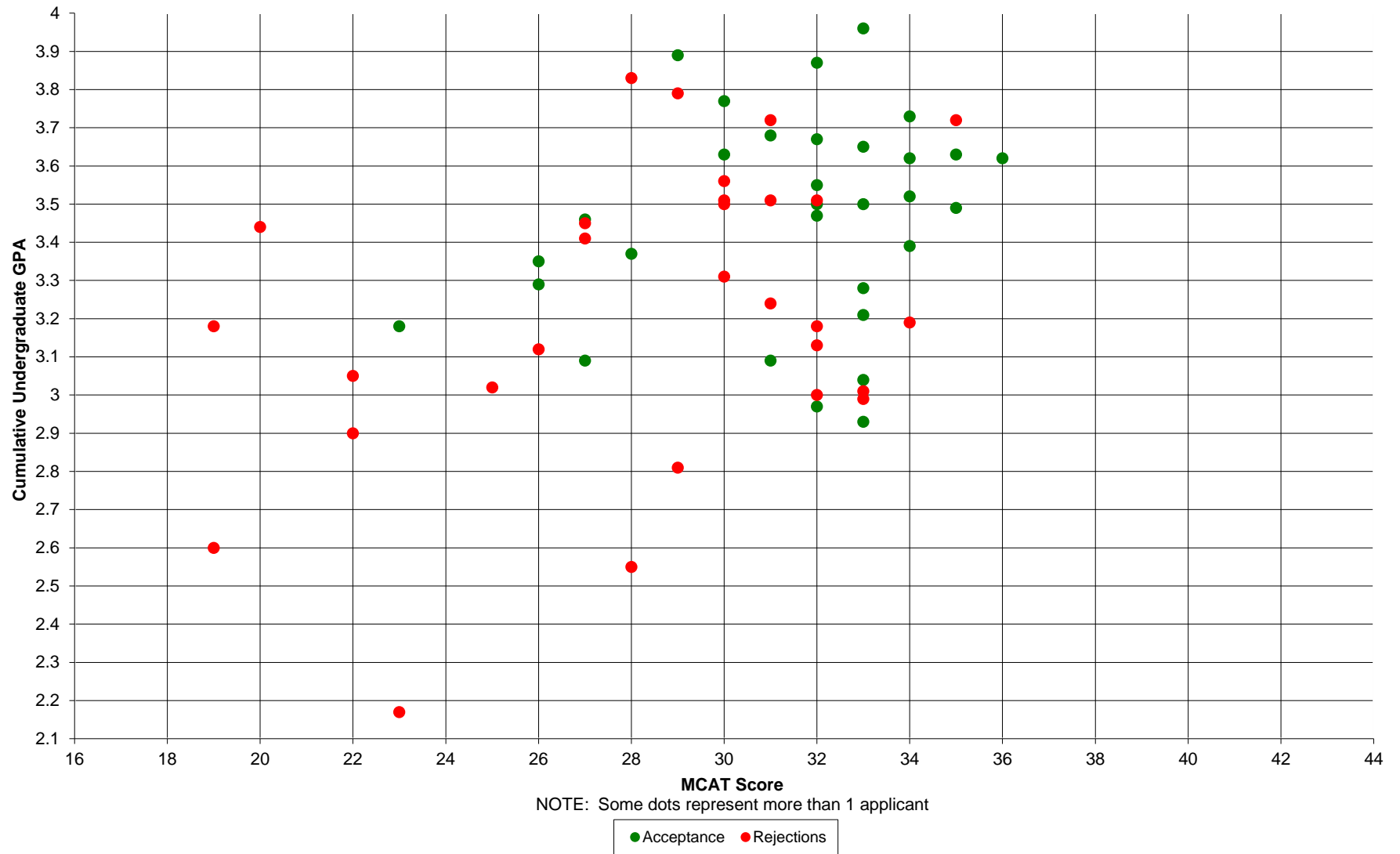

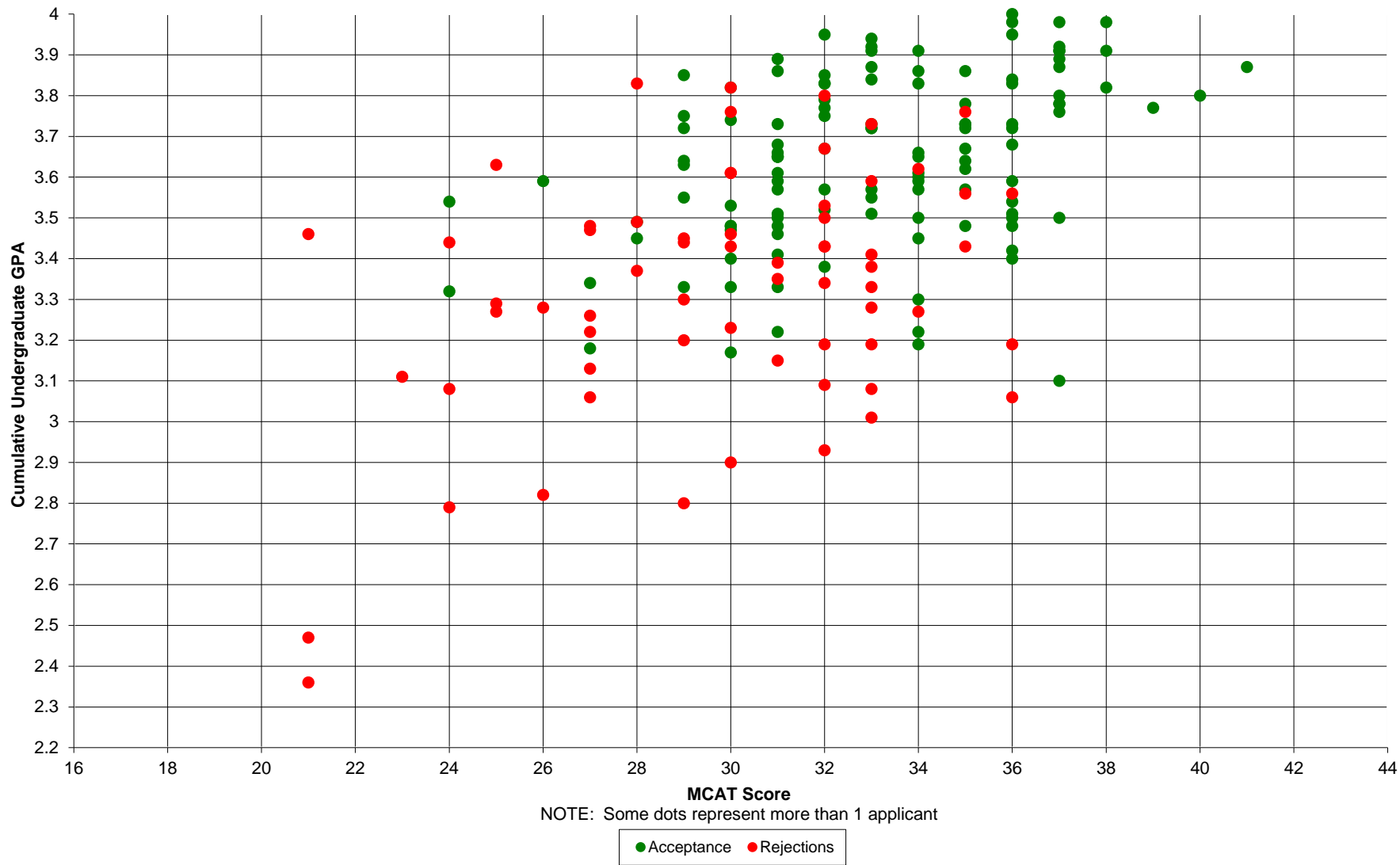




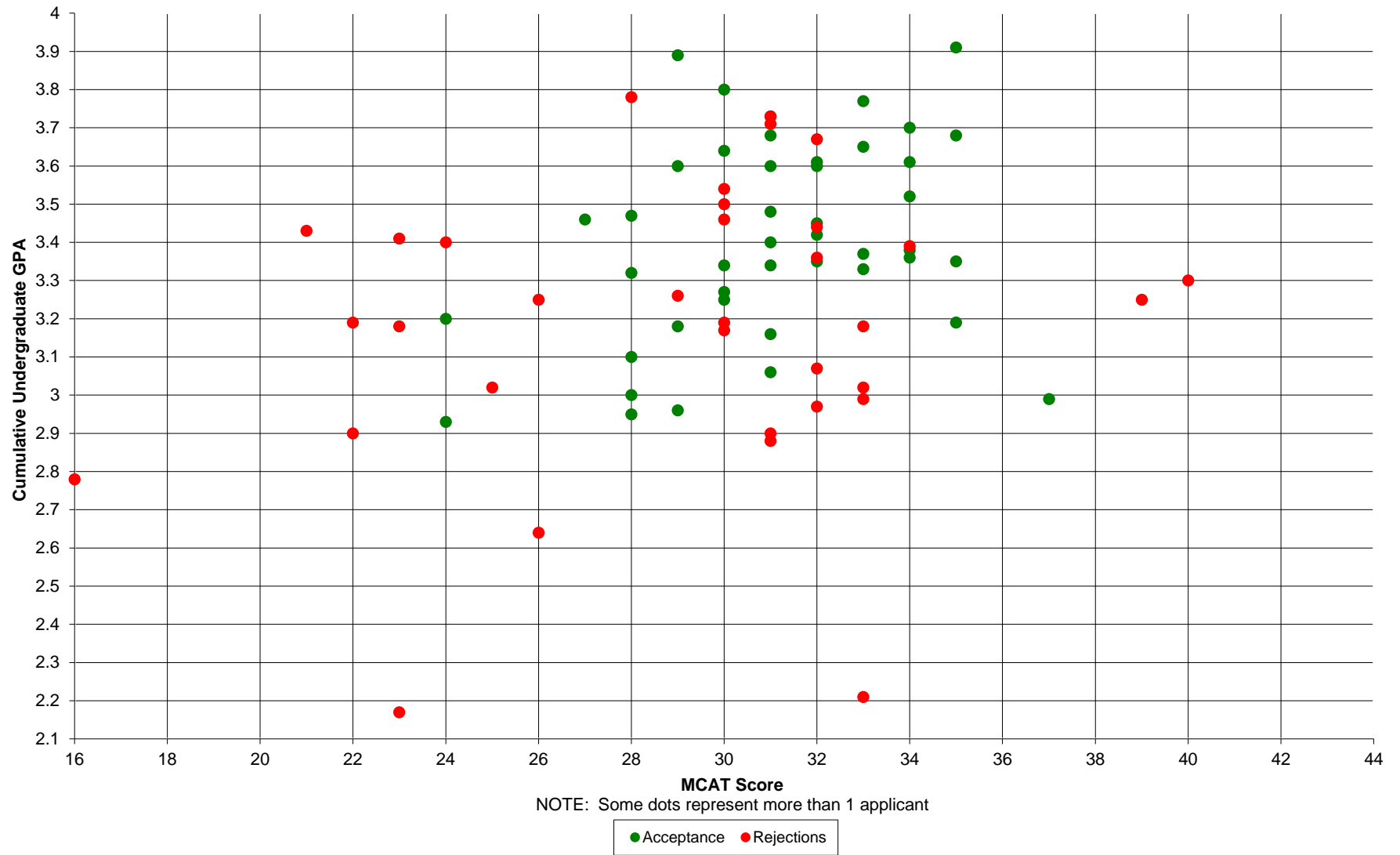

### 2014 Allopathic First Time Applicants

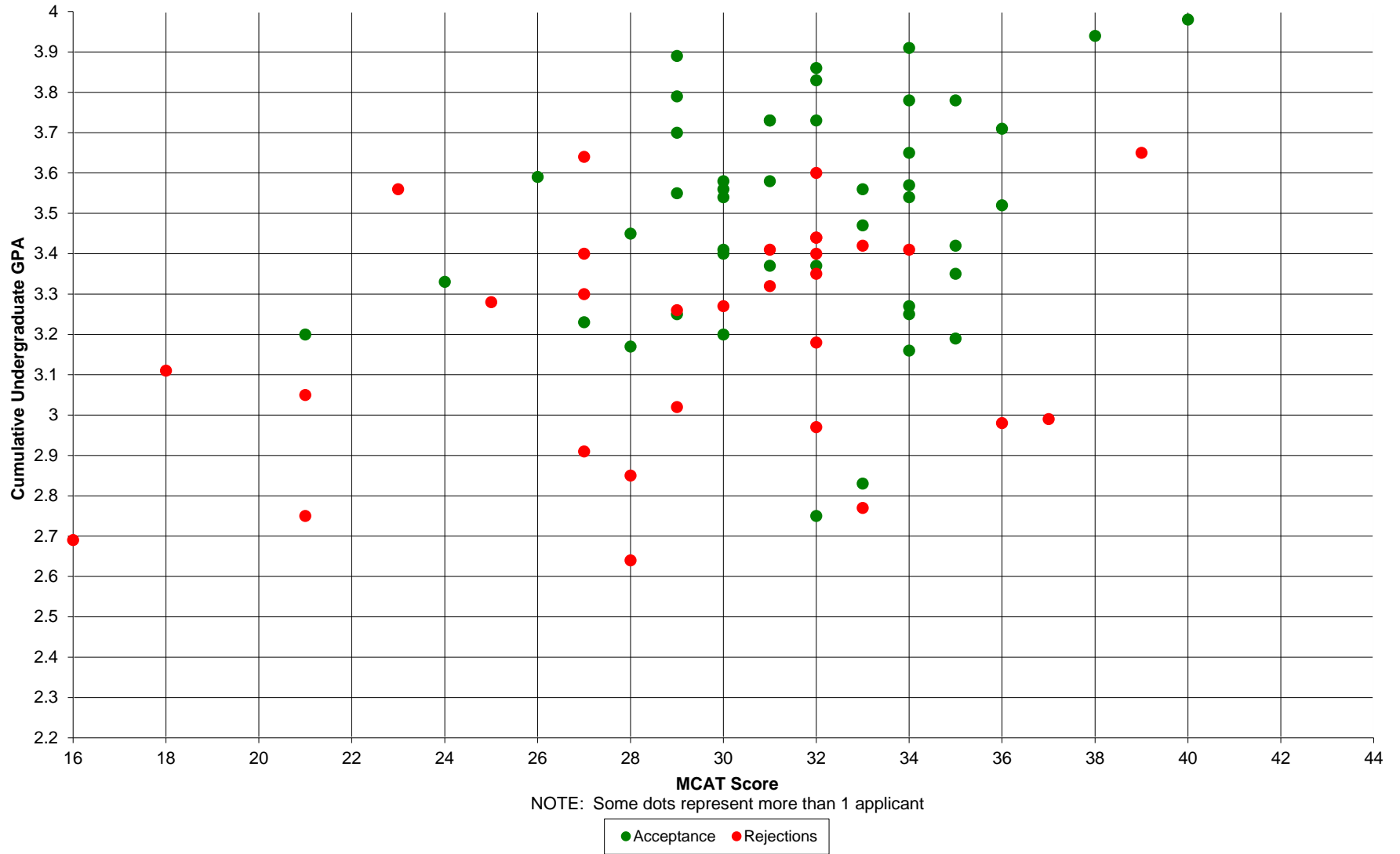

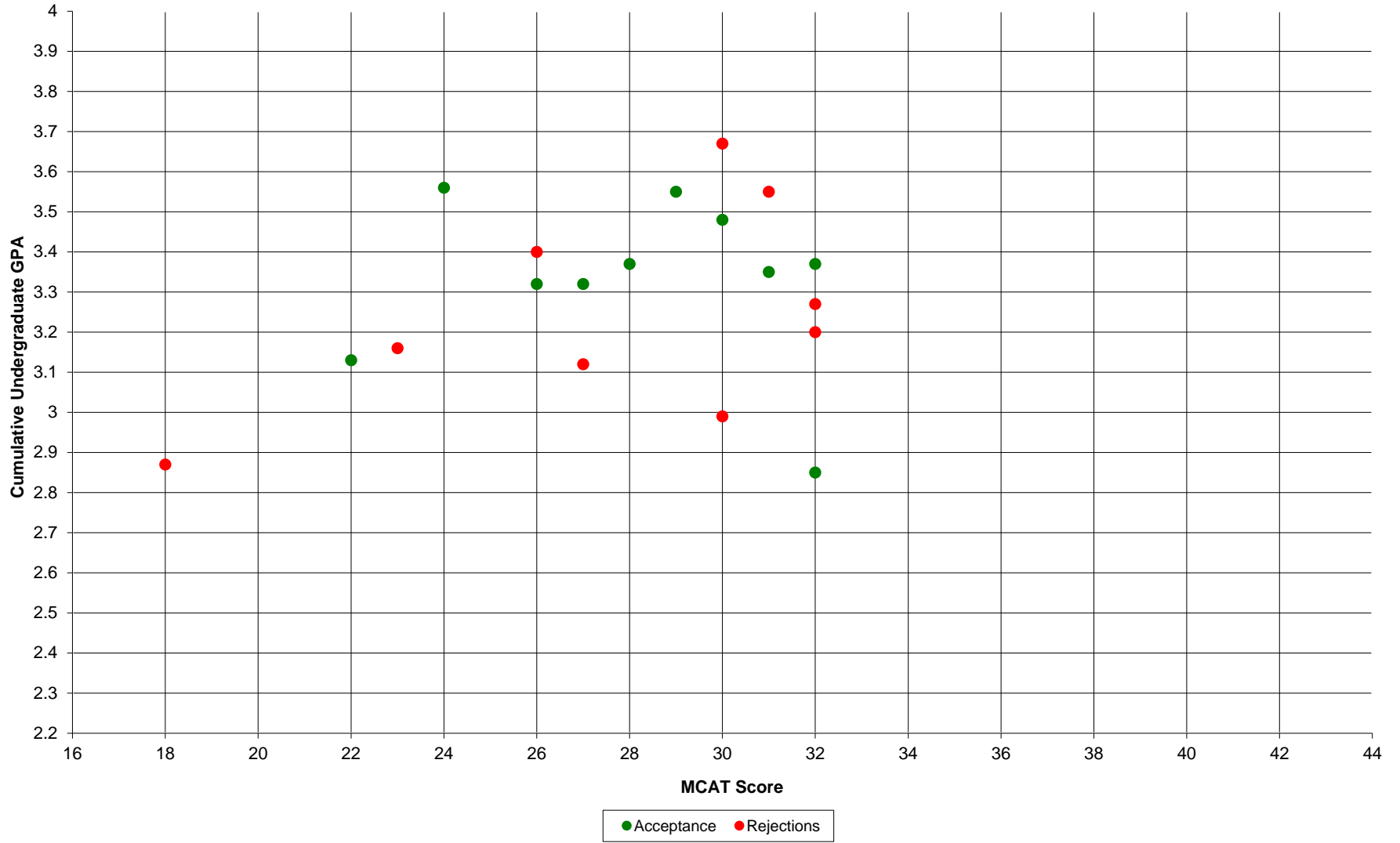

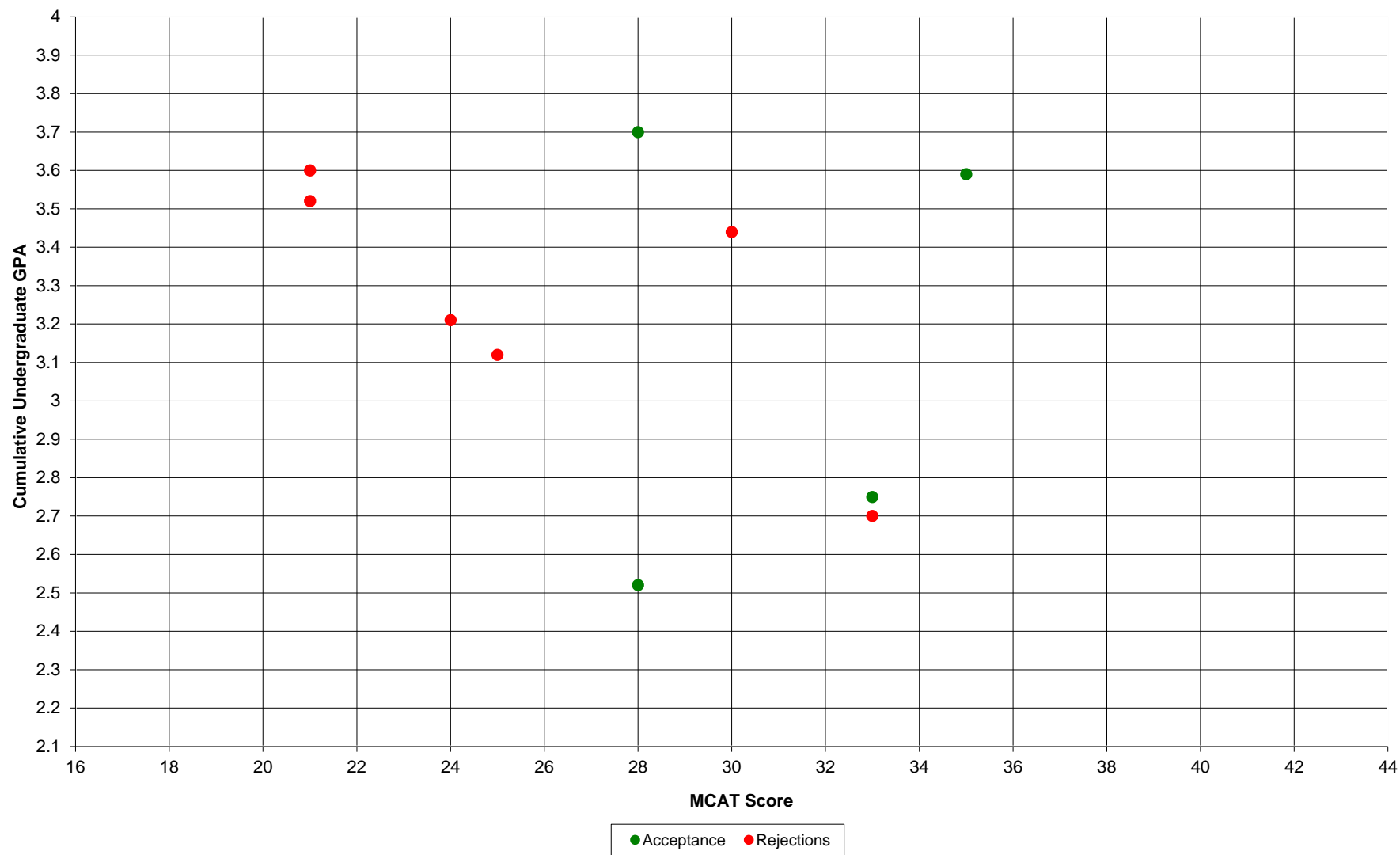

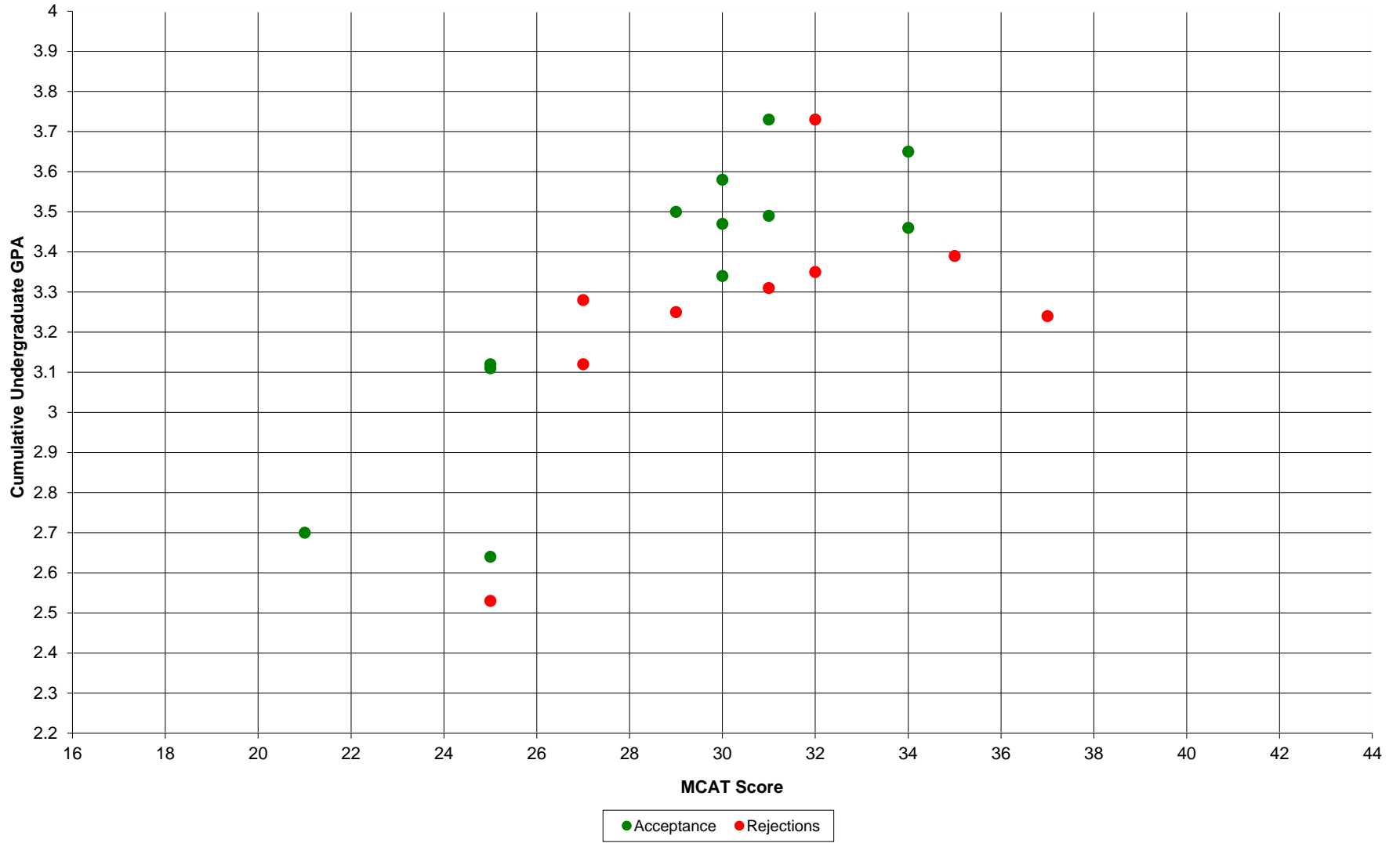

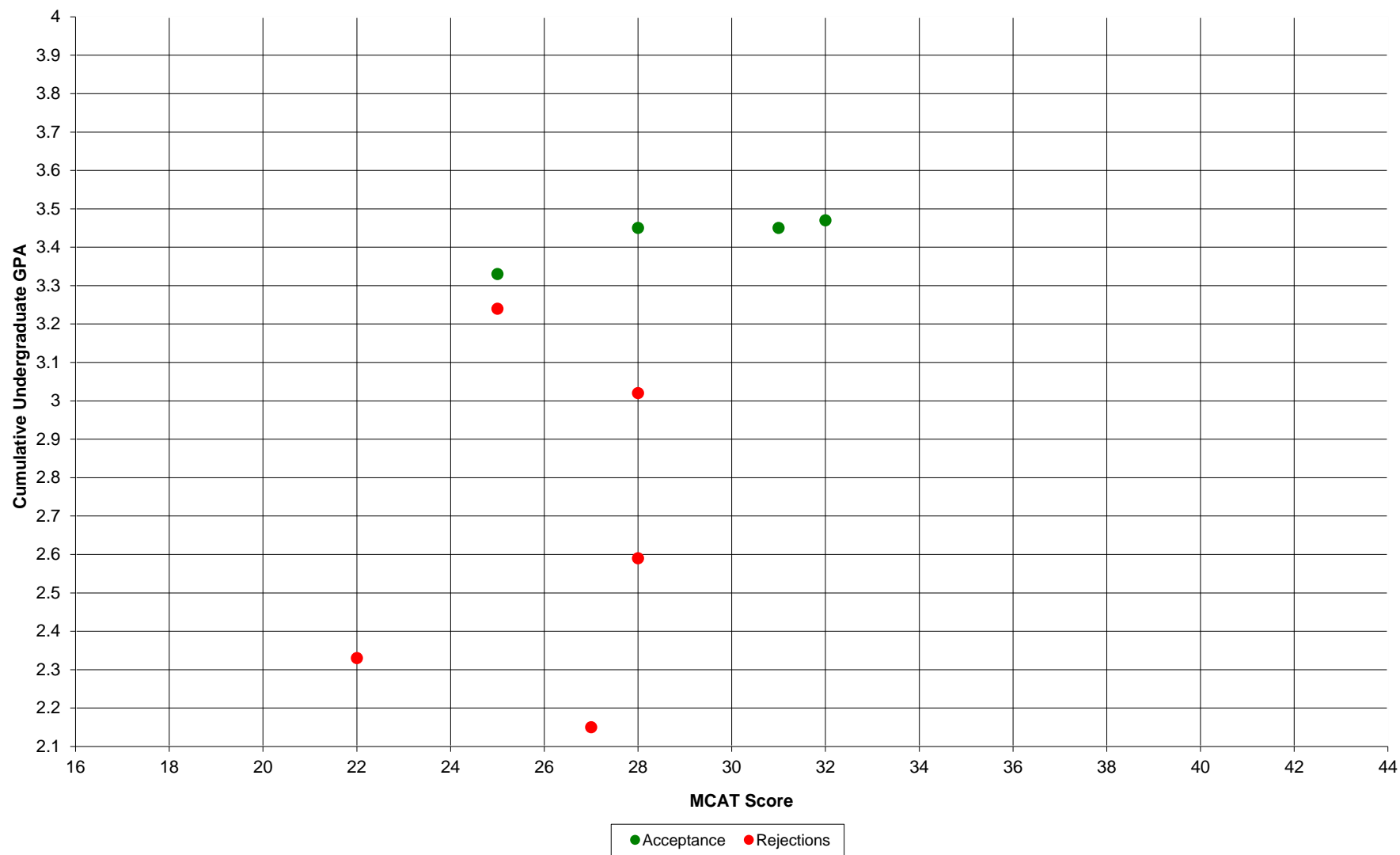

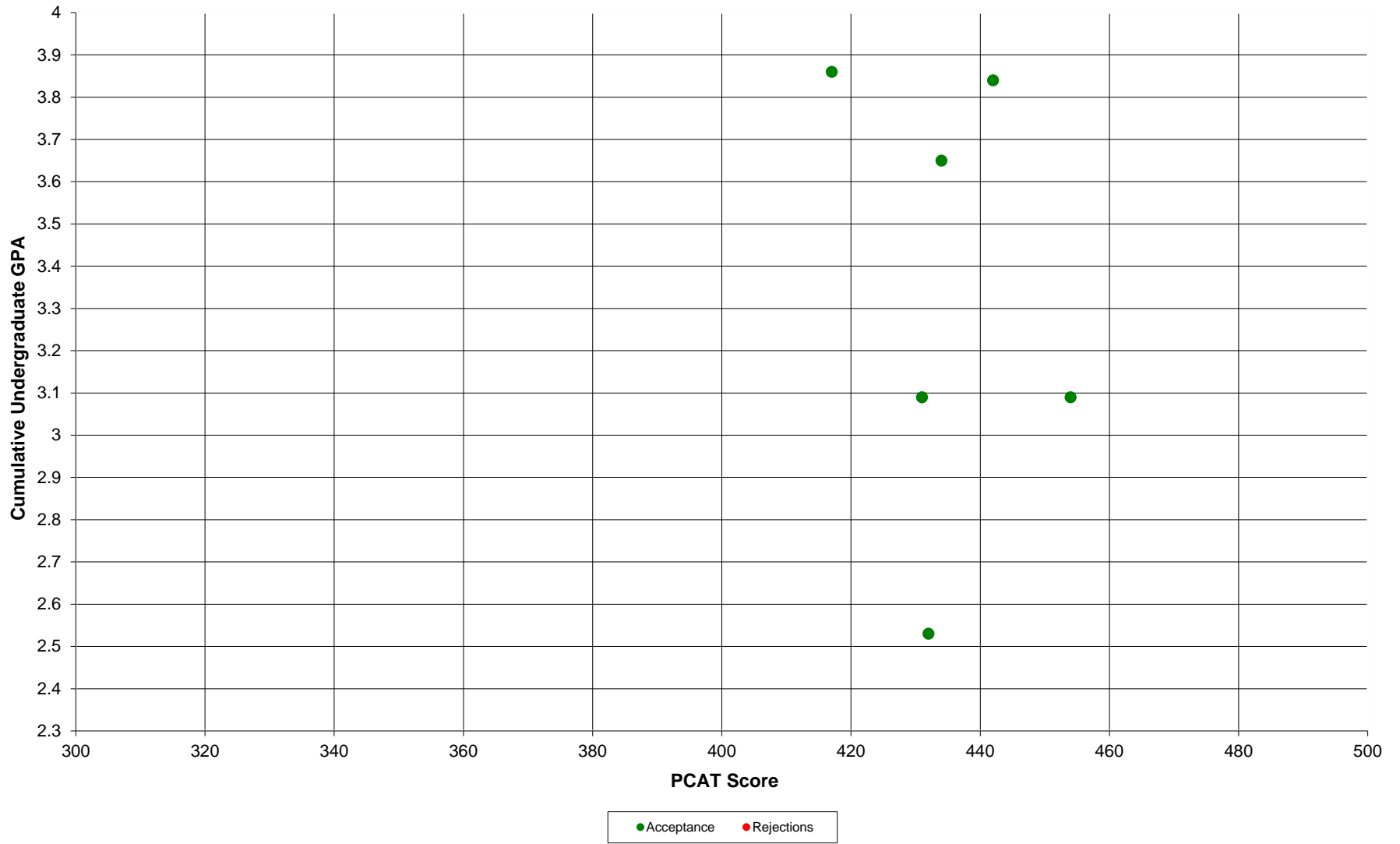
