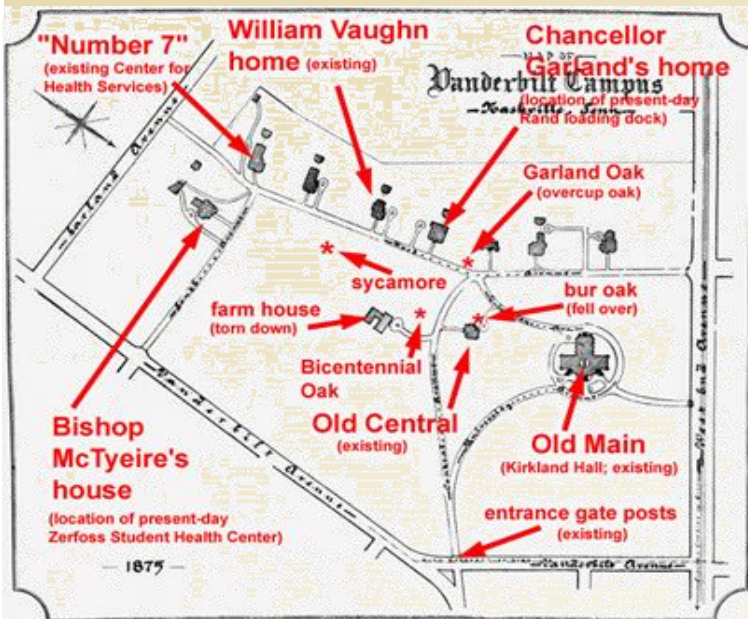


## Explore Vanderbilt

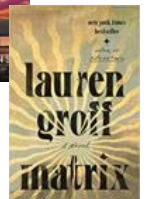
