

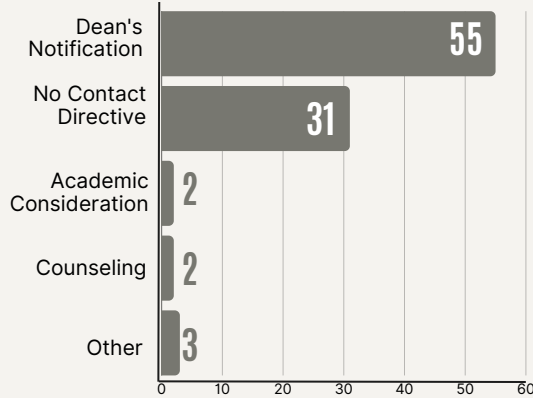
TITLE IX ANNUAL DATA REPORT
