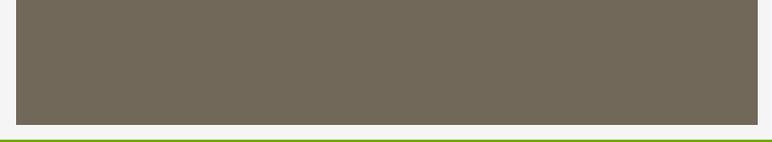

# Decisions

- Past Decisions
  - Decisions made by others that affect you now:
    - Wars
    - Grand Relatives
  - *After the Reich* by Giles MacDonogh, 1963—
- Present Decisions
  - Decisions made by you that affect your current life.
    - Investments
    - Spending habits (out living your money)
    - Personal decisions (divorce, will, etc.)
- Future Decisions
  - Decisions that you make that can affect generations to come
    - Do nothing
    - Will
    - Guidance
