

Honduras 1988: Land Titling Study

The 1988 Honduras study was designed as a panel study to follow up the 1985 study of the impact of the Land Titling Program in Honduras. The 1988 study was based on interviews of the landowners of the same parcels of land that were interviewed for the study in 1985, so that the data were consistent because they were provided on the same land that was part of the program only two years later. In some cases, the ownership of the land had changed, but in most cases, it was the same respondent.

The interviews were carried out in the same face-to-face and door-to-door manner as in 1985, mainly in the department of Comayagua (77.2%), but also in the department of Yoro (22.8%). Respondents were mostly male (84.1%). The samples in this study was stratified by department, and then within Comayagua, by the type of property.
