Tuition — May/December





Name Recognition of Potential Candidates for Governor Spring -Fall





Name Recognition of Candidates for Governor by Region



Name Recognition of Senate Candidates










Top 3 Priorities of TN State Government Over Time

Which of the following do you think should be the top priority of the Tennessee state government? 80%


