



Among TN Registered Voters





Among TN Registered Voters







#### Among TN Registered Voters



## Approval of Republican Governors
















## Top Priority of TN State Government Over Time










# Favorability of Affordable Care Act Over Time by Partisanship














## Views on Same-Sex Marriage Over Time
















## Views on Marijuana Legalization






## Views on Marijuana Legalization by Age






#### Concern of Use or Sale of Meth

How concerned are you about the use or sale of methamphetamines—also known as crystal meth—where you live?














