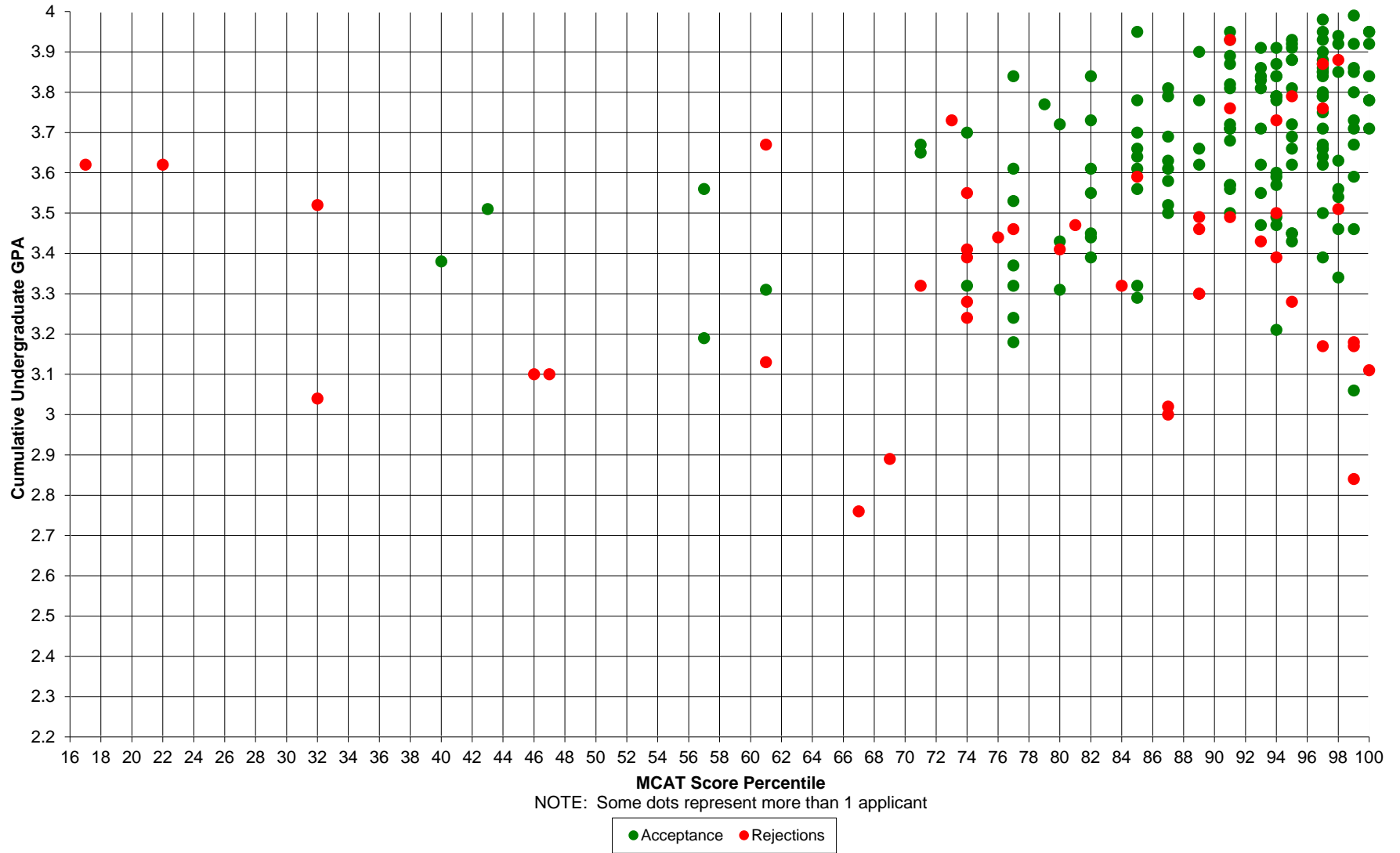

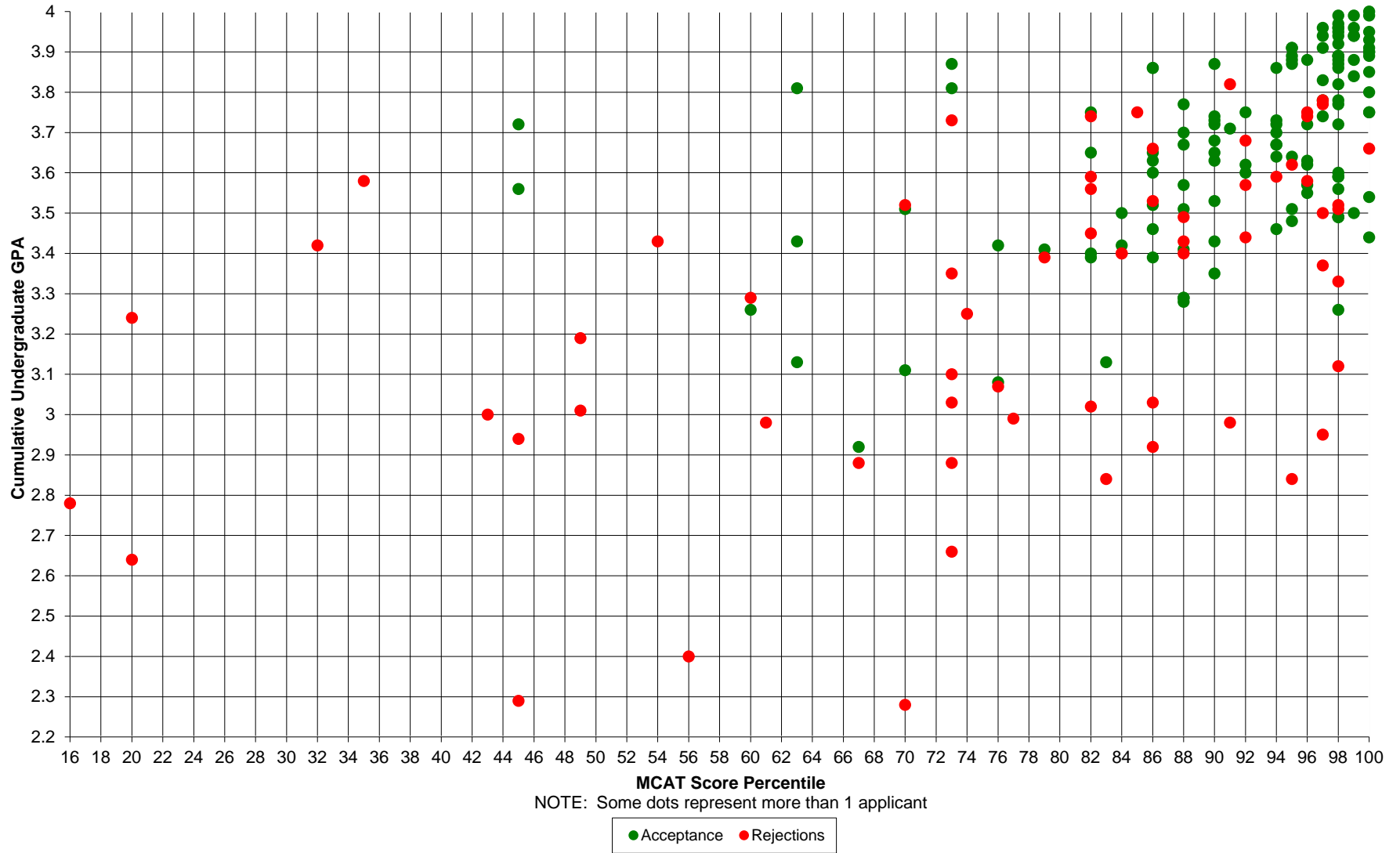




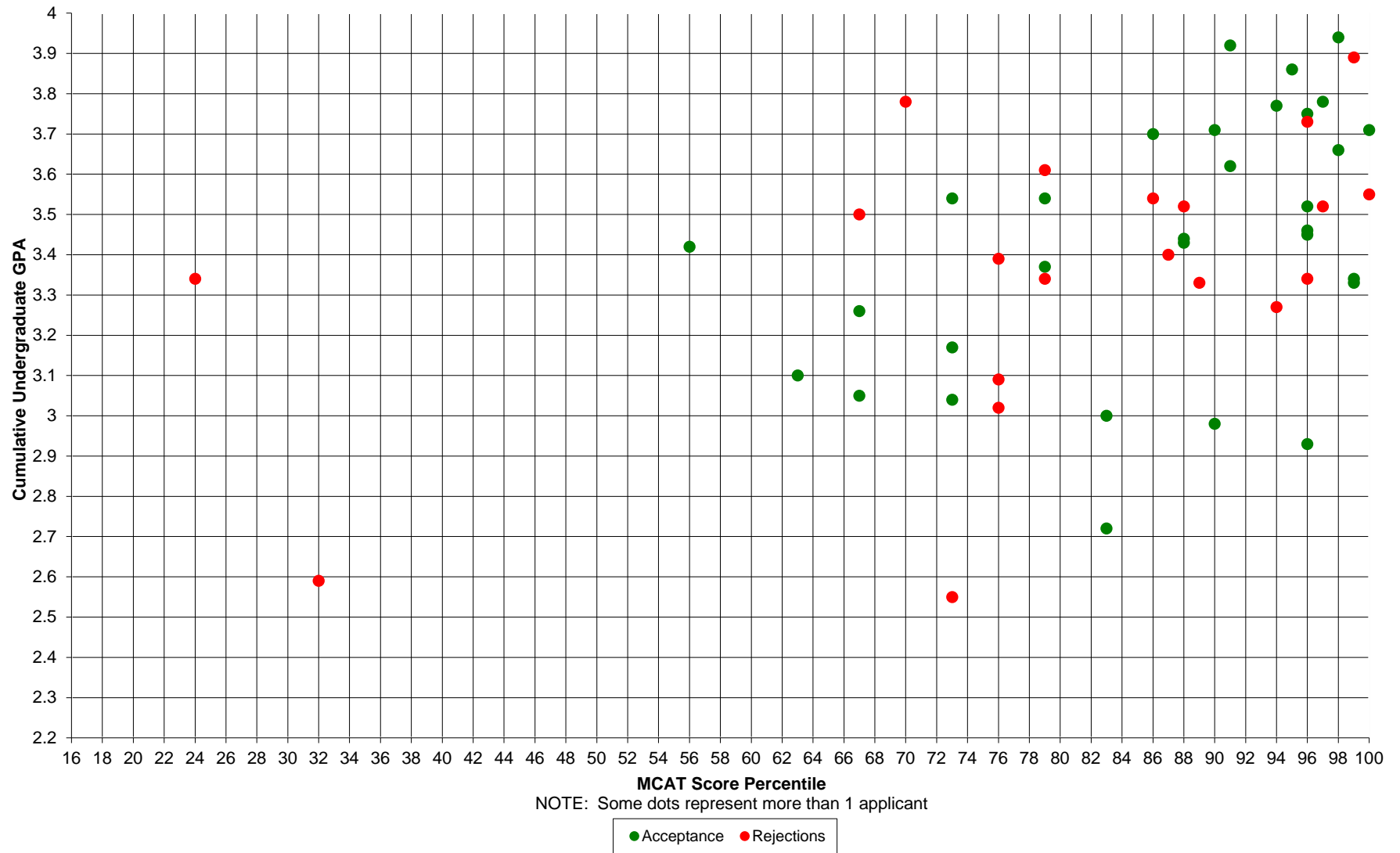
## 2018 Allopathic Re-Applicants



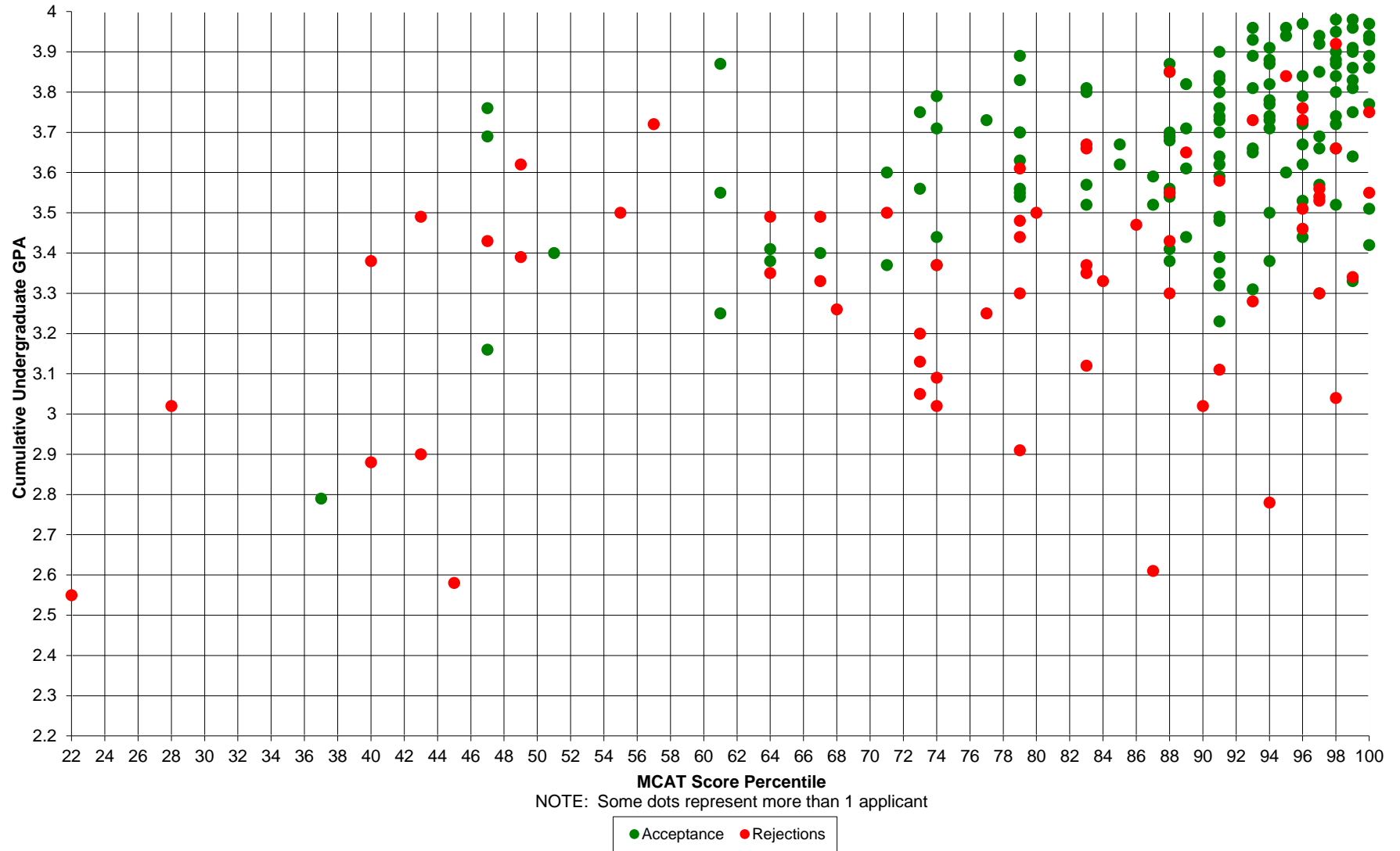
# 2017 Allopathic First Time Applicants



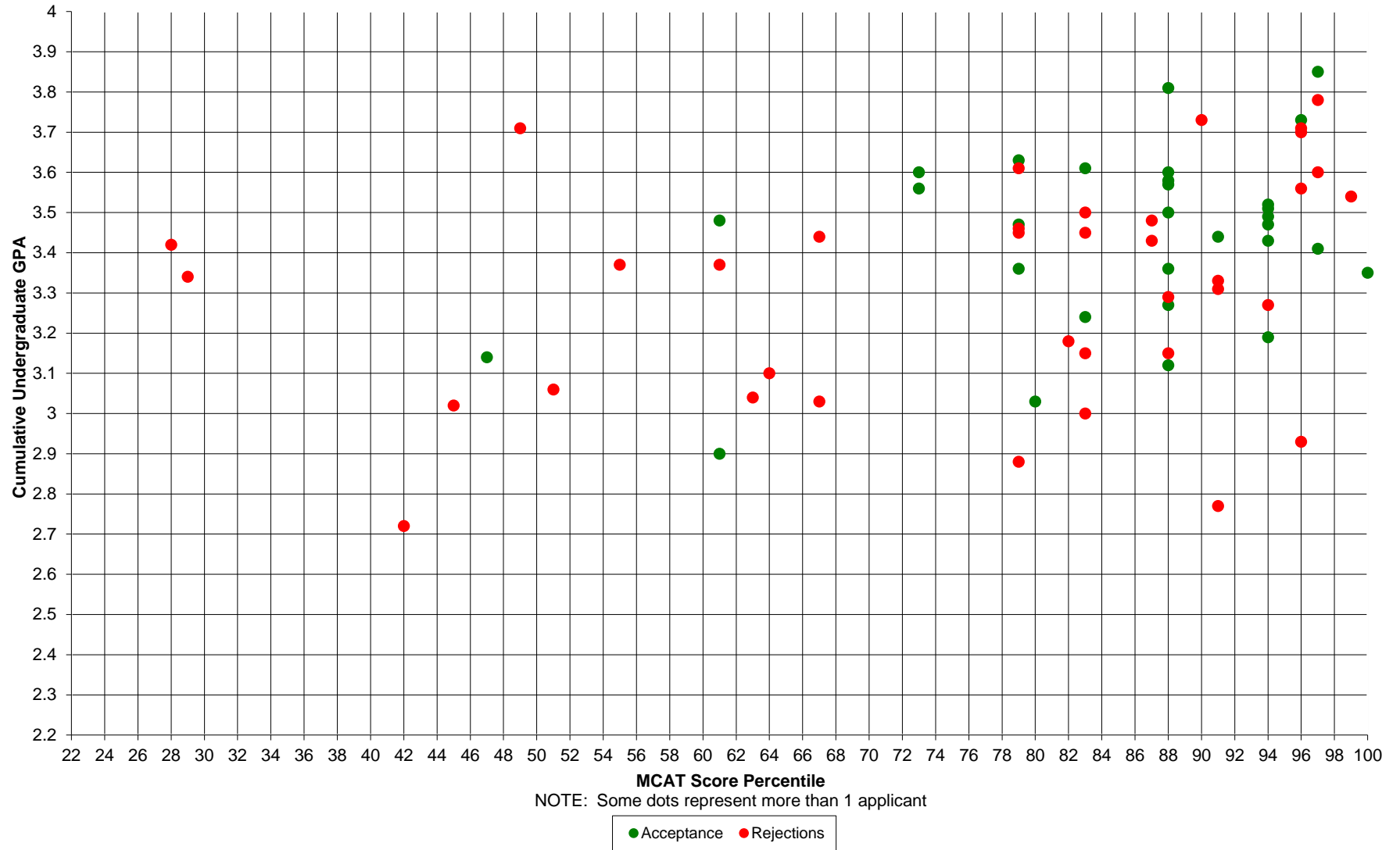
