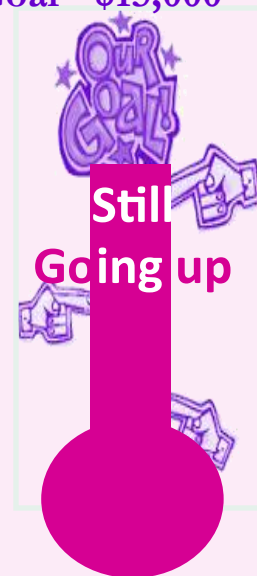

Ravel is one of the great orchestrators — a composer who knew how to bring out rich colors and textures through his use of instrumentation. *Le Tombeau de Couperin* is a Baroque-inspired piece for a smaller orchestra, while *Rapsodie espagnole* is a Spanish-flavored piece that captures the full scope of the orchestra.
