A sample of 1,508 respondents was drawn from the adult population through a national multistage probability sampling method. Apoyo, Opinión y Mercados, S.A., among Peru’s best-known survey research organizations conducted the interviews face-to-face. Funding was generously supplied by The United States Agency for International Development (USAID).

There was not an individual report presenting the results of this study. However, results were analyzed in a research study, “Political Support, Political Skepticism, and Political Stability in New Democracies: An Empirical Examination of Mass Support for Coups d’Etat in Peru,” written by Mitchell A.
