

## LAPOP Honduras 1991 Elite Study

The Central American Public Opinion Project (CAPOP) includes a study of the elite public opinion in Honduras. This small sample is not representative of Honduras' national population, nor of its political elites. Only 18 observations were collected, 13 of them among male respondents. It was designed to complement the CAPOP urban sample conducted in Tegucigalpa and San Pedro Sula that same year. CAPOP was a precursor of LAPOP when the countries were confined to Central America.

Annabelle Conroy undertook the fieldwork. Category labels for some variables remain undefined. No study has been conducted with these data.
