

NIH Other Support

Other support includes all resources (domestic or foreign) made available to a researcher in support of and/or related to all of their research endeavors, regardless of whether or not they have monetary value and regardless of whether they are based at the institution the researcher identifies for the current grant.

Items to Include in Active/Pending/Completed Section (this list is not inclusive of all possibilities)

- ✓ Any research activity conducted within the scope of an Investigator's Vanderbilt appointment that provides funding or requires a time commitment. Including but not limited to; grants, contracts, subawards, CORE funding of Effort support, as well as the examples below.
- ✓ All collaborations and affiliations that provide funding or require a commitment of time, whether foreign or domestic.
- ✓ Clinical trials
- ✓ Start-up funding by an organization **other** than Vanderbilt
- ✓ Consulting agreements where the PI or senior/key personnel will be conducting research as part of the consulting activities.
- ✓ TIPS awards, Realignment Funding, Pilot Projects, some competitively awarded "Gifts" (or any other internally or externally funded competitive awards
- ✓ Investigator's VA-funded activities, space, and equipment
- ✓ ***In-kind¹ contributions uniquely available to the researcher***
 - Visiting Research Scholars supported by their home institution
 - Any person (students included) utilizing outside funding directly supports the PI's research, e.g., post-doctoral students paid by VUMC T32 grant.
 - Materials, supplies, equipment, reagents that are not available to everyone and directly support the research of the PI (including some NDA's and MTA's).
 - Access to resources (lab space, equipment, etc.) at another institution, including VUMC space or equipment
 - Core Scholarships

TIP: If in-kind resources are intended for use on the project, include them in the Facilities and Other Resources or Equipment section. If they are not for use on the proposed project list in Other Support.

Does Not Need to Be Included on Other Support

- × Start-up funding from Vanderbilt
- × Consulting agreements that involve non-research activities
- × Training awards, prizes, or unrestricted, non-competitive gifts
- × The application under consideration or the current PHS award for the project
- × NIH proposals or projects for which the individual is an Other Significant Contributor without effort
- × Vanderbilt endowed professorships
- × Vanderbilt retention packages
- × Royalty funds – if not directly supporting the research
- × Fee for service agreements
- × Departmental funds

¹ In-kind contributions, e.g., office/laboratory space, equipment, supplies, or employees or students supported by an outside source. If the in-kind contribution's time commitment or dollar value is not readily ascertainable, the recipient must provide reasonable estimates.
