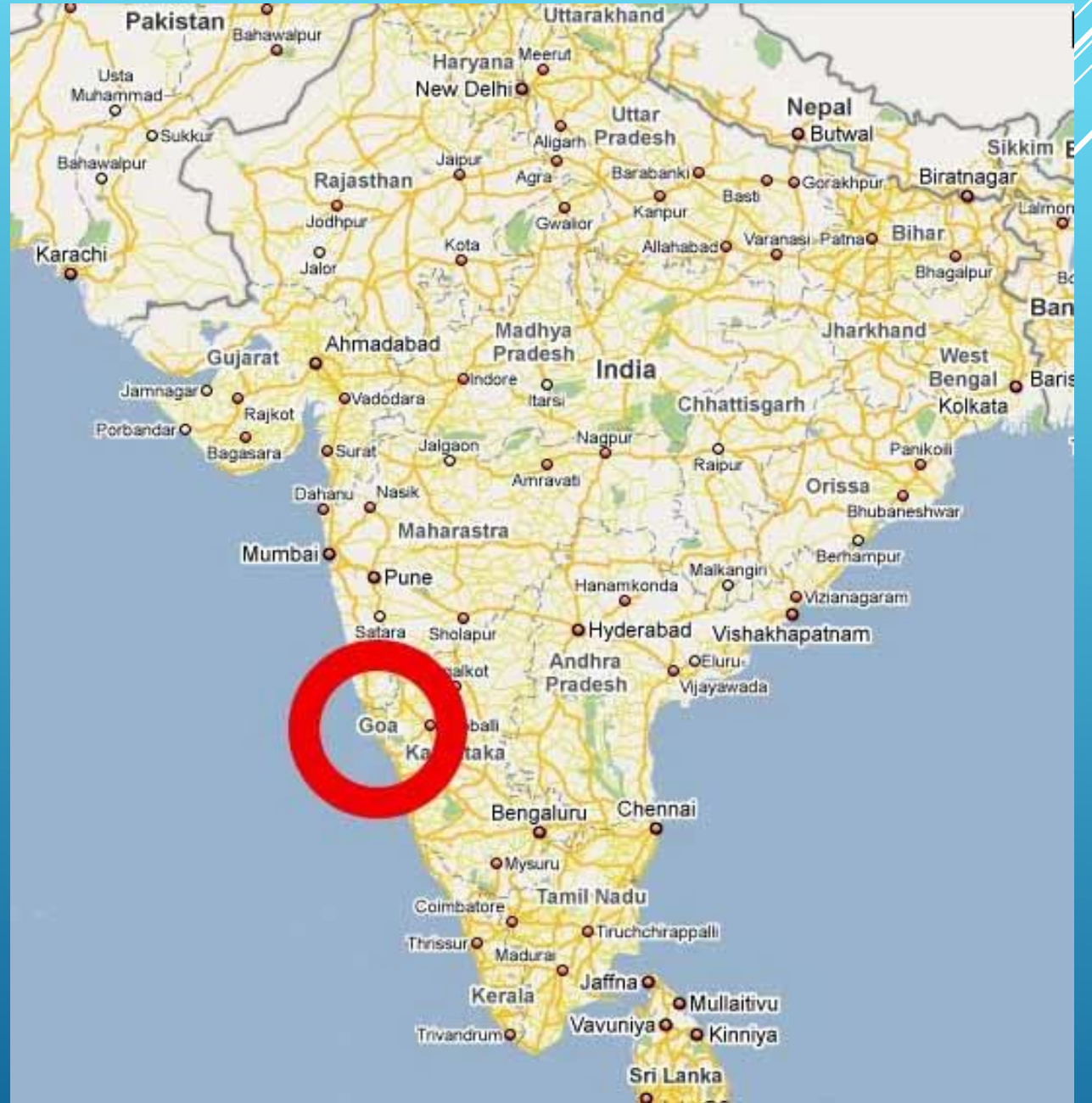

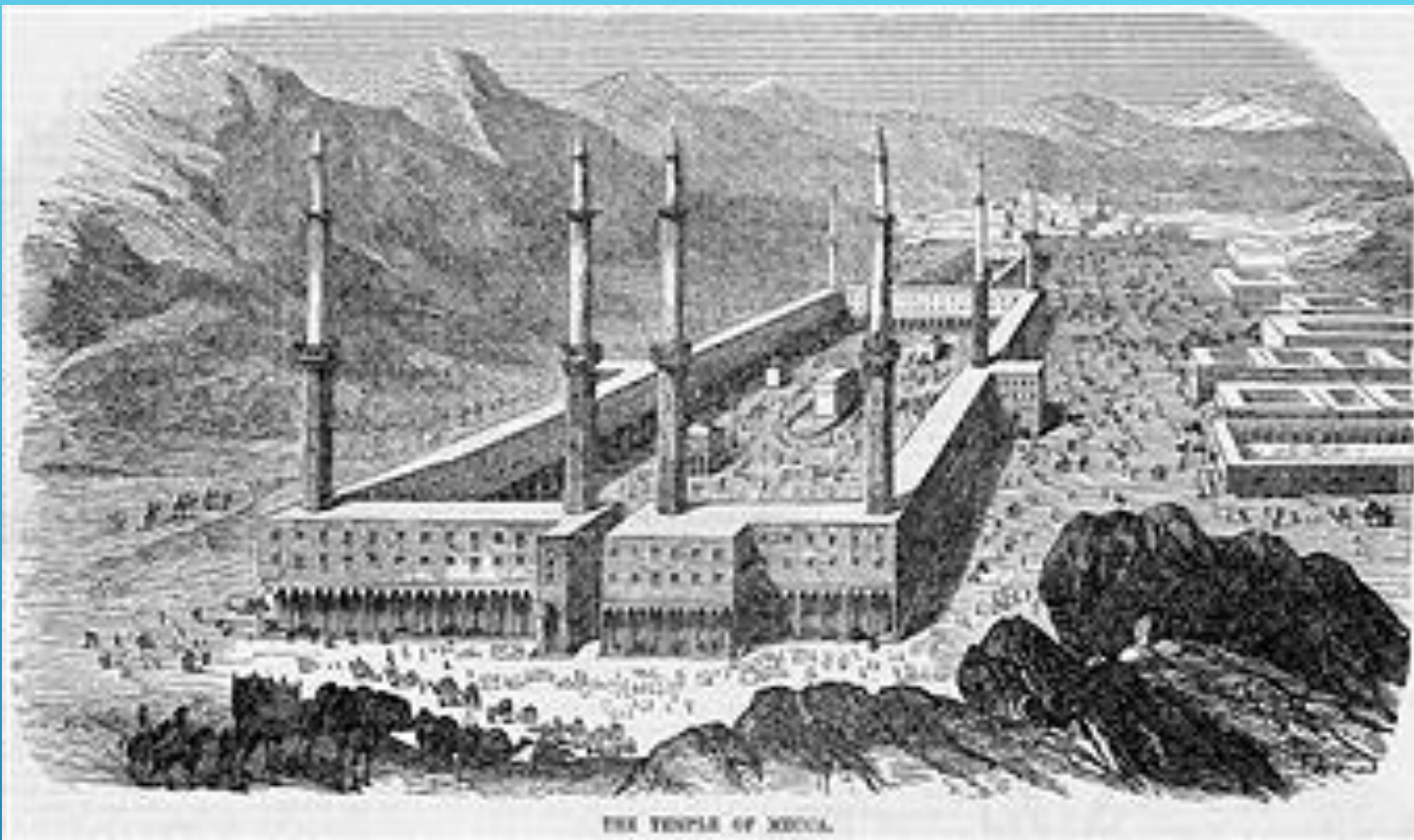
ISABEL ARUNDELL

- ❑ marriage in 1861 (sort of secretly)

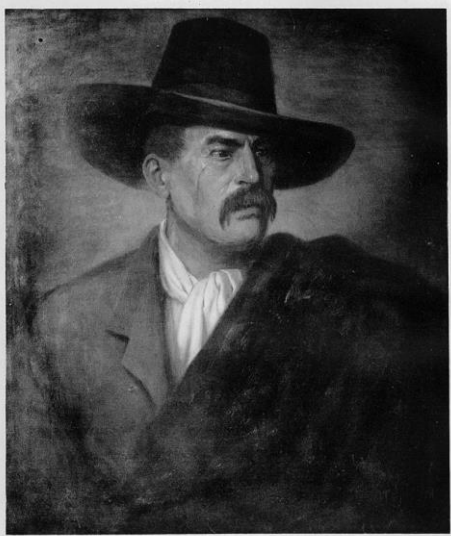
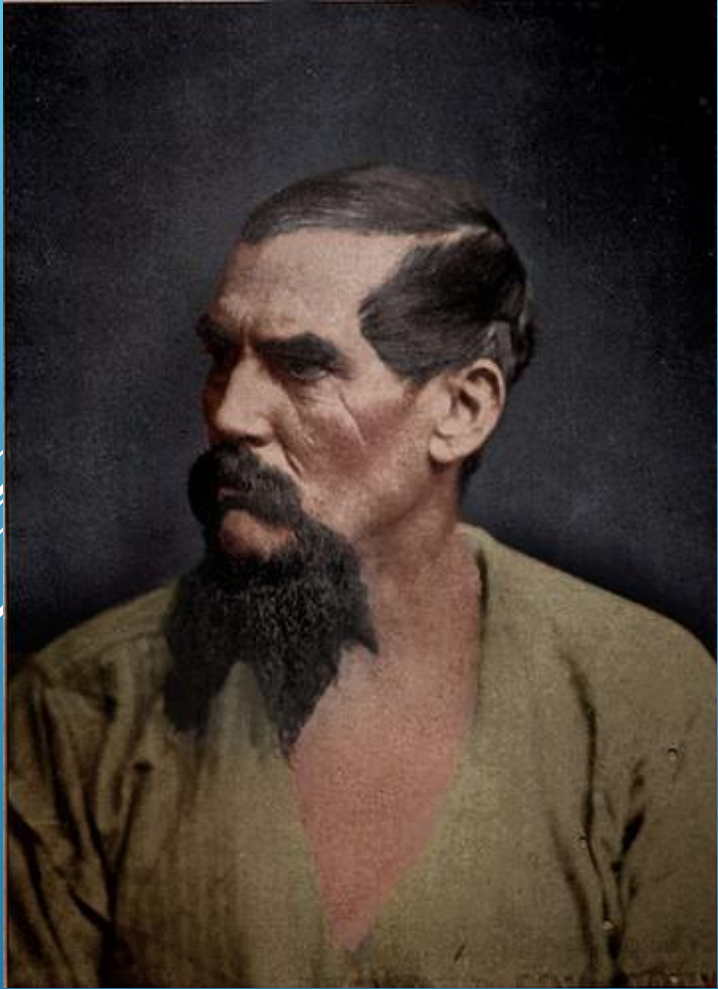
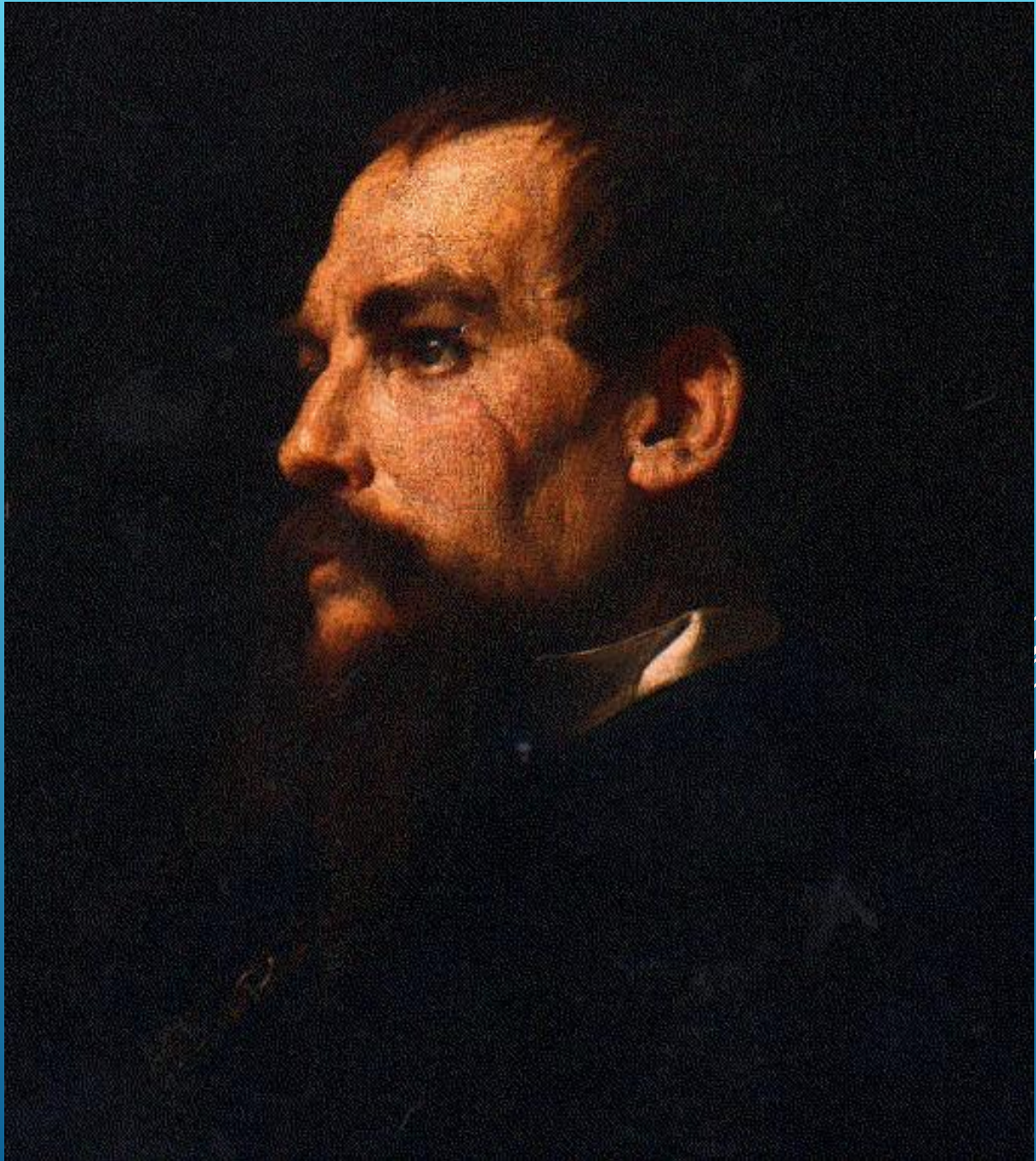
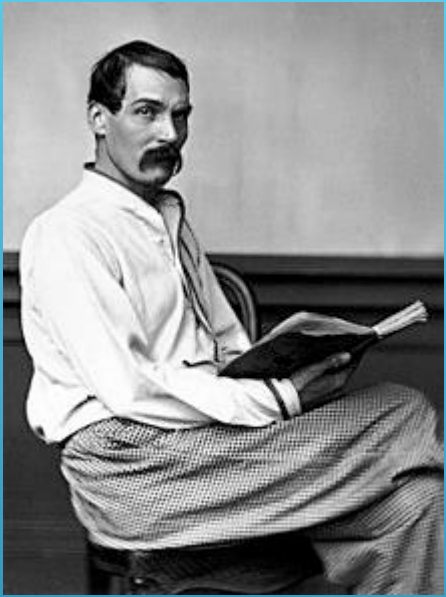
