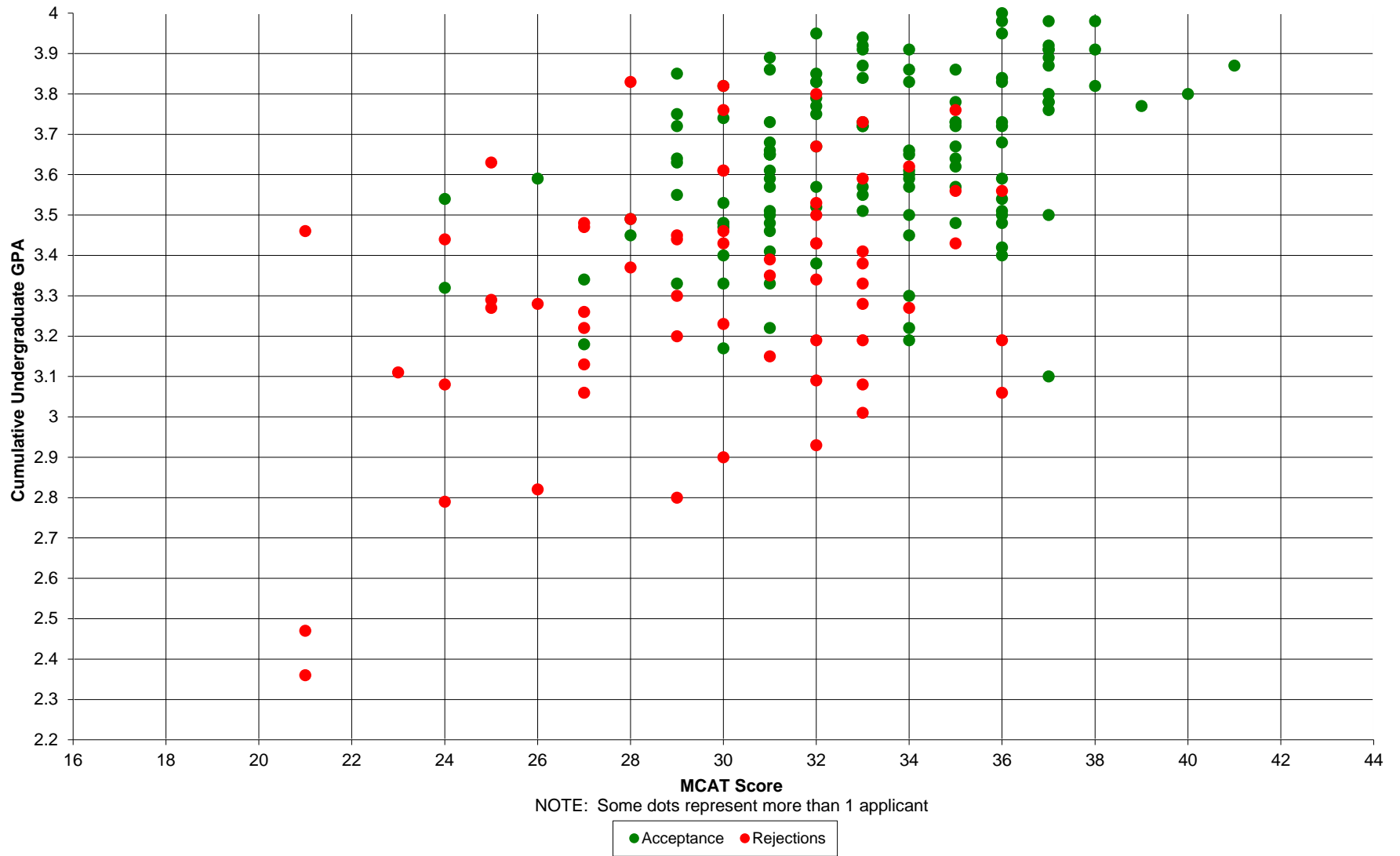

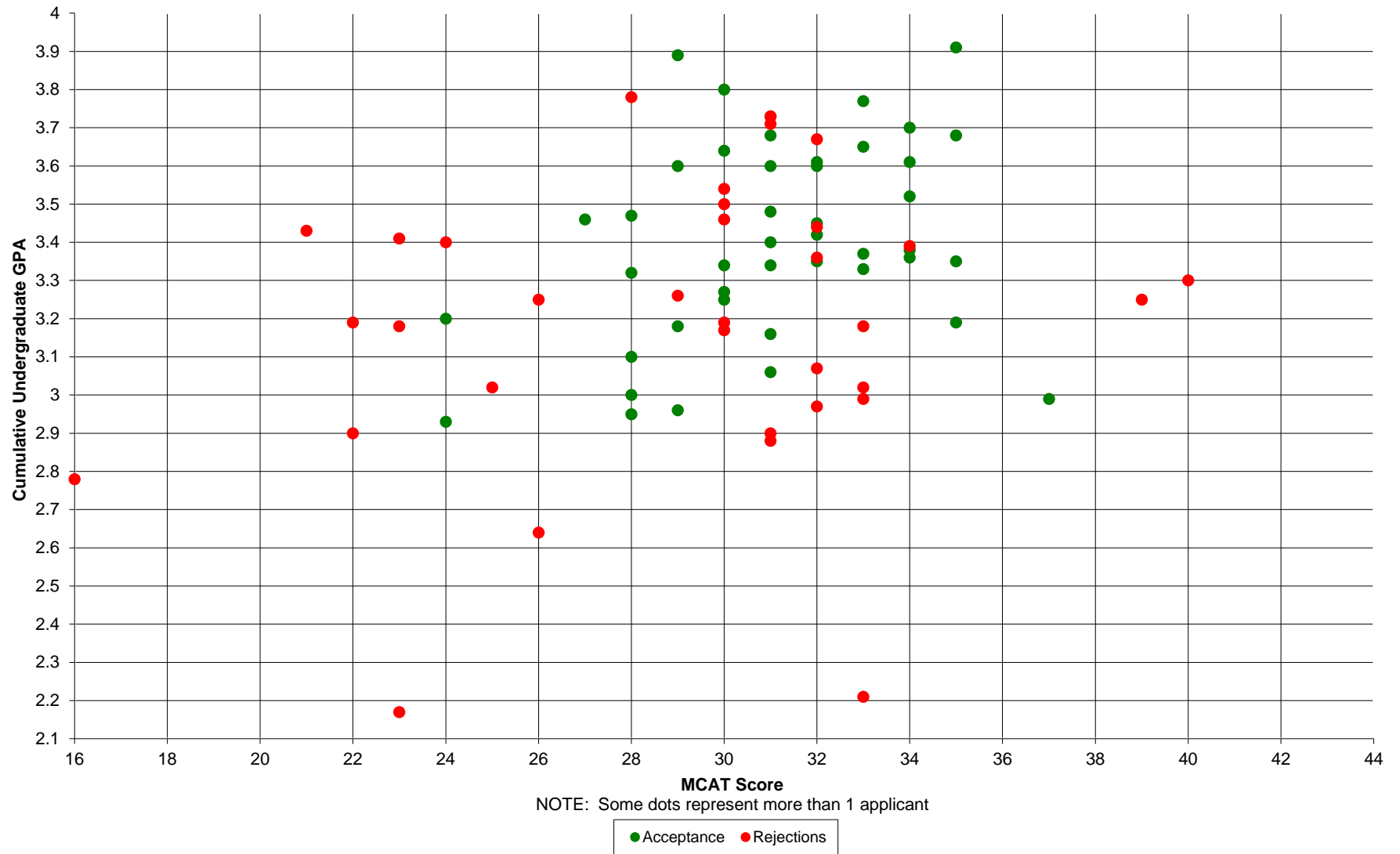

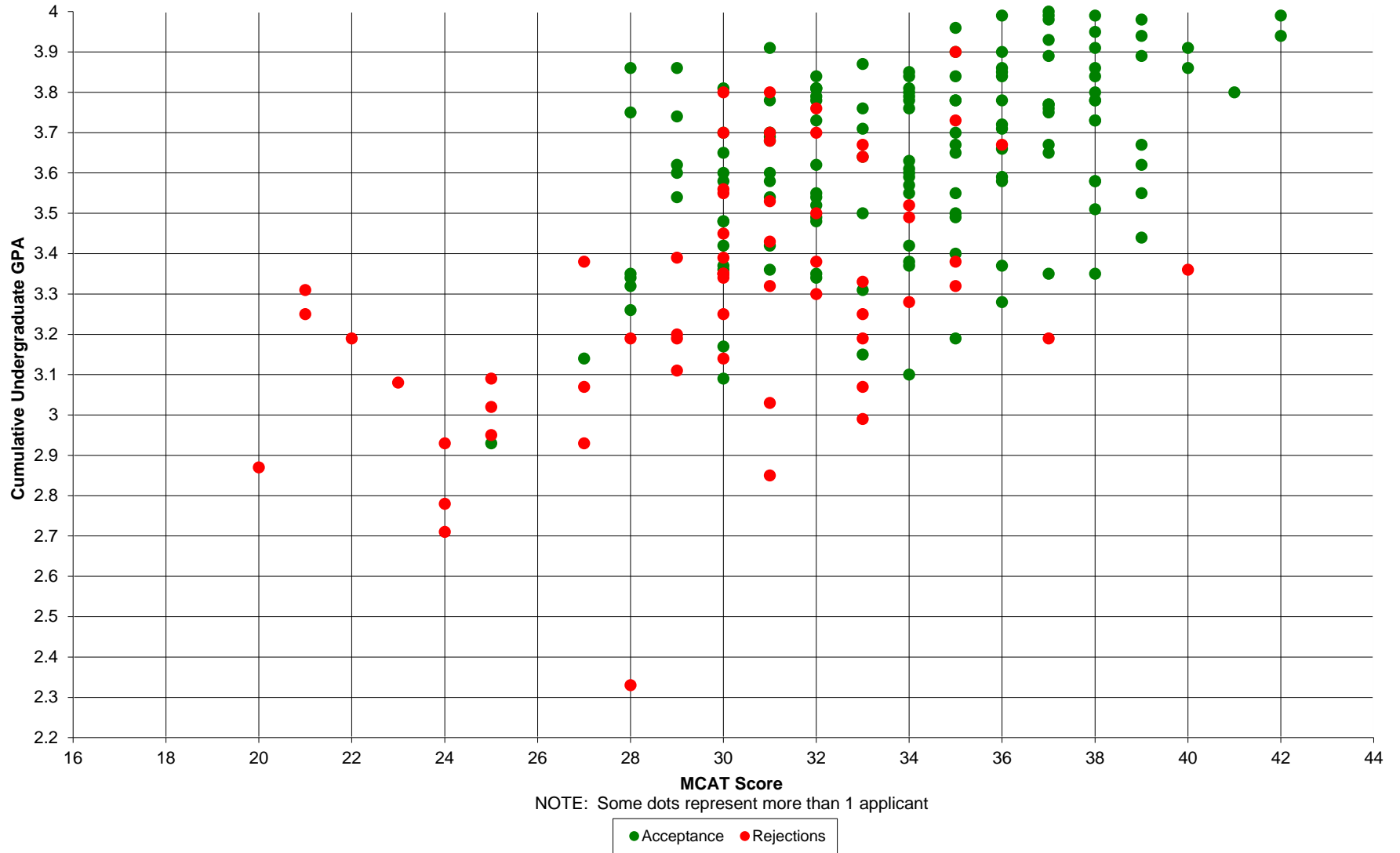
2014 Allopathic First Time Applicants



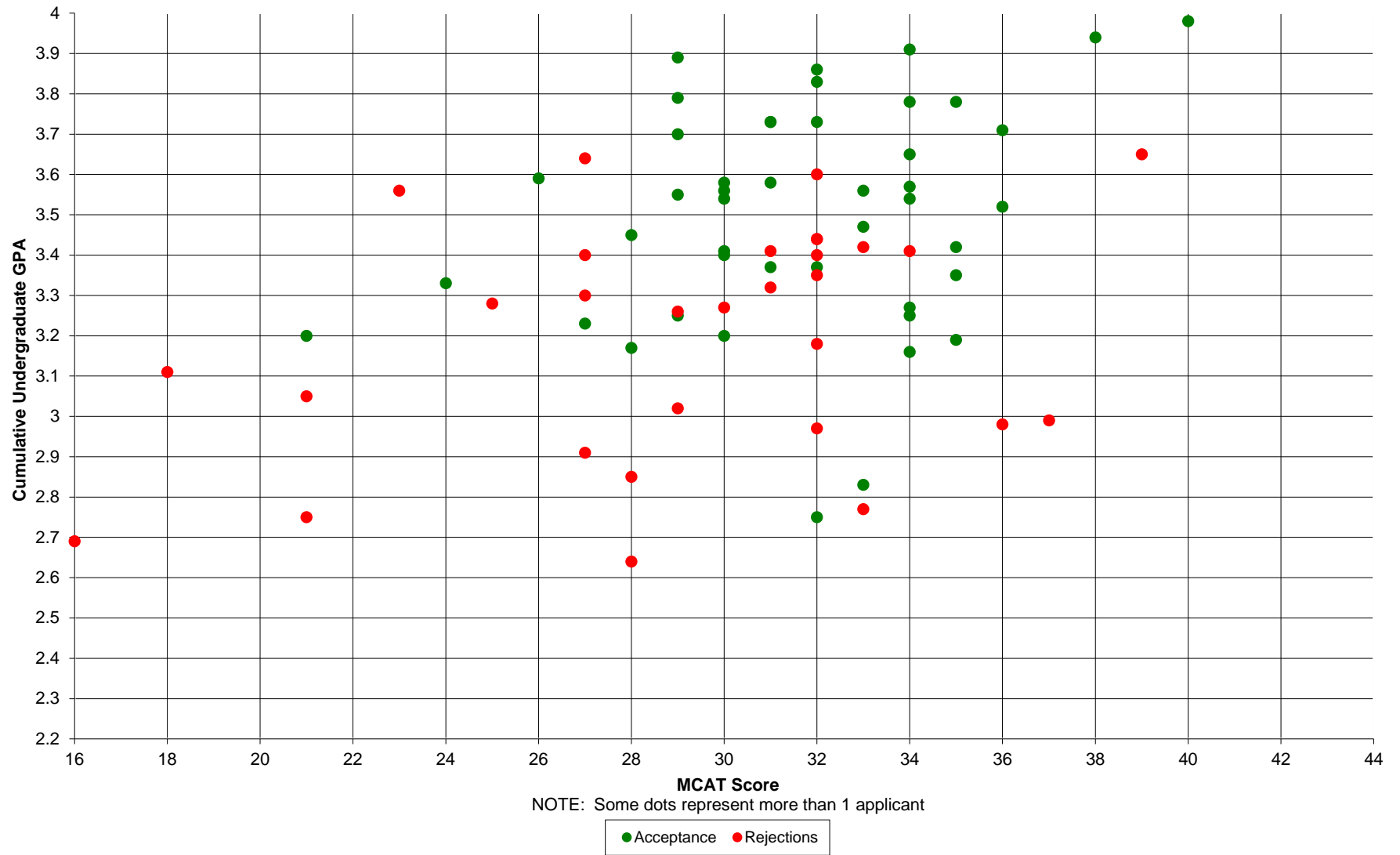
2014 Allopathic Re-Applicants



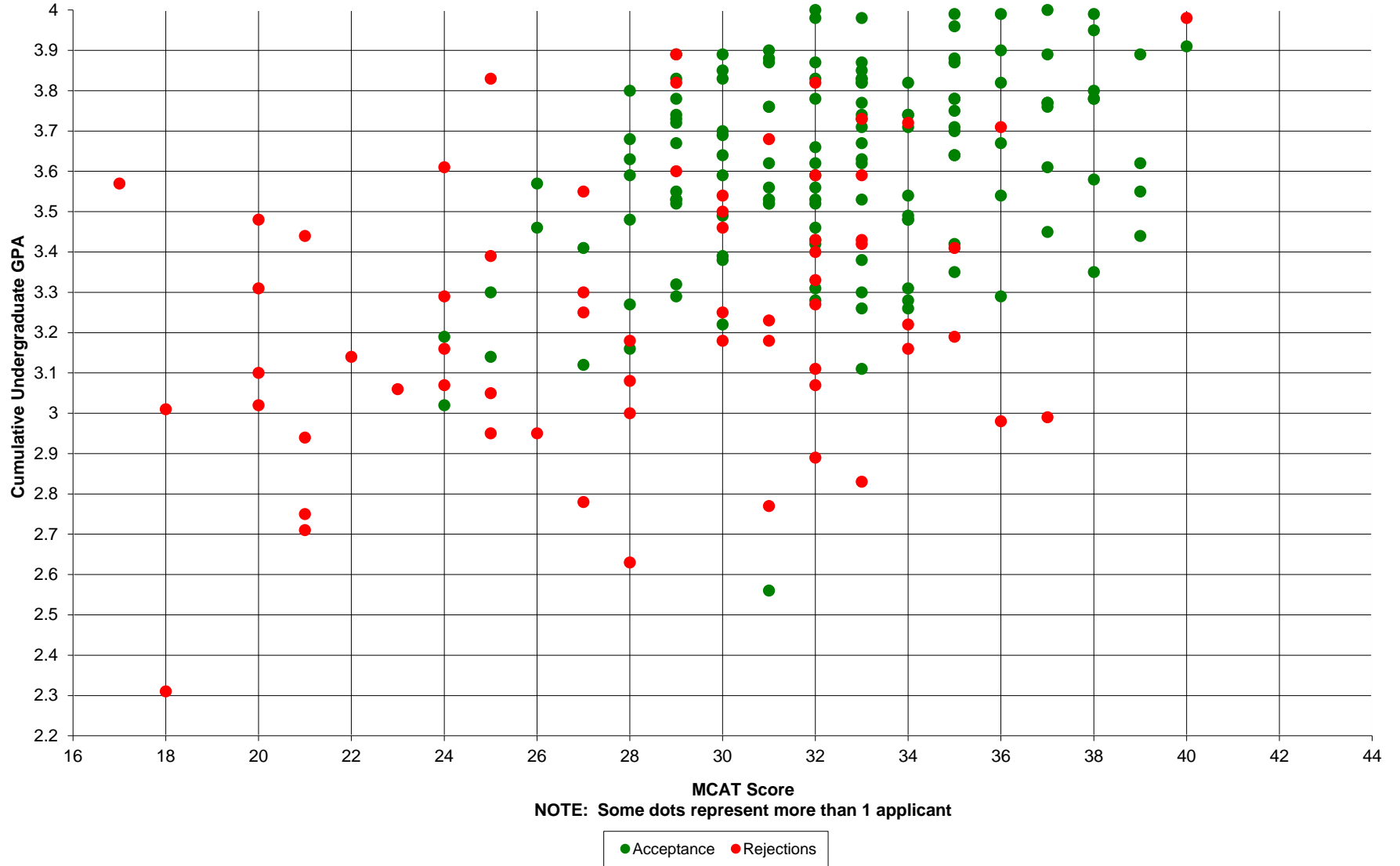
2013 Allopathic First Time Applicants



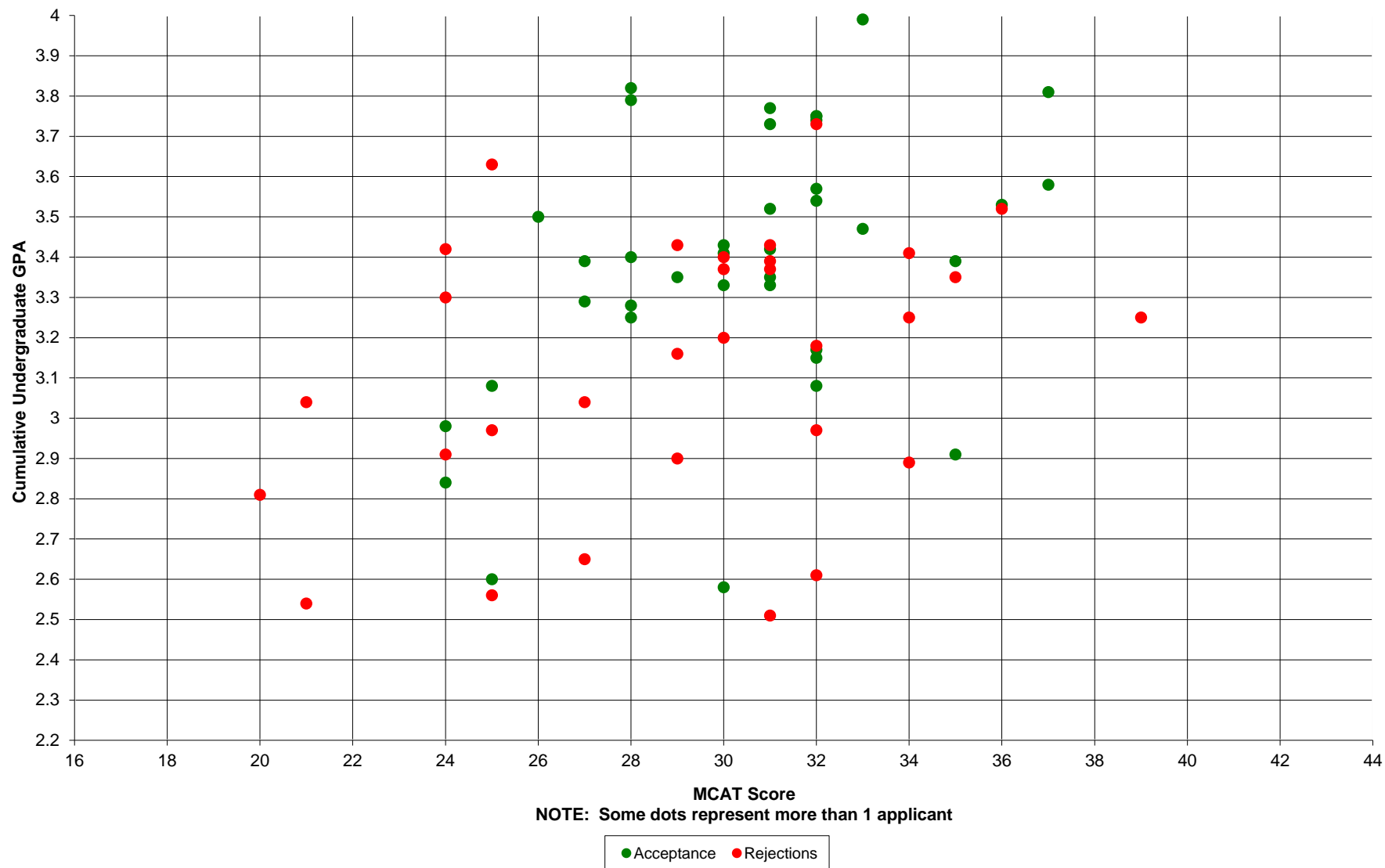

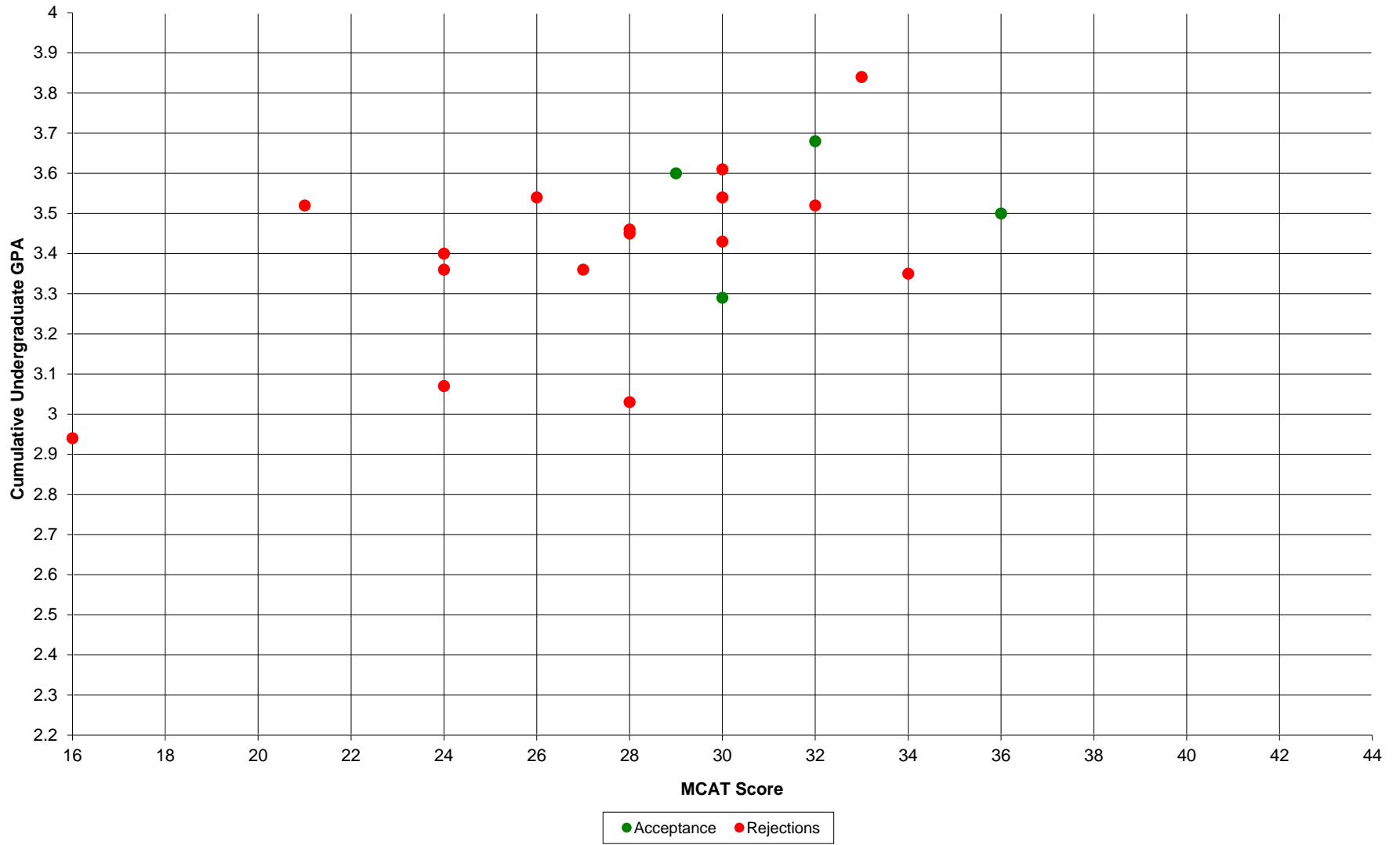

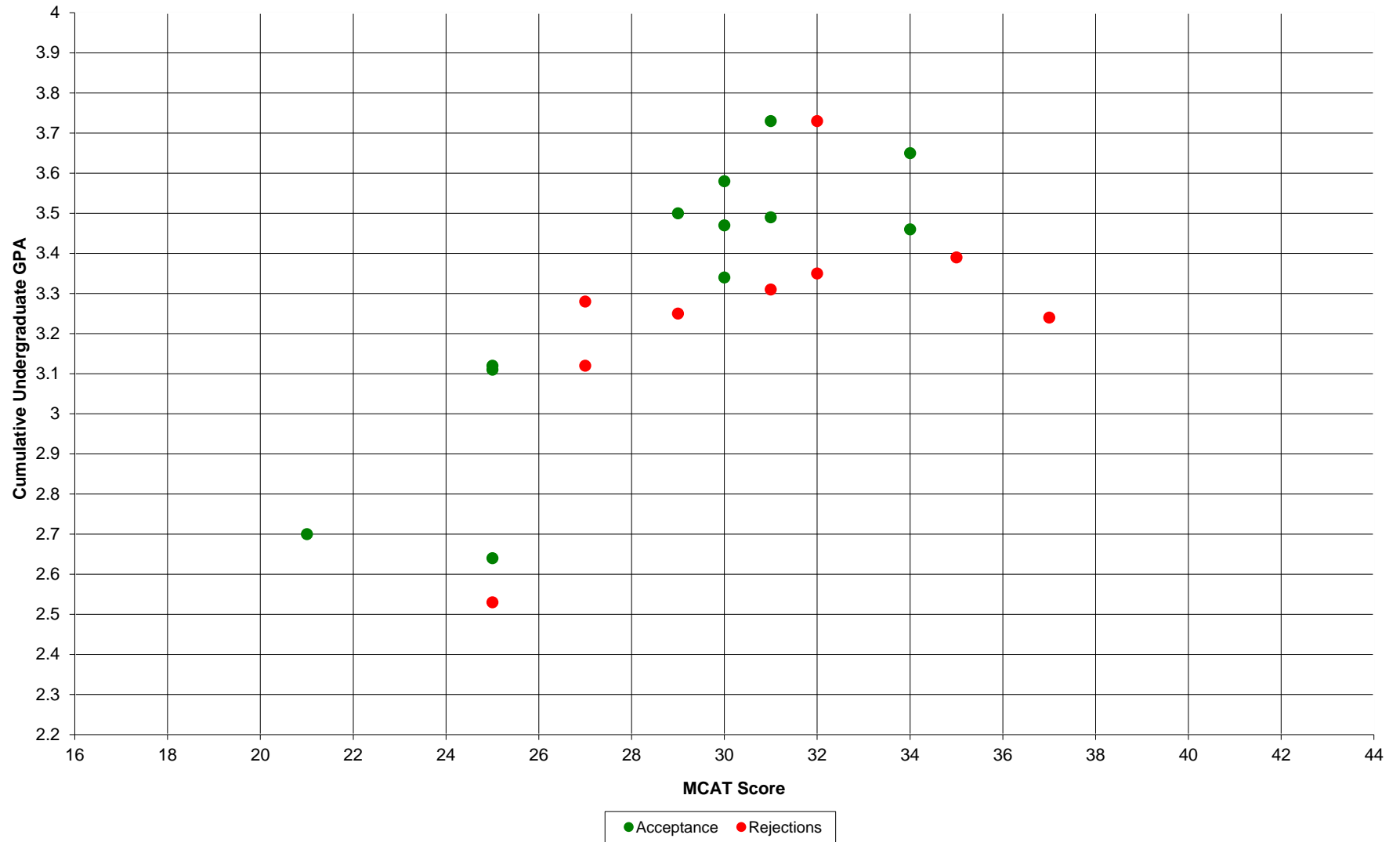

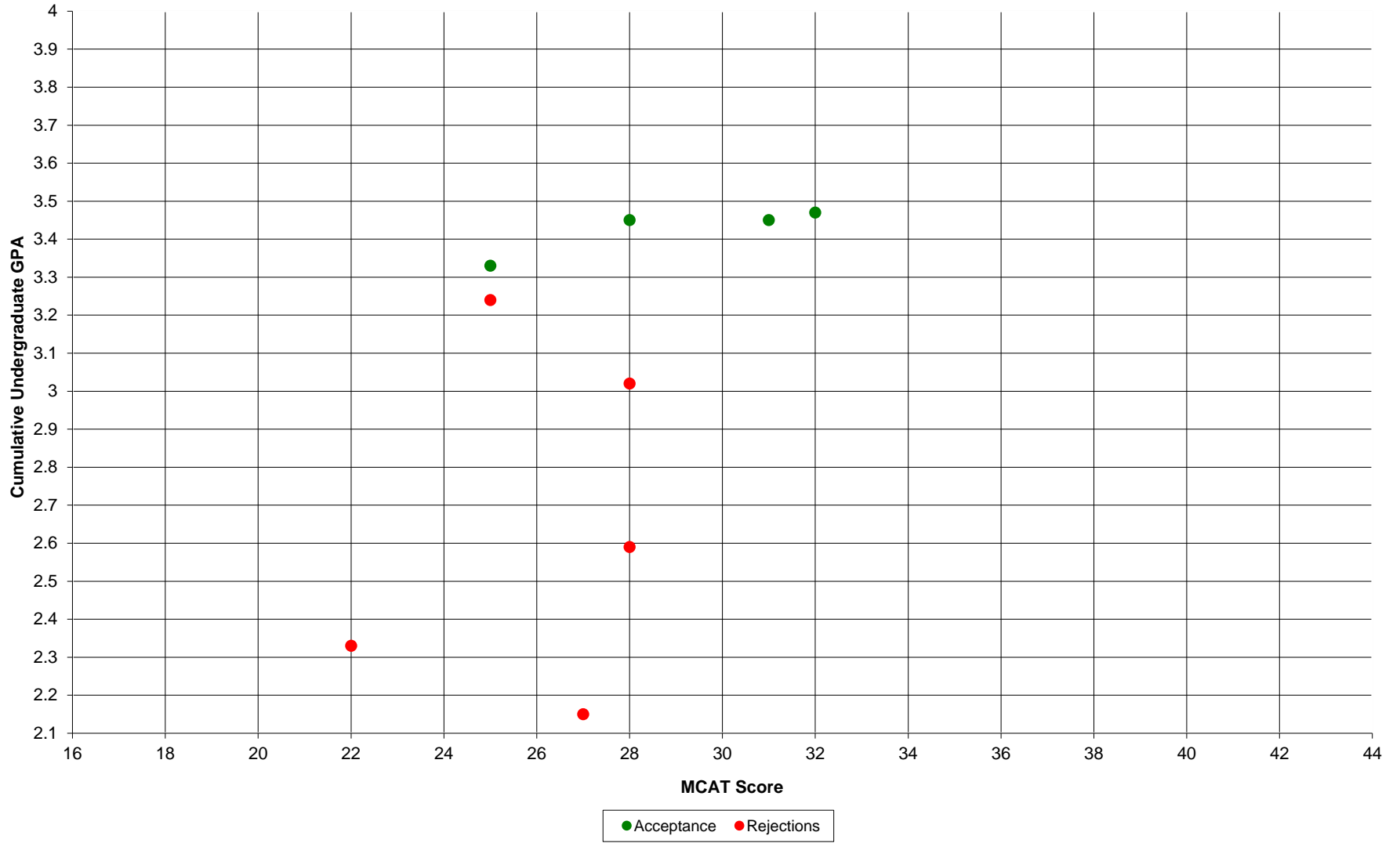

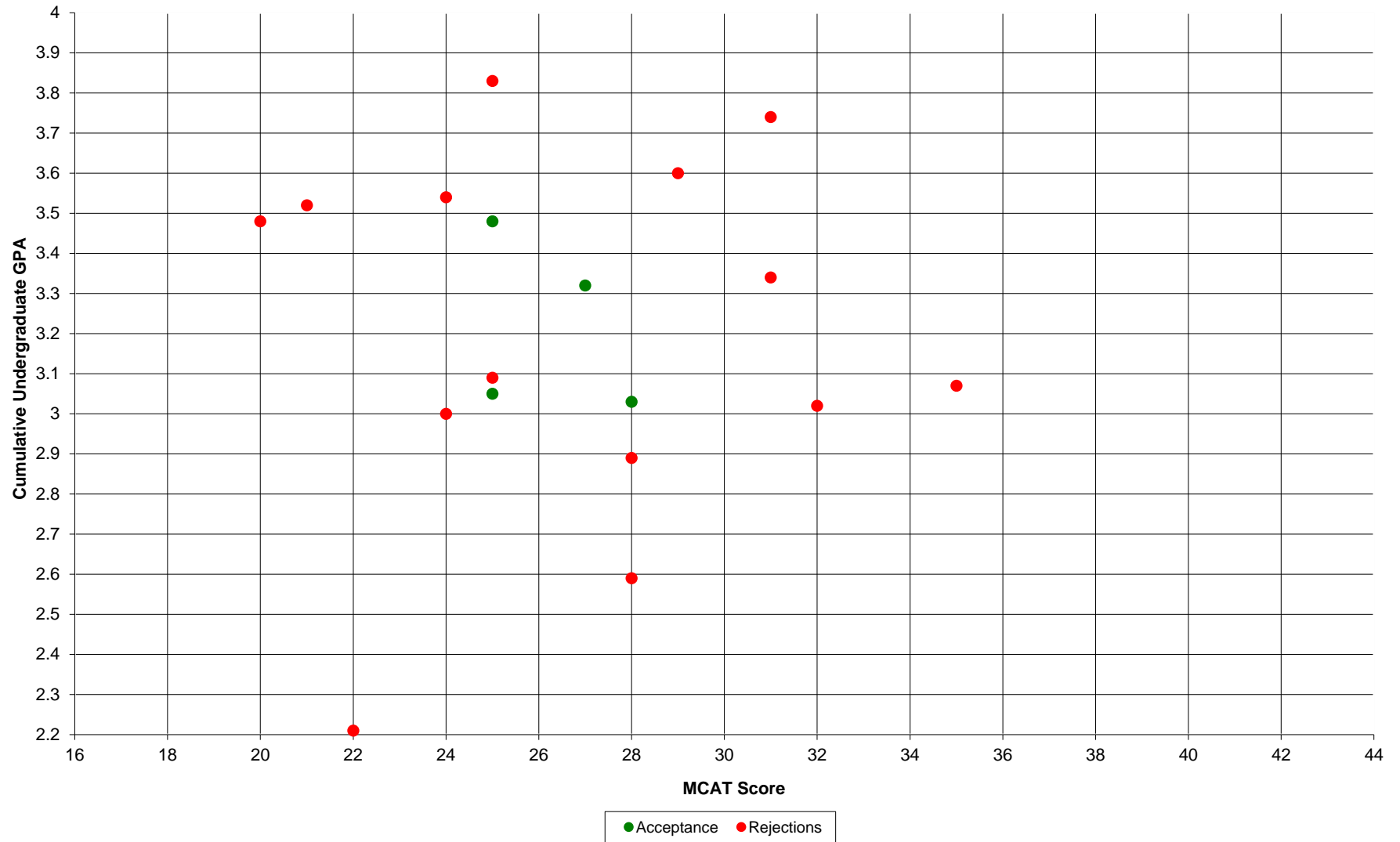

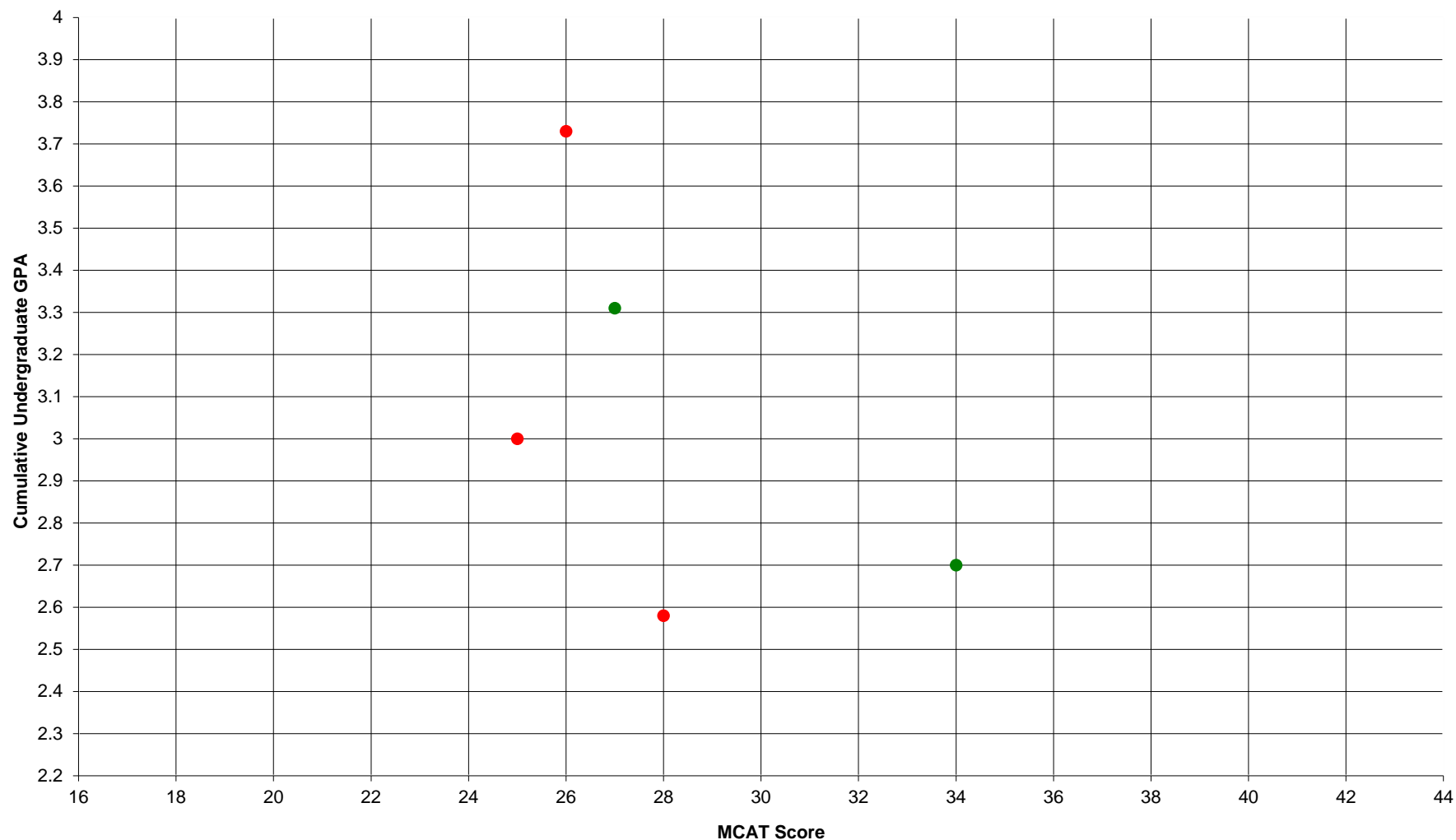

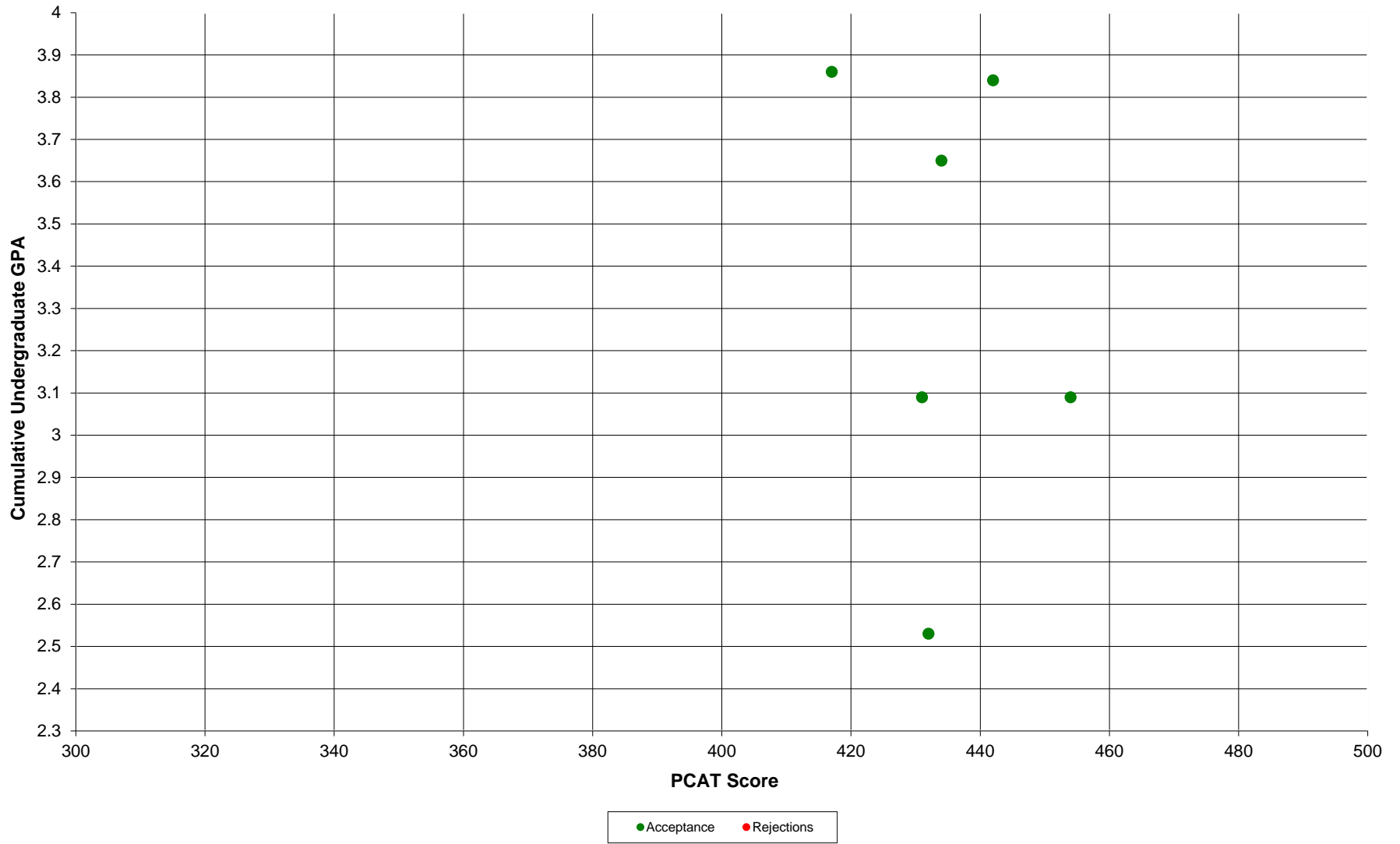

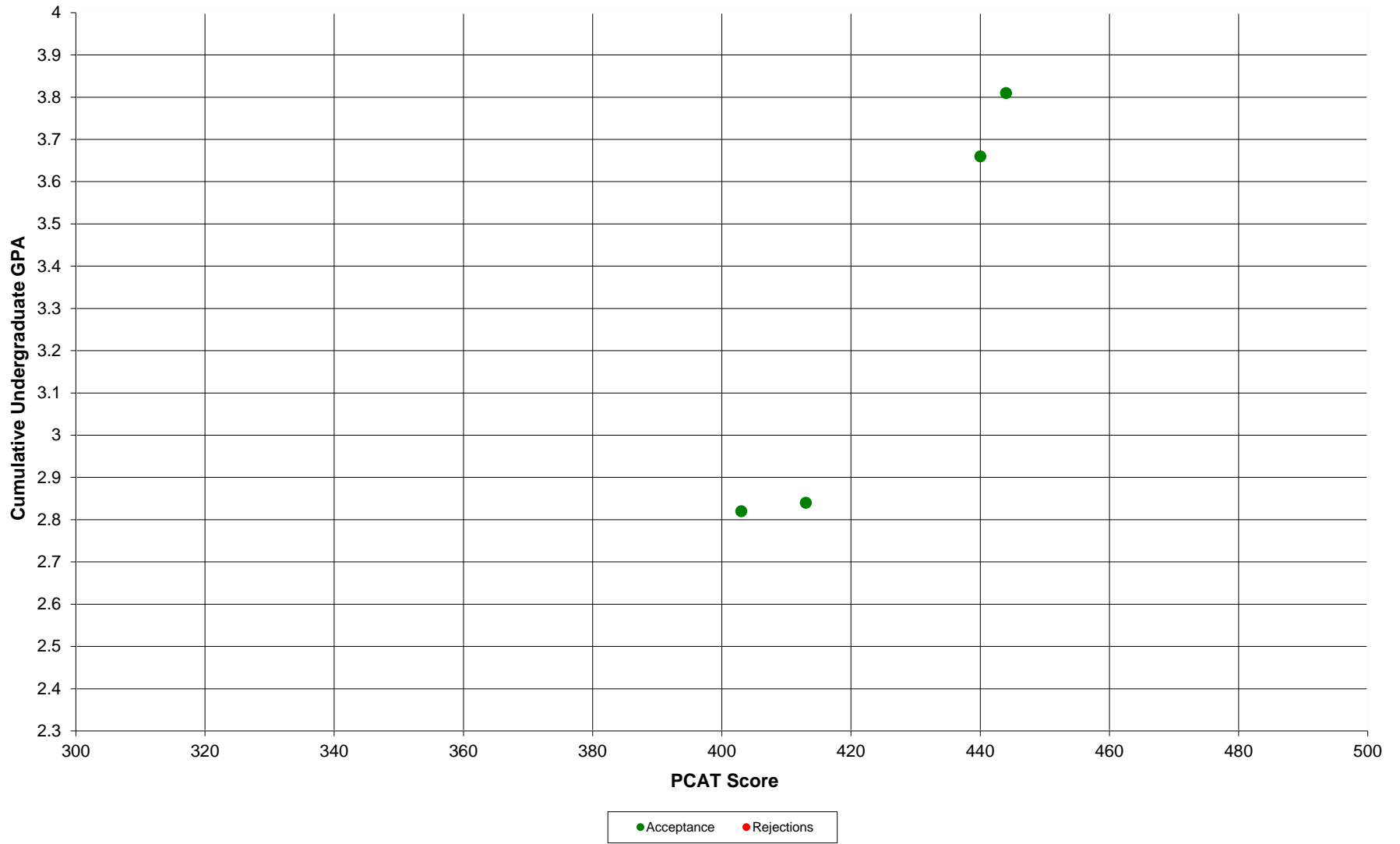

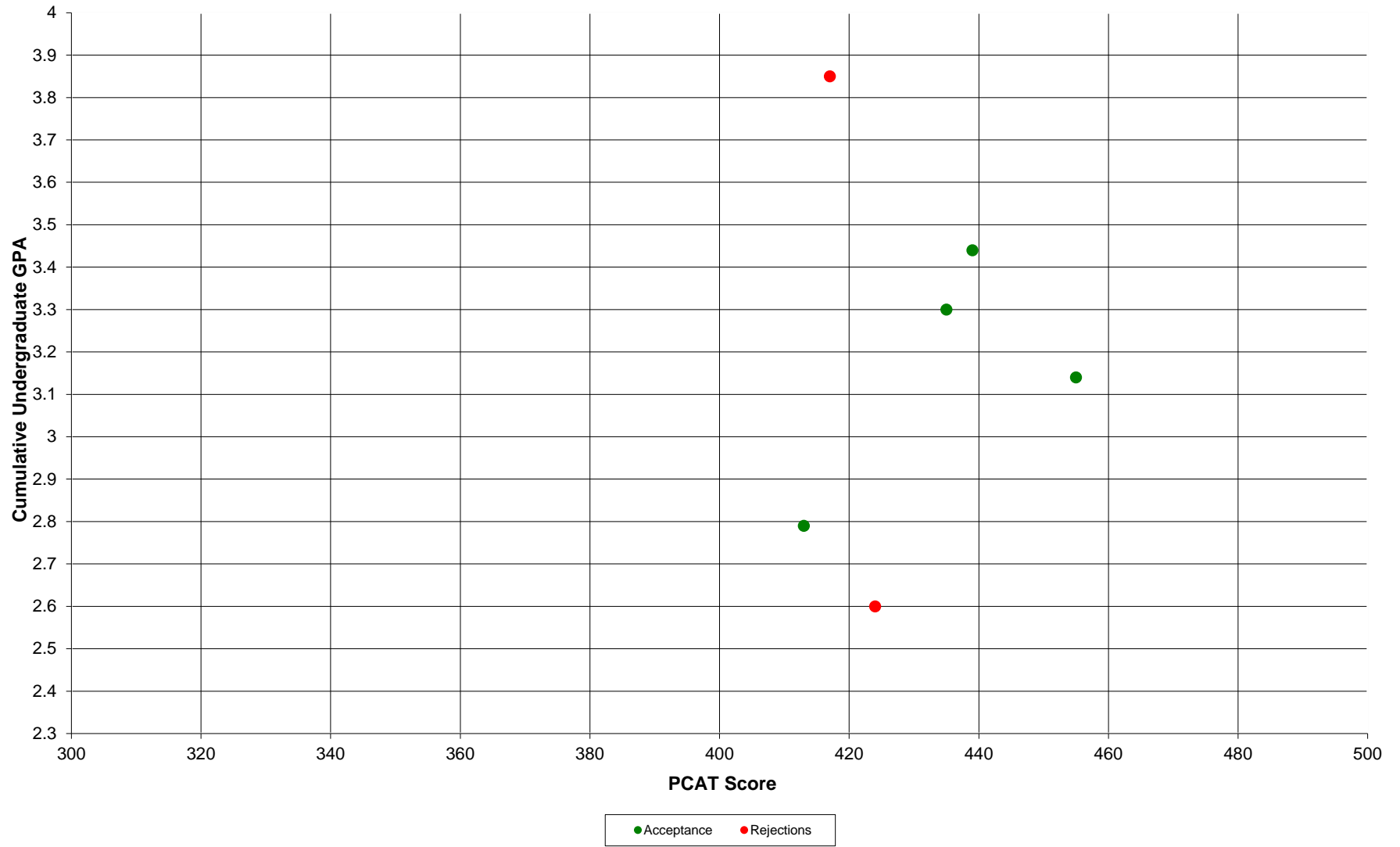
